THE "LITTLE PREACHER"

No doubt, one of our greatest tools in the spread of the gospel is the simple Gospel Tract! This handy "*Little Preacher*" is able to do what many of us often fail or are unable to do. Let me give some examples of the advantages the Gospel Tract has:

- I. The Gospel Tract never stumbles over words or forgets important Scriptures.
- 2. The Gospel Tract can be given even during extremely brief encounters (when making a purchase, passing some-one in the street, etc.).
- 3. The Gospel Tract never gets sidetracked or caught up in an argument, it just gives the message of salvation, plainly and clearly.
- 4. The Gospel Tract is never intimidated or fearful.
- 5. The Gospel Tract never is tempted to compromise the message of Christ.
- 6. The Gospel Tract can wait on some one's door until they get home.
- 7. The Gospel Tract can be left in public places and wait until some one's curiosity causes them to pick it up and read it.
- 8. The Gospel Tract never gets tired and gives up.
- 9. The Gospel Tract never gets discouraged or disheartened.
- 10. The Gospel Tract is very inexpensive and travels very easily (letters, purse, shirt pocket).
- 11. The Gospel Tract will often speak over and over when read and reread, whereas our verbal witness is usually only heard one time.
- 12. The Gospel Tract can and will travel to communities we could never personally reach.
- 13. The Gospel Tract is very inexpensive to purchase and distribute.

We could go on and on as to the benefits and uses of the *"Little Preacher"*. Only eternity will reveal the number of souls saved and lives impacted by this *"Little Preacher"*!

THINGS OF THE WORLD

"Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world." (1 John 2:15)

We must be wary of the world's "*things*," because we are "*in the world*" not "*of the world*" (John 17:11-16). The command in our text is that we are not to love the world or its things, not that we should remain blissfully ignorant of them. We are to be "*wise as serpents, and harmless as doves*" (Matthew 10:16).

There are big things of the world like nations and kingdoms (Matthew 4:8; Luke 12:30) as well as cares and riches (Mark 4:19) which can sap our focus and drain our loyalties. And there are "*rudiments*" and "*elements*" (Colossians 2:20; Galatians 4:3) that can twist our thinking and "*spoil*" us (Colossians 2:8).

We are warned that friendship with the worldly lifestyle and that which espouses the "*things*" of the world, makes us an "*enemy of God*" (James 4:4). That is because such people embrace the "*spirit of the world*" and not "*the spirit which is of God*" (1 Corinthians 2:12). Those people speak about the things of the world, and the world listens to them (1 John 4:5).

God's people may be "*base*" and "*weak*"- even "*foolish*" in the eyes of the world (1 Corinthians 1:27-28). Since the great Creator God has chosen us out of the world (John 15:19), it should not surprise us that the world "*hates*" those who belong to the Lord Jesus (John 17:14). Hence, the ungodly passions that drive the ungodly behavior of the world, "*the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world*" (1 John 2:16).

Those passions and the people who embrace them will "*pass away*." But "*he that doeth the will of God abideth forever*" (1 John 2:17). HMM III
