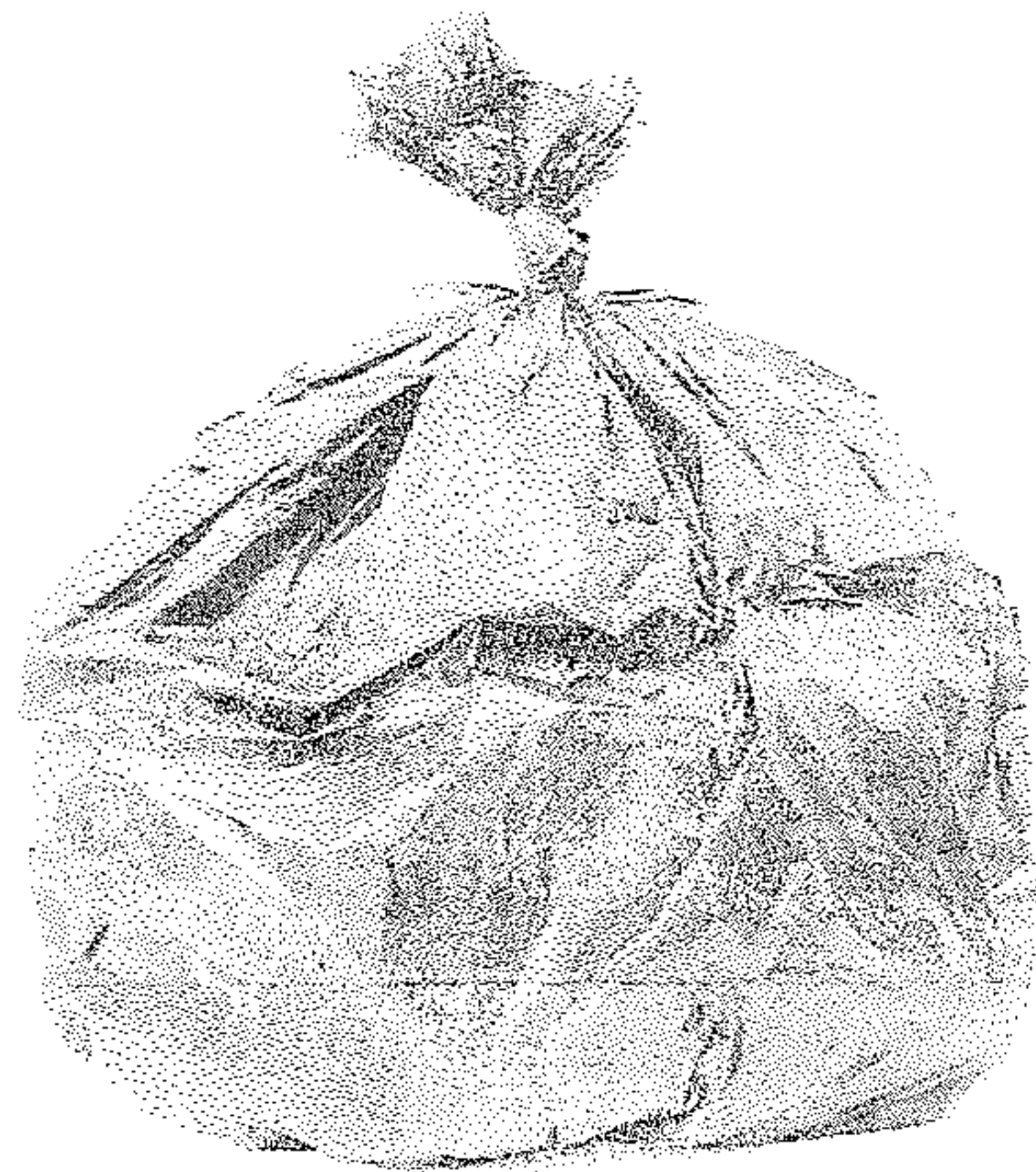


# “DO COUNT THEM BUT DUNG”



## PHILIPPIANS 3:1-9

- Finally, my brethren, \_\_\_\_\_ in the Lord. ~Neh. 8:10  
*Natural happiness is affected by pain, sorrow, sickness, poverty, and tragedy. But Christian joy rides high over all the billows of life. ~MacDonald*
- \_\_\_\_\_ of dogs, beware of evil workers.
