In 1962, a small group of believers (of the Baptist persuasion) in Oakland, MD, called Brother Ed Wilt (a home church planter) to come and start the First Baptist Church of Oakland. Now here we are, 50 years later and the First Baptist Church (now the Mountain Lake Independent Baptist Church) is still going strong.
