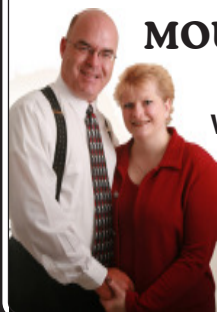

After All God Put Me Through... Did He Really Love Me? Testimony of Jenifer Jones

I grew up in a broken home. Often my mother would have 2 or 3 men stay the night in a week's time. She drank and did drugs, and although she loved us, we often had to live with my grandmother. We lived in a trailer most of my life. I had no contact with my father, who was a drunk and had physically abused us as children. I blamed God for my situation. I hated Him for it. You see, I knew there was a God, but He didn't love me. No one really did, it seemed. When I was 13, a friend from school began to invite me to church. After several months of turning her down, I agreed to go for a Christmas banquet on a Friday night.

The deal was if I went ONCE, then she would stop pestering me to go. She said that I could borrow one of her fancy dresses (I didn't own a single one!) and put on her make-up. She did my hair, and I began to be excited. I felt pretty for the first time in my life. It was a wonderful evening of fun, games and food...but then came the preaching! I was amazed that these people really believed that God loved them. They were passionate about their "SAVIOR," and I sat and listened to every word. "If God were really loving as they said, then why had He done all of these tragic things to me?" He was about to show me! That night I lay in bed, and I kept reliving those words, "God loves you and wants to be your Father!" Could it be? So I decided to try Him out and see if what I heard was true.

I desperately wanted a Father that loved me. Praise God I got one!! I said, "God, if you are really loving and you want to be my Father, then prove your love to me. I need proof! I want to be loved so that I can accept the gift that the preacher told me about. I believe that You love me and sent your Son for me. I want to be with You in Heaven. Oh, thank You, God, for loving someone so unlovable." That was the beginning of the most amazing journey of my life. My mother was not excited. She thought that I would get over it in time. I decided to go to church Sunday, and the church bus came and picked me up. I wore black jeans, a Metallica rock band t-shirt, chains around my neck, and my nails were black. I may have even had on black lipstick. I wore it often, but I don't recall. I stood in the back with my arms crossed. I was soaking up every word, but I later was told by our youth pastor that I looked like I was going to kill him and that he was afraid of me. We had a good laugh about that.

I rode the church bus faithfully from that service on for the next three years until we moved away. My, how God has changed my life! I am forever in the debt of that church family that gave so faithfully to the church bus ministry so I could be saved and grow in the Lord. I am now happily married with three beautiful children. I attend the Clays Mill Road Baptist Church in Lexington, KY where I serve as a Sunday school teacher, nursery worker, Pee Wee Patch Club teacher, a member of the Women's Missionary Society and Women's Soulwinning, a worker in the deaf ministry, and I have worked in the bus ministry for over 10 years. When I see the lives of my family, I am brought back to that Friday night, December 19, 1990 when God changed my life forever.
