



TRACT EVANGELISM

In Chile, a young mother came to Christ after reading a tract a missionary had given her. A man in the southern US was born again in his prison cell after reading a tract handed him by one of the guards. A Soviet paratrooper read a tract he was using to light a fire, and his life changed for eternity. Testimonies for the effectiveness of tract evangelism are endless.

WHYEVANGELIZE?

Most of us are not "evangelists" according to the classic definition. But the Bible is clear that we are to share the gospel.

WHY US?

God has chosen to reach the world through us. God uses our faithful (and sometimes fearful) efforts at evangelism to develop us. We must commit ourselves to God in trust and we be familiar with His Word. The more we know about God, the better our ability to answer the questions put before us.

There are many other blessings associated with witnessng, but one of the greatest is the personal joy of seeing someone come to salvation. And of course, one of the most effective methods of evangelizing the distribution of quality Gospel tracts.

WHY TRACTS?

It has been said that nothing cost less, goes farther, lasts longer or says it better than a gospel tract.

Tracts are indispensable. Think about their strategic use as you go out into the world each day. When you make them part of your spiritual repertoire, God will give you many opportunities to share. A tract can go to work if even a child finds one on the floor. Regardless of your spiritual maturity or experience in sharing the gospel, a tract is an indispensable helper.

Here are suggestions for developing an effective tract distribution.

- **1. PRAY.** You cannot win anyone to Christ, neither can a tract. Only the Holy Spirit can do that.
- **2. GIVE APPROPRIATE TRACTS.** Always carry several different types of tracts with you—so you can match the message to the person.

- **3. ENGAGE YOUR AUDIENCE.** This can be done by making eye contact, with a simple smile, asking questions and listening carefully to what is said.
- **4. DON'T FORCE TRACTS ON PEOPLE.** I recommend distributing a dozen tracts carefully, prayerfully, and judiciously over handing out a hundred indiscriminately.
- **5. USE TOP-QUALITY TRACTS.** Invest in the best tracts available. You and your Lord will be judged by the equipment you use.
- **6. KEEP YOUR TRACTS IN GOOD CONDITION.** Make sure your tracts are clean and fresh when you hand them out.
- 7. **USE POSITIVE TRACTS.** Our job is not to put others down, but to lift Jesus up by presenting the positive truth of the gospel.
- **8. FIND NEW WAYS TO USE TRACTS.** Be original. Never leave home without a tract.
- **9. GET ORGANIZED.** Place tracts where they will be readily accessible for your use, like in your closet, car, backpack, or purse.
- 10. DETERMINE TO GIVE OUT ACERTAIN NUMBER OF TRACTS EACH DAY. Challenge yourself to get out of your "comfort zone" and you will be amazed as you see the Lord bless your efforts.

SUGGESTIONS FOR TRACT DISTRIBUTION:

Do not force anyone to take a tract.

Do not block or constrain another person's movement in order to give them a tract.

Students should wait until between classes or after school hours to distribute Christian literature to other students and teachers.

On your own property or in your own home, you have every right to distribute any type of Christian literature.

If approached by a police officer or anyone questioning your right of religious free expression, be polite. Explain to them you are exercising your First Amendment rights to free speech.

You should not be required to seek permission or submit applications to exercise First Amendment rights.

Realize that private property owners have the right to limit FirstAmendment activities on their property.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR TRACT DISTRIBUTON ARE ONLY LIMITED BY YOUR IMAGINATION!

Hand out to customers at restaurants.

Put on tables in post offices.

Pass out on busy downtown street corners.

Pass out at schools after dismissal.

Hand tracts to the passengers on elevators.

Pass out in apartment complexes.

Pass out to customers in line at restaurant.

Pass out to downtown pedestrians.

Put in each box or bag of merchandise sold.

Send to parents in birth announcements.

Leave in phone booths.

Leave on ATM machines.

Leave in game rooms.

Place under the car windshield wiper.

Pass out door to door.

Put inside restrooms.

Leave on sitting areas of shopping malls.

Leave in city parks on benches.

Leave in Dressers for the Maid at Motels

Leave in Laundromats.

Leave at funeral homes.

Give to attendants at parking garages, etc.

Leave in motel rooms (in the drawers, telephone book, etc.)

Give to waitresses with generous tips at restaurants

Put in magazines in waiting rooms.

Leave in beauty parlors.

Include in bills paid by mail.

Hand to store employees, check-out clerks.

Leave on waiting areas of hospitals.

Leave in bank where deposit slips are.

Give to hospital \mathcal{E} nursing home patients.

Leave in returned library books.

Mail to relatives of deceased in obituaries.

Put in helium-filled balloons.

Put in pockets of used clothing given away.

Leave in dressing rooms of clothing stores.

Hand out at sporting events.
