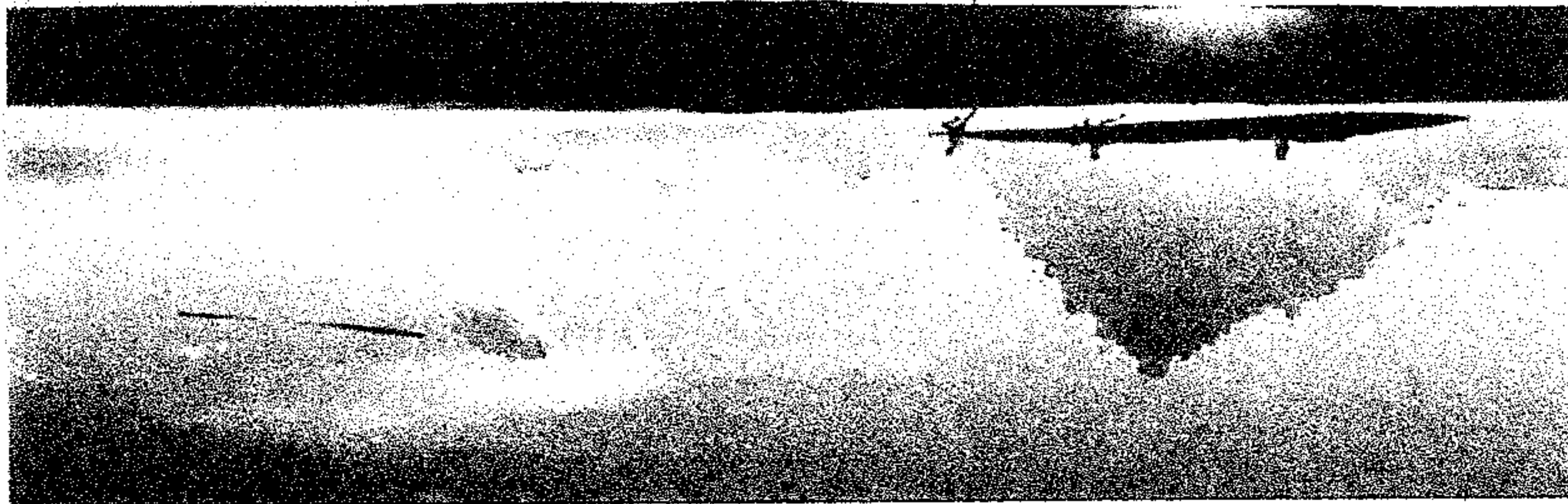


# “PRESS TOWARD THE MARK”
