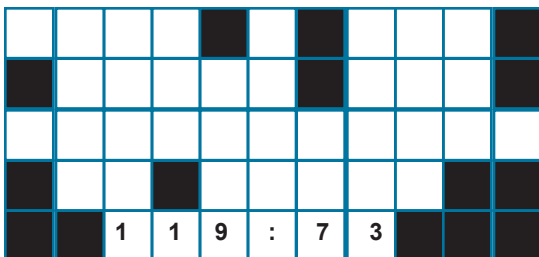
PUPPY CHOW (For People!)
