## Lessons from Aquila and Priscilla

Needle and Thread-  
Get your friends together  
and make a circle where  
your hands can touch each  
other. Choose one person to  
be a needle and one to be the  
thread. The thread chases the  
needle, but cannot go inside  
of the circle. The needle  
weaves between the people  
in the circle trying to "sew up"  
the circle before the thread  
catches him. When the needle  
goes in between two people  
they hold hands to show that  
that part of the circle is closed.  
If the needle is caught, the  
thread becomes the needle  
and someone else becomes  
the thread.

Do you need a special  
gift for someone this  
season? Here's an idea...  
Buy a miniature Christmas  
Tree from a craft store.  
Decorate the tree with spools  
of thread, buttons attached to  
long pieces of wire that can be  
stuck in between the branches,  
a measuring tape as the  
garland, and any other sewing  
things you can find. Items  
such as thimbles, ribbons,  
pin cushions, small scissors  
can be glue on to the tree.  
When finished, you may want  
to place the tree into a small  
sewing basket with a little note  
that says "Thank you for being  
'sew' kind."
