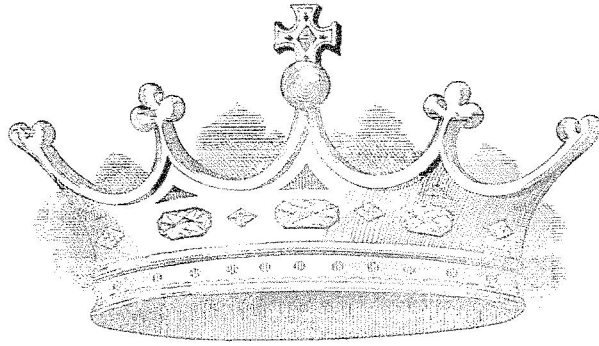


# THE WRATH OF THE KING
