I hen one speaks of the need for more laborers in the work of the Lord, Matthew 9:37-38 is often referenced. Jesus said: The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest. Our desire mirrors these verses as we labor here in Germany. The spiritual fields of Germany are ready for the harvest. All that is needed are more laborers. What we face is not a shortage of work, but of workers. Kelly and I long to see more faithful servants of the Lord who are called to invest their lives here in Germany. There are numerous towns and cities here in Germany that do not have a Bible preaching church. Who is going to reach those towns and cities with the Gospel of Jesus Christ? There is much work that needs to be done, and Germany needs more laborers!

On July 26 we will undertake a short, six week "furlough" back to the States. We will return to Germany on September 6, just in time for Jackson to start a new school year. Since his summer vacation is much shorter than the typical American summer break, we are forced to keep our trips to the States very short. While visiting the States, we plan on spending some quality time with friends and family, but we will also be in numerous churches spread out over the country. We will be in lowa, Nebraska, South Dakota, Arkansas, Tennessee, Virginia, West Virginia, Pennsylvania, Indiana, and Ohio.

We will be traveling 4,735 miles and be in the car for a total of 76 hours and 25 min in six short weeks! *Please pray for our sanity and safety!*

We desire to be in as many churches as possible, but there is only so many that we can visit in such a short amount of time. We would love to personally express our thanks to every church that supports us, but that is impossible to do in six weeks time.
