



The following are some suggestions as to how tracts can be distributed:

1. Give tracts out at big events such as baseball games, soccer games, etc.
2. Put tracts in with your bill payments.
3. Send tracts and a personal letter to friends and family members. Send a tract a week to our elected officials and to community leaders.
4. Leave tracts with the waitress at the restaurant (be sure and leave a generous tip when leaving a tract) and the cashier when you pay the bill.
5. Leave tracts with the people you do business with (gas station attendant, grocery store clerk, doctor, pharmacist, etc.).
6. Leave tracts in waiting rooms, rest rooms, hotel and hospital lobbies.
7. At garage sale, set up a small table with tracts on and give them to your customers.
8. Leave them in phone booths, in the library, on store counters and in dressing rooms.
9. Pass them out in stores, at the park, or down town.
10. Leave them in the laundromat (not in the washer or dryers though!), give them to the customers.
11. Leave them with the mailman, phone man, delivery man, and salesmen.
12. Go door to door and give them to folks or just place them on their door to find when they open up.
13. Give them out in school, leave them in lockers, changing rooms, and in desks.

Use your imagination! Tract distribution is a form of service in which almost every Christian can participate. No special training is necessary; no unusual talent is needed. The only requirement is a sincere desire to be used of God. Just imagine what could happen if each of us would give a tract to everyone we meet. Some fellow in our town might get several tracts a day for a month. He would surely begin to wonder what in the world was going on and give some thought to his spiritual condition. Only eternity will reveal what Gospel tracts have accomplished for the cause of Christ and the spread of the Gospel! Get a packet today, give out as many as you can, trust the Lord to use your efforts and give God the glory!

HOW TO CONDUCT YOURSELF DURING PREACHING

"But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth" (1 Timothy 3:15).

1. USE THE BIBLE

Read the verses as the preacher reads them. Test with the Bible everything the preacher says (*Acts 17:11*). Write things in your Bible (important things, such as cross references, definitions, important thoughts).

2. LISTEN CAREFULLY

Look to God for a message. *1 Peter 4:11* says the speaker is to be the oracle of God, meaning the mouthpiece of God. If you listen carefully and seek something from the Lord, you can be edified even from a seemingly boring message. Remember that God can use weak men. An example is Solomon. He had tremendous problems, but God used him to write three important books of the Bible, including the book of Proverbs, which is the book of wisdom.

3. SIT RESPECTFULLY AND ALERTLY

Examples of what not to do: slouching, leaning on your elbows with your head down, and chewing gum. Such things send signals that you are not interested in what the preacher is saying. Remember that others are watching you. Your attitude affects the preacher, those sitting around you, and the entire atmosphere of the service

4. DON'T DISTRACT OTHERS

Examples of things that distract others are talking and writing notes, making noise (i.e., cracking your fingers), playing with babies, walking in & out, and kids looking at people behind them.

5. TREAT THE INVITATION SERIOUSLY

Respond to the invitation as Lord leads and pray for others. Be careful not to distract others during the invitation. Do not walk out during invitation. Be conscious of their need.
