(BIMI), each SOAP missionary is sent under the authority of a stateside independent Baptist church to reach Uganda with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

SOAP reaches out to orphan children of Uganda with the Gospel and then trains them to become effective ministers to their own people. In order to do this great task, SOAP accepts into its care and custody, children who are double orphans (having lost both father and mother). We become their parental caregivers and provide for their physical needs along with godly nurturing and training for spiritual development.
