Our Beliefs

Doctrinal Stances

These are a few brief descriptions of our doctrinal stances on some of the topics that have been of issue.

The Bible is inerrant and infallible and the final authority on all Biblical issues. For English speaking people, the scriptures are preserved in the King James Bible.

The biblical church is local and visible and was established when Jesus called His disciples as stated in the Gospels.

The only Baptism we will accept is immersion by a Baptist church of like faith and practice.

The observation of Lord's supper is reserved for only members of the local church.

Jesus Christ was born of a virgin, being both man and God. He lived a sinless life and salvation is only through Him.

All who have been truly saved by grace through faith in Jesus Christ, are eternally saved and kept by His power and can never be lost again.

While the Holy Spirit grants gifts those who have received salvation, we believe

those apostolic sign gifts, such as speaking in tongues and the gift of healing have ended.

We hold to a pre-tribulation position on the rapture of the church, and a pre-millennial position on Christ's return.

The two scriptural positions of the church, Pastor and Deacon can only be held by men.

Our Practice

Church Operation

Through the direction and leading of Christ it is our goal to plant a conservative, fundamental, evangelistic, separated church, where Bible preaching and teaching will be the preeminent ministry. We hold to Baptist doctrine for by its very definition, it is a biblical doctrine that holds the Holy Scriptures as the final authority on all ecclesiastical practice, administration, and polity.

Conservative - hold to an orthodox form of worship not conforming to the whims and trends of the modern era.

Fundamental - rejection of both modernism and progressive theology as it seeks to gain favor within the culture.

Separated - in both lifestyle and worship that we hold ourselves to be a peculiar people. To be within and affecting the world but not a part of the world. Separate in appearance, music, and every aspect of both worship and life.

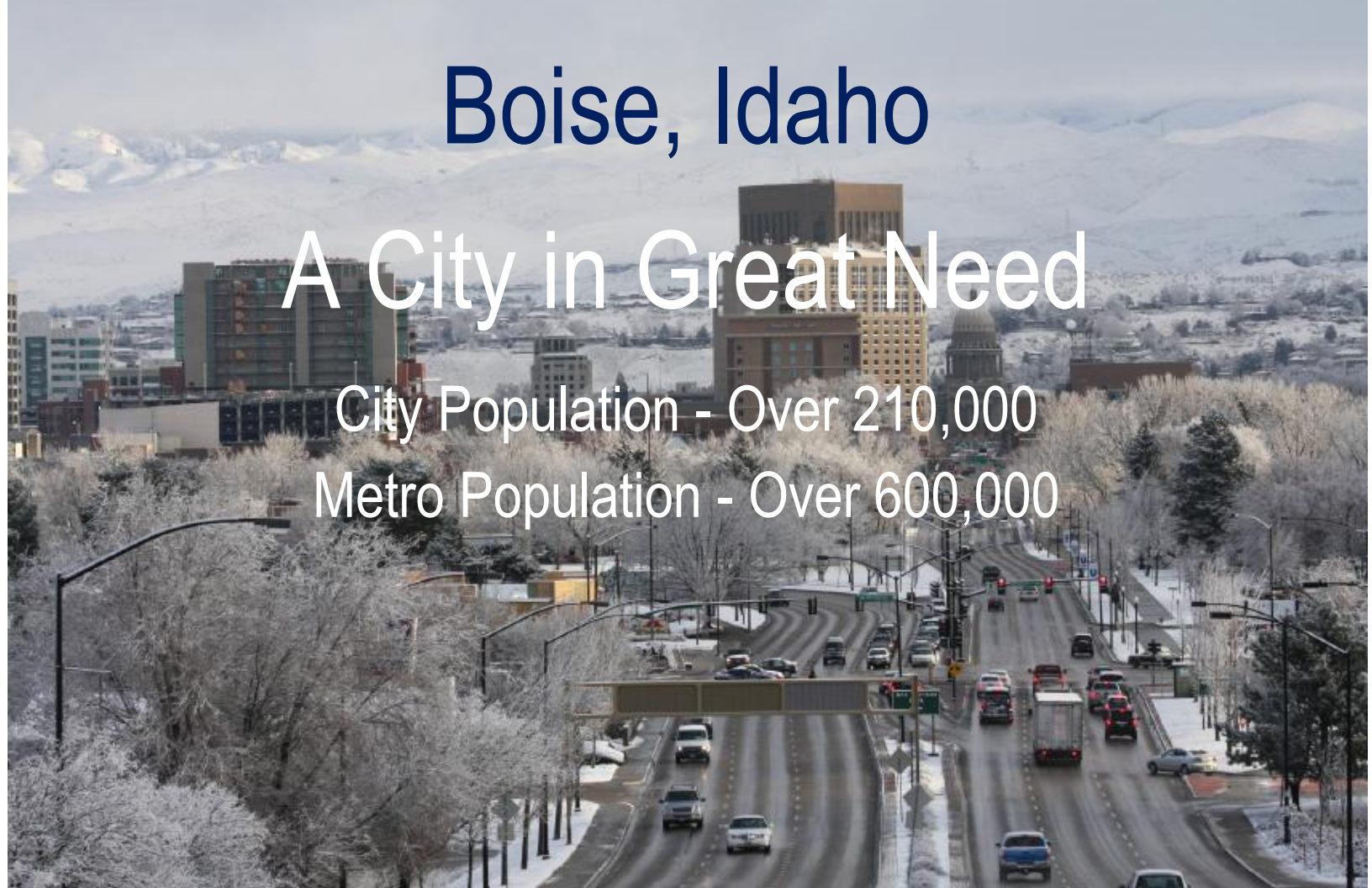

City Population - Over 210,000

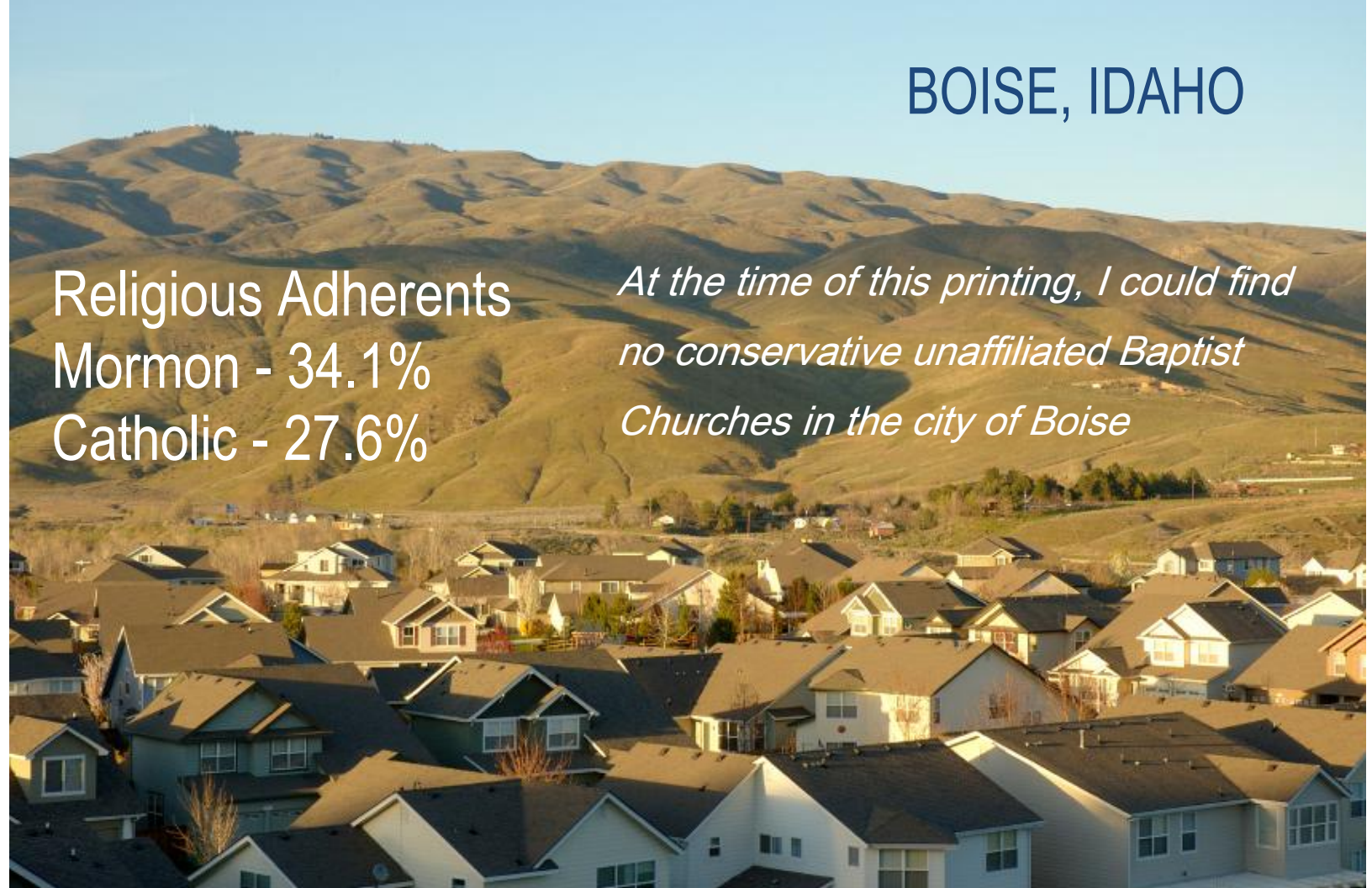
Metro Population - Over 600,000
