### The Upper Room Campaign November 8 – November 14, 2020 Week 3

**Introduction:** This week we will continue in our progress in Christ's School of Prayer. You will notice the progression of growth in prayer as we go through this week's schedule. Starting with the importance of the corporate church prayer meeting and why the church should pray together to learning the all-inclusive requisite for answered prayer at the end of this week, each day presents a spiritually healthy meal from Christ's table of prayer.

#### Day One – November 8<sup>th</sup> – The Power Of United Prayer (Matthew 18:19-20)

There are two things we learn that are very important. First is the power of prayer with other individuals, whether it be a spouse, friend, or family member. Second is the power of people gathering together to pray. Third is the power of a church prayer meeting. This promise applies to all three.

- Lord, I will seek to pray with others.
- Lord, I will seek to be faithful to my church's prayer meeting.

### Day Two – November 9<sup>th</sup> – The Power Of Persevering Prayer (Luke 18:1-8)

If an unjust judge will avenge a widow speedily because of her perseverance, how much more will the Lord reward our persevering prayer.

 Lord, I will not give up praying for that which You want me to bring before you.

#### Day Three – November 10<sup>th</sup>– Prayer In Harmony With The Being Of God (John 11:41-42;Psalm 2:7-8)

Christ never had a prayer go unanswered because He prayed in harmony with the very being of His Heavenly Father. We are to pray the same way.

 Lord, I desire to grow in prayer so that I pray according to Thy very person.

#### Day Four – November 11<sup>th</sup> – Prayer In Harmony With The Destiny Of Man (Matthew 22:20; Genesis 1:26)

This will be the message that will be brought in tonight's services.

#### Day Five – November 12<sup>th</sup> – Power For Prayer And Working (John 14:12-23)

If we are to succeed in God's work we must pray and we must work. This power is given to us by God.

- Lord, I will pray as if everything depends upon Thee.
- Lord, I will work as if everything depends upon me.

# Day Six – November 13<sup>th</sup> – The Chief End Of Prayer (John 14:13)

The ultimate goal of prayer is for our prayers to be answered so that God will be glorified through us.

- Lord, I will desire to seek to glorify Thee.
- Lord, I will glorify thee through successful praying.

# Day Seven – November 14<sup>th</sup> – The All-Inclusive Condition (John 15:7)

Abiding in Christ, and His Word abiding in you is the all-inclusive condition..

- I will seek to abide in Christ.
- I will saturate myself with Thy Word.

**Conclusion:** Starting today, spend time each day going over the passage of Scripture and the lesson for the day, and set aside a time for prayer each day. Listen to the messages each day, whether in church or on Facebook or our website (<u>www.orangeburgbaptist.com</u>). If you have not started on the prescribed dates, start where you are by getting week one of the outline before proceeding to this week, and, if possible, do a morning and an evening time until you catch up. For further study, I would recommend you getting Andrew Murray's book, <u>With Christ In The School Of Prayer</u> and study each lesson, using the KJV.
