## **Ministry Update**

The following is a report from Venezuela and The Philippines, and it clearly demonstrates the faithful work of these dear missionaries. Please keep them in your prayers.

## From Venezuela

•Pastor Niller reports that during the months of March and April, he and his church knocked on over 250 doors. They presented the plan of salvation over 90 times with 92 accepting Christ as their personal Lord and Saviour. They also had several baptisms during this month. They ask that we pray for them as they are in search of an air condition for their ministry, spiritual growth, numerical growth, workers for their various outreaches, and for his city to be saved.

•Pastor Elton reports that during the months of January through March this new church had several special days in which the community was invited to visit the church. On one such occasion, they had 55 in attendance with 25 salvations. Praise the Lord!!! They also had two encouraging youth conferences. Their specific prayer requests are for souls to be saved, workers for the various outreaches, a van to bring people to church, and property of their own. •Special request from all serv-
