


FIVE KEYS TO... BENEFICIAL BIBLE READING

- 1. Schedule Your Bible Reading Daily. Ideally, read your Bible morning and evening. If this is not practical, read your Bible first thing in morning, and if this doesn't work for you, schedule time each day that is best for you. (Joshua 1:8-9; Psalm 1)
- 2. Follow A Schedule To Read Your Bible Through In A Year. Every book and Chapter of the Bible is given by inspiration of God and is profitable for our spiritual growth. (2 Timothy 3:16)
- Find A Quiet Place You Can Go To Be Alone. This may even be the bathroom if necessary. Make this place your "Devotion Place."
- 4. Read With A Pen In Hand. Underscore significant verses, jot notes/quotes in margin that God brings to mind.
- 5. Ask Yourself The 8 "Bible Study Questions" Listed In This Bulletin. These questions enable you to glean spiritual lessons/applications from nearly every passage of Scripture.
