

Why Have Tract Month?

Every faithful Christian wants to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ with others, but some find it extremely difficult to talk personally with someone, especially a stranger. There is a way to get over those fears and a way to make it easier to spread the gospel.

Just imagine you hand a Gospel Tract to someone, maybe without saying a word. That person and/ or another person read the gospel tract. You meet them in Heaven because at that one moment, you were bold enough to hand a tract to someone. What a glorious meeting it will be.

Have gospel tracts available at all times, and use every opportunity that God gives you to spread the gospel. We must not be "not be ashamed of the gospel".

- † Gospel Tracts can get inside homes and stay there until read. You can't.
- † Gospel Tracts are able to travel anywhere and can work overtime.
- † Gospel Tracts are often read many times over until the person meets the Lord.
- † Gospel Tracts are never timid in presenting the gospel.
- † Gospel Tracts never get discouraged!

How to use Gospel Tracts

- 1. Obey all local ordinances relating to the distribution of literature.
- 2. Always ask God to use you, seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit for each tract placed, and then pray for the Lord of harvest to bless it.
- 3. Pray. You cannot win anyone to Christ, neither can a tract. Only the Holy Spirit can do that.
- 4. Approach with loving smile. This can be done by making eye contact, with a pleasant and loving smile
- 5. Make every opportunity count. Never leave home without a tract and never miss a God-given opportunity to save.
- 7. Distribute tracts each and every day. The Lord will abundantly bless your efforts by giving you the joy only God can.
 - $\ensuremath{+}$ A tract is never embarrassed, timid, nor fearful and isn't hurt by rejection.
 - † It does not flinch and show cowardice when the truth it conveys is not believed.
 - † It never yields to the temptation to compromise the truth of the gospel of Christ.

- † It speaks clearly and right to the point.
- † It never argues back when its message is disputed, and it always sticks to the Truth.
- † It glorifies only Jesus as the Holy Spirit reveals the Word of God to its readers.
- † It never gets tired and gives up.
- † It keeps on working while we are sleeping.
- † It is always ready to witness to its readers at any time and at any location.
- † It can get inside of a house and stay there, even in secret places where we cannot gain entrance, to be revealed at a chosen time.
- † It cost very little and travels inexpensively.
- † It travels by any mode or class and in all kinds of climate and weather conditions.
- † It requires no food, clothing or shelter.
- † It is easily carried in a pocket or purse and between the pages of a book.
- † It can be used by anyone, any age, deaf, mute, crippled or even in a wheelchair.
- † It can be used by either the intellectual or the uneducated, because no speaking skills are needed to convey its message.
- † It conveys a message that is not ever lost, like a sermon, and can be read over and over again, long after we are gone and forgotten
- † It always catches a person in the right mood, because the Holy Spirit will always speak to the heart as the Word is being read.
- † It needs no translator, when it is in the language of the reader. It may be read by scores of people before God is finished with its purpose.
- † We can do a great work for God and lead many people to the knowledge of Christ.

Study the tracts first yourself before giving them out to others. This way you will know exactly what it says and you can refer to it when you talk to people.

Make a faithful commitment to give out our Gospel Tracts each week, each month and each year. You will be amazed of the joy the Lord gives you in your heart each time you pass out a Gospel Tract to a stranger with a prayer.
