The finances of the school depend upon the tuition from students and gifts of its friends for operation. From time to time special fund raising programs will be held and **cooperation is required.**

REGISTRATION: This payment is required at the time of application and is non-refundable.*

STATEMENT OF FAITH

We believe that the church should be evangelistic, missionary, Baptist, and premillennial in faith and practice.

Broadway Christian School is the educational arm of Broadway Baptist Church. Its primary purpose and objective is to train the students in the knowledge of God and the Christian way of life and also provides an excellent education.

BCS exists to work in cooperation with the home in training young people for time and eternity. The school faculty works closely with the parents to train the "whole" child.

Attendance at BCS is a privilege and not a right. The goals of this school are not to reform, but to train young people in the highest principles of Christian leadership, self-discipline, individual responsibilities, personal integrity, and good citizenship. This school stands without apology for the Gospel of Jesus Christ, which includes the highest standards of morality and conduct.

POLICIES

Schedule

School hours are from 8:00-2:30. Our school doors open at 7:30 and close at 3:00. Any student not participating in extra-curricular activities should be picked up by 2:45. After care will be available through individual persons affiliated with the school. Not part of the school program.

Absences and Tardies

Any student that is absent from school is required to bring a written excuse from parent/guardian. Only excused absences will be allowed to make up missed work.

Tardiness is very disruptive. Therefore, we cannot tolerate excessive tardiness. Tardiness can also result in loss of credit of affected classes.

Dress Code

Girls: loose fitting, modest dresses or skirts below the knee except for P.E.
(More specific rules given in the handbook to be given out at time of registration)

Boys: jeans or khakis (not faded or patched) with collared pullover shirt tucked in. No baggy pants. Belts are required

Hair Policy

Young ladies should keep their hair properly combed. No fad styles or cuts.
No excessive coloring, no unnatural coloring or dyeing of the hair.

Young men must have their hair cut off the collar, off the ears, and above the eyebrows. Styles such as rat tails, punk, new wave, fade, bowl or lines are not allowed. There is to be no excessive use of mousse to make the hair stand up.
No coloring or dyeing. No facial hair will be allowed.

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STATEMENT OF COOPERATION

I have read and understand the information concerning the school policies and rules, and I have explained to my child the contents. We agree to abide by the rules and standards stated in the school handbook in order to maintain a cooperative relationship. In the event of a behavior problem concerning my child, I agree to abide by the guidelines stated in the handbook. If I become dissatisfied with BCS in any respect, I will not sue, or make threats to sue this ministry, make demands, make any kind of accusation or complaint, or actually litigate any matter whatsoever relating to or resulting from the enforcement of the guidelines, but will try to resolve the matter with the person or persons involved or withdraw my child from BCS immediately. To do otherwise would be a clear violation of Biblical teaching and practice.

In full cooperation with BCS, I will attend the Parent Teacher Fellowship meetings when possible. Participation in fund raising events is required. I further realize that building strong relationships with my child's teacher to aid in the training of my child is as much my responsibility as is the school. Therefore, I will pray for the staff and school; cooperate with them in discipline, lay a spiritual foundation through godly example at home.

I understand that Broadway Christian School is not accredited by the state. BCS does not participate in the SOL program. Therefore, if I remove my child from BCS and transfer to public education, they may be tested from that school's curriculum. There is the possibility of having to repeat a grade.

By completing and submitting this form, I agree to pay the non-refundable registration fee. I understand that when payments are made in ten monthly payments, the first payment is due by September 1, and the last due by June 1. If payments are made after the 10th of the month, I will be charged a \$15.00 late fee. If a student is withdrawn any time during the month, no refund of any part of the monthly tuition payment will be made. By signing this application, I am authorizing the school to withhold report cards and other records until my tuition and other fees have been paid and my account is up to date.
