"The Kingdom of Heaven"

- ❖ Found only in MATTHEW, the Gospel of the KING. The expression is used 33 times in 32 verses.
- Physical, literal dominion created by God and given to man (Adam). Man lost that dominion by rebelling against the Creator's law.
- * Contains both SAVED and LOST souls. Consider the parables of the wheat and tares.
- ❖ Offered to the Jews at the First Coming of Christ. "The kingdom of heaven is at hand!"
- This kingdom was rejected by the Jews along with their rightful King. Now the nations take the kingdom by force and violence (Matt.11:12).
- ❖ It will come in its fullest extent during the Millennium under the reign of the King of Kings
- Unites with Kingdom of God at Christ's Coming.



"The Kingdom of God"

- The expression is used 70 times in 69 verses in the Gospels and Epistles.
- Spiritual, invisible (Luke 17:20). Entered into only by the new birth (John 3:3).
- Only the SAVED are part of this kingdom.
- * Offered to the Jews at the First Coming of Christ, "The Kingdom of God is at hand!"
- This kingdom was rejected by the Jews along with their rightful King. Now this kingdom is offered to the Jews and Gentiles who will believe (Matt.21:43).
- This kingdom is INWARD and INTANGIBLE (Rom. 14:17).
- ❖ It will come and re-unite with the Kingdom of Heaven in the Person of Christ at His Second Coming.
