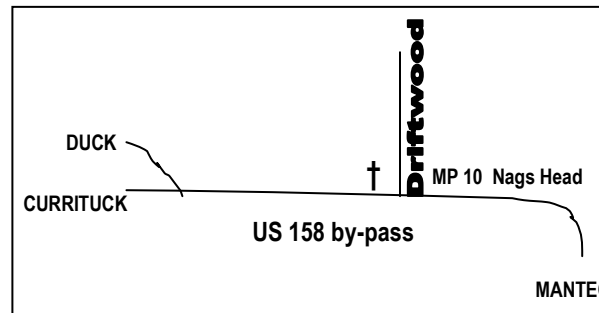

WHAT TO EXPECT

- All routes start from the church, after orientation, and end at the church.
- There will be rest stops complete with restrooms, water and an assortment of snacks and fruit.
- Support vehicles will also be on hand to provide assistance if needed.
- Lunch will be provided.

THE ROUTES

25 and 50 Miles

- ⊕ From the church
- ⊕ To the end of Old South Nags Head Road
- ⊕ Back to the church (for 25)
- ⊕ Up to Southern Shores & back to church on the sound side (for 50)

100 MILES

- ⊕ From the church to Currituck Lighthouse
- ⊕ Back to the church – via sound side
- ⊕ To the end of Old South Nags Head Road
- ⊕ Back to church

NOTE: Entrance to the Bodie Island Lighthouse and the Wright Memorial are not part of the official routes. Those wishing to visit these sites during the ride can do so on their own.
