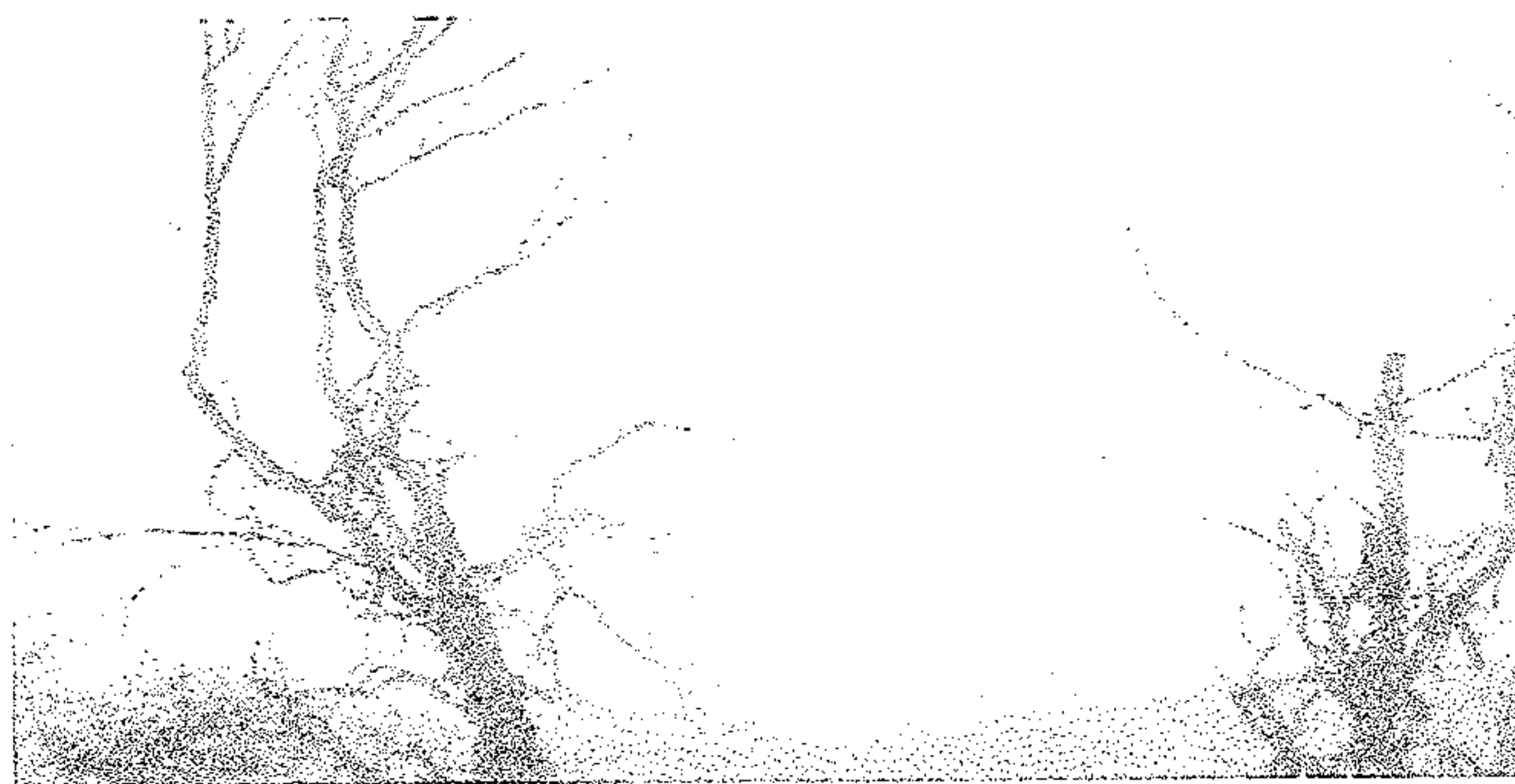


# “THE SECRET OF THE LORD”
