


Boxes and Bibles

NEWS BITS FROM HERE AND THERE





Opposition leader Juan Guaidó has declared himself the interim president of Venezuela with the intentions of holding elections. Backed by the United States and her allies, Mr. Guaidó is calling for current Venezuelan president Nicolas Maduro to resign in order to hold new elections. With inflation projected to reach 1,500,000% this year, millions of Venezuelans have fled the country for Brazil, Colombia, Ecuador, and other places where they can find work to help support their families. Churches, also experiencing this crisis, have lost key workers and leaders and many have begun feeding programs on Sundays for local people. Paper production is non-existent (they can't even buy toilet paper), so the printing of God's Word and helpful materials is not available. Yet in all of this, the church continues to grow. Weekly, people are being saved, baptized and discipled. Pray for our Christian family in Venezuela and get involved in the Bible shipments to South America.

"Numerous states introducing Bible Literacy classes, giving students the option of studying the Bible. Starting to make a turn back? Great!" Tweeted President Trump. Legislators in FL, IN, MO, ND, VA and WV are proposing Bible Literacy classes following the example of Kentucky. In 2017, under much opposition from the ACLU, the Kentucky legislature and governor passed a bill that allowed for public schools to teach Bible literacy classes. According to the ACLU, "public school teachers use the Bible to impart religious life lessons" by using Sunday School material as its source for the classes. In a statement last August, the ACLU said, "Without more specific guidance, we fear some classrooms will once again be filled with preaching, not teaching. The ACLU-KY reminds students and parents that 'Bible Literacy' courses may not promote religion or a particular religious viewpoint, test students on matters of religious faith, nor be designed to instill religious life lessons. Religious education is best left to parents and churches, not school or government." (cbsnews.com)

How many graves are in America? Statistics show that 2.4 million Americans will die just in this year. Calculations grow daily as grave hunters, genealogist, historians, hobbyist, and family members track down and chronicle the roots of this nation. "Find A Grave" a popular online cemetery roster touts over 170 million registered graves. Estate records can be read dating back to the 1700s, with most in that century being quite specific and detailed showing accounting down to the last teacup. Yet is this all that has been left behind - a good mystery surrounded in yellowed papers and crumbling tombstones? An American Patriot's last will and testament points to something greater. He penned:

"In the name of God Amen. June the 25th day in the year of our Lord 1797, I...being at this time in a low station of health but in my proper senses thanks be to God for it, therefore calling to mind the estate and mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed to all men once to die, I do constitute and make and ordain this my last will and testament, that is to say principally and first of all after this life is ended. I recommend my soul into the hands of God who gave it, and my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian and decent like manner at the discretion of my executor hereafter mentioned, nothing doubting, but at the last and general resurrection, I shall receive the same by the mighty power of God and as to such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life, I dispose of in the following manner..."

Graves may be lost, papers may vanish, yet a hope in eternity can be a lasting heritage. Death is certain until the coming of the Lord. Of this even the unbelieving believe. Have you prepared? What will you leave for those that follow? How will it count for eternity's sake? Ponder this:

For here have we no continuing city, but we seek one to come. (Heb. 13:14)
