Comparing the Kings of Babylon with the coming ‘Man of Sin’



Nebuchadnezzar

- 1- For a time, he was the most powerful man on the Earth
- 2- He attacked and oppressed the Jews
- 3- He defiled the Temple at Jerusalem by taking the sacred vessels from it (2 Thess. 2:4)
- 4- He is a MAN who is also described as a BEAST (Rev. 13)
- 5- His heart was filled with pride
- 6- He was associated with the mandatory worship of an image. He punished non-conformers with the threat of death.
NOTICE: he effectively joined **RELIGION** with **POLITICS**. As political head of the kingdom, he also served as ‘worship leader’ to false gods. (Rev. 13:15) (Rev. 17:3) Beast & Prophet Unite
- 7- He blasphemed the One True God
- 8- He was judged by God and, subsequently, was compelled to praise the TRUE GOD of Heaven (Phil. 2:9-11)

- 3- He was ultimately destroyed by a STRONGER KING (Rev.19)
