

Luke's Testimony



Mike's Testimony

I grew up in a home where both of my parents were Christians. In 1982, I asked Jesus to be my Savior. I acknowledged that I was a sinner and was on my way to hell. I was baptized in Nebo First Baptist Church shortly after that. After high school, I attended the U.S. Naval Academy. I met Jen while attending church in Annapolis. It was at the Academy God dealt with me about preaching His Word. I answered the call and fulfilled my military commitment to the military by serving in the Marine Corps. It was at Coastline Baptist Church in Oceanside, California that I learned the value of planned, personal evangelism. While in Iraq, God showed me the impact of a godly testimony by allowing me to lead another soldier to him. God then brought us to Virginia, where I was privileged to attend the Heritage Institute of Ministry and prepare for a life of service to my Savior.

Jen's Testimony

I was raised in a Christian home in Edgewater, MD. My parents were saved when I was two years old. When I was nine years old, my older sister came to me, very concerned that I was not going to heaven and needed Jesus. On March 21, 1987 I ran downstairs and asked my mother to pray with me to ask Jesus to save me and come into my heart. I was baptized one month later. I met Mike in a Sunday school class at church. We were married on May 23rd, 1998. Our son, Isaiah, was born in 1999 and our daughter Abbey was born in 2001. We have attended Heritage Baptist Church for over ten years where, I have served as a K4 aid, volleyball coach, and wedding and event coordinator. We became close friends with many of the missionaries who came back on furlough. God used Justin and Grace Hayes to impress on us the need for missionaries, and especially missionary teams.

Our Call

God used Justin and Grace Hayes to reveal his plan for us in Spain. Justin simply asked the question, "Come and help us." God brought that statement up over and over in our hearts. During our missions conference in 2011, God again put a burden in our hearts to serve him more. We started praying about what and where God wanted us, and God brought up Spain every day. The first Sunday in January, Pastor Edwards preached on Abraham leaving Ur. We surrendered to serve God in Spain that night.

Our Plan

The book of Acts shows the value of missionary teams. Paul routinely traveled on missionary journeys with several companions. We believe God has called us to fill that supporting role in Spain. When we arrive in Spain, we will work with Justin and Grace Hayes, who are BIMi missionaries also sent from Heritage Baptist Church. Our first step will be to learn the language. By working with missionaries already there, we can immediately become immersed in an existing work, allowing us to practice the language while serving. As we learn the language, we will be able to work with the Hayes to teach Spaniards and help them start their churches in areas we might not be able to effectively reach as outsiders.
