...that in all things Christ might have the pre-eminence.

"Who can find a Virtuous woman? For her price is far above rubies." Matthew Henry states, "This description of the virtuous woman is designed to show what wives the woman should make and what wives the men should choose... We have the abridgment of it in the New Testament (1 Tim. 2:9,10;

1 Peter 3:1-6), where the duty prescribed to wives agrees with this description of a good wife.

The ungodly world cannot understand God's perfect plan; and with great effort, rejects biblical teaching concerning marriage and the family. Unregenerate man, and sadly, some professed believers think they know more than God. The devastating result is heartbreaking consequences and ruined lives. Many religions of this world treat women as second class citizens or less. But the Bible sets forth the worth and honor of the Proverbs 31 woman



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PROVERBS 31:10-31

- **10** Who can find a virtuous woman? for her price *is* far above rubies.
- 11 The heart of her husband doth safely trust in her, so that he shall have no need of spoil.
- 12 She will do him good and not evil all the days of her life.
- 13 She seeketh wool, and flax, and worketh willingly with her hands.
- **14** She is like the merchants' ships; she bringeth her food from afar.
- 15 She riseth also while it is yet night, and giveth meat to her household, and a portion to her maidens.

For wives, mothers, and all young ladies in Christ, let us declare May as "First" Lady Month for Christ. Here is an acrostic using the word F-I-R-S-T to describe the virtuous woman of Proverbs 31.

F aith – A VIRTUOUS woman – a woman of strength made so by her faith and fear in the mercy, love, grace, and wisdom of her righteous and Holy God.

I ntegrity – A VIRTUOUS woman – a woman of holiness and wholeness, fixed and firm in honesty.

R econciliation – A VIRTUOUS woman – a woman reconciled to God with the ministry of reconciliation in the husband, home, and hearts of those around her.

S tewardship—A VIRTUOUS woman – a woman of industry well able to furnish her household.

T rust – A VIRTUOUS woman – a woman called blessed by her children, a woman trusted and praised by her husband.

In American history, the U.S. president's wife was not referred to as the "First Lady" until Zachary Taylor used the term in reference to Dolley Madison. Within a decade of Zachary Taylor's 1849 eulogy, "First Lady," had become the standard title of the president's wife.

Beginning with Martha Washington, many of the president's wives set forth an example of dignity and grace in their role as a leader. Though a very private person, she understood the pressures of this very public role. With her aristocratic Virginia roots, Martha Washington was criticized as too "royal" by some Americans wary of all things British. "At the same time, she was decried as too common by those who feared that her habits of recycling old gowns and of retiring early during receptions might confirm the suspicions of the world that America was an uncivilized wilderness. But to all who visited the president's

house—in New York City or later in Philadelphia—Lady Washington was the model of grace and propriety; eventually these qualities won her the affection and respect of all America." Ref - First Ladies of the White House by Skarmeas, page 5.

Sara Polk and her husband brought to the White House a marriage that was a true partnership. She often told friends that she believed that she and her husband were predestined by God to lead America. Upon arriving to the White House, Sarah immediately made her presence felt. Believing that dancing in the White House rooms would be undignified, she banned all dancing, card playing, and drinking. When the "First Lady" entered the room during her husband's inaugural ball. the music and dancing ceased in her honor. Known to possess a balance of ego and humility, she used her leadership role while insisting, "I recognize nothing in myself; I am only an atom in the hands of God." Lucy Hayes, mocked in the press as "Lemonade Lucy," immediately established a White House policy banning alcohol at all receptions. She resisted all efforts by the temperance movement to become part of their leadership and maintained a firm belief that hers was essentially a private role in a public setting. She was the first "First Lady" to hold a college degree. She had the education, resources, and opportunity to make the role of "First Lady" an active, independent, and powerful one. However, Lucy focused on her family responsibilities and her husband. While not totally shunning public duties, she was the first president's wife to travel without her husband and to deliver prepared speeches. Lucy also took an active role as president of the Women's Missionary Society at her church during her husband's presidency. Ref - First Ladies of the White House,

And in the day or in the night 'tis her love that brings comfort and delight. RLW




FROM VENEZUELA -

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Mass For His Soul



My dear wife and I were having lunch in a restaurant when an interesting conversation arose in the booth next to ours. Apparently, the waitress had asked the dining customer at that particular table about the "Jesus" T-shirt he was wearing. This waitress made the statement that she was brought up as a Catholic, but believed that all religions had some good and truth. The customer responded by asking if she had ever read the Bible? He then continued and later offered her a gospel tract to read.

In light of recent events, I found this young Catholic lady's response quite interesting. The following account by James McCarthy may help to give insight to the teaching of the Roman Catholic Church.

Climbing the steps of the bus that would take me across the width of Ireland from Galway to Dublin, I prayed that God would direct me where to sit. I wasn't disappointed. About half way to the back of the bus there was an empty seat next to an elderly nun. I sat down and we exchanged names.

Sister Teresa sized me up pretty quick. From my name she knew that I was of Irish descent, and from my accent that I was an American. "Your parents raised you in the Catholic faith?" she asked in a tone attesting to the fact that she already knew the answer.

"Yes," I responded politely, feeling somewhat as if my second grade teacher, Sister James Timothy, was speaking to me.

"And are you still practicing your faith?" Sister Teresa continued.

"No," I answered. "I began reading the Bible several years ago and became a born-again Christian. I left the Roman Catholic Church two years later."

Sister Teresa frowned. She had heard this story before. "I don't understand why so many people feel that they have to leave the Church." After a short pause she added, "You should have remained a Catholic."

"It was a matter of doctrine," I answered. "The Bible teaches that salvation is a free gift of God."

"I believe that," Sister Teresa replied with conviction. "Salvation is from God. That's what the Church teaches."

"But the Bible says that 'by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God," I said, quoting Ephesians 2:8.

"I believe that also," Sister Teresa answered. "Salvation is by faith in Christ. Christ died on the cross for our sins. We are saved through Him."

Sister Teresa's confident replies surprised me. She sounded as if she really believed it. Despite the teaching

of her church, she seemed to believe as I did. I decided to test her further. "Do you think that you will go to heaven when you die?"

"Yes. Christ died for me. I'm trusting in Him to get me there."

I asked a few more questions and found every answer spot on, as the Irish would say. Maybe she's a believer, a sister in Christ, I thought to myself. It's common to hear Christians today state that there are lots of believers in the Roman Catholic Church. I had met very few. The Catholics I had spoken to generally had no understanding of the gospel. I had never met a priest or nun who could explain the biblical way of salvation; I guess there is always a first!

We chatted most of the way to Dublin. I found Sister Teresa, like most nuns, to be a kind-hearted woman. And regardless of what her Church taught, I couldn't find anything wrong with her own understanding of salvation. Nothing, that is, until we reached Dublin.

"Are you visiting family?" I asked as we pulled into the bus station.

"No, I'm on my way to Rome," Sister Teresa explained. "Pope John Paul has declared this to be a holy year. Anyone taking a pilgrimage to Rome can earn a plenary indulgence."

I was shocked by her shameless participation in such an unbiblical practice. Catholicism teaches that every sin incurs a penalty, called temporal punishment. It also teaches that this penalty must be paid by the sinner either through suffering while alive on earth or after death in purgatory. Additionally, the Church claims that it can dispense credits that cancel the debt of temporal punishment. These credits are called indulgences. A partial indulgence takes away a portion of a person's penalty. A plenary indulgence, like the one for which Sister Teresa was attempting to qualify, cancels all the temporal punishment that a person had accumulated up until that time. The Church says that Christ gave it the authority to draw these credits from a vast reservoir of merit earned by Christ, Mary, and the Catholic saints.

I learned later that Pope John Paul II was offering Catholics visiting Rome a Plenary Jubilee Indulgence. Pilgrims were required to receive the sacraments of penance and the Eucharist, visit the basilicas of Saint Peter, Saint John Lateran, Saint Paul, and Saint Mary Major, and at each location pray for the pope's intentions, his personal prayer requests. Those meeting these requirements would receive a complete remission of the temporal punishment of their

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sins

I had to voice my astonishment how Sister Teresa had given me a false picture of her beliefs. "I thought you said that Christ had died for your sins and that salvation was through trusting Him!" I objected.

"Christ has done His 99%," she retorted. "We have to cooperate by doing our 1%." With that she grabbed her bag and disembarked from the bus.

Sister Teresa apparently had no qualms about adapting the explanation of her faith for my evangelical ears. And why should she? The Roman Catholic Church has been following this approach for over 30 years. Gone are the days of the Church-Triumphant when Rome could and did intimidate emperors and kings. Gone are the dogmatic canons, as at the Council of Trent in which the Church condemned teaching contrary to its own. Gone are the anathemas that the Church once pronounced upon its opponents—solemn curses that put them outside the Church and the salvation it offered.

Now, having lost most of its ability to threaten with spiritual damnation, torture, and execution at the hands of civil collaborators, the Roman Catholic Church has changed its tactics. Rather than calling councils to condemn its critics and their teachings, the Church chooses to ignore them. Rather than issuing canons condemning salvation by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone, the Church now prefers to blur the lines of doctrinal distinction. When engaged in dialogue with non-Catholics, the Church today stresses what is held in common, not changing its doctrine, but reformulating its answers for an ecumenical age. It now woos rather than warns. Particularly in countries where there are large numbers of evangelical Christians. it is not unusual for the church to adopt the very wording of its former critics. There are no longer heretics, only separated brethren. Some within the Church are talking of the possibility of Martin Luther being formally forgiven. Others predict that the Church will one day recognize Luther as a Roman Catholic saint! The result is that now the Church's explanation of how the mingling of the work of Christ and the work of the Catholic for salvation fits together is couched so thoroughly in biblical language that it almost sounds right. Rome's Council of Trent, which has never been rescinded, stated: "If anyone says that in the Mass a true and real sacrifice is not offered to God; or that to be offered is nothing else than that Christ is given to us to eat, LET HIM BE ANATHEMA.

In my hands and from which I presently quote is the

Catechism of the Catholic Church Revised in accordance with the official Latin text promulgated by Pope John Paul II. The numbers preceding the following statements will indicate the passages quoted in the above said Catechism.

Concerning the Mass or Eucharist (1375) – It is by the conversion of the bread and wine into Christ's body and blood that Christ becomes present in this sacrament. (1376) – The Council of Trent summarizes the Catholic faith by declaring: "Because Christ our Redeemer said that it was truly his body that he was offering under the species of bread, it has always been the conviction of the Church of God and this holy Council now declares again, that by the consecration of the bread and wine there takes place a change of the whole substance of the bread into the substance of the body of Christ our Lord and of the whole substance of the wine into the substance of his blood. This change the holy Catholic Church has fitly and properly called transubstantiation. (1414) – As sacrifice, the Eucharist is also offered in reparation for the sins of the living and the dead and to obtain spiritual or temporal benefits from God. In commentary on sickness and death the following is stated: (1517)—As the sacrament from Christ's Passover the Eucharist shall always be the last sacrament of the earthly journey, the "viaticum" for "passing over" to eternal life. For the sick and dying, the "Anointing of the sick" is fitly celebrated within the Eucharist. (1523) - The anointing of the sick completes our conformity to the death and Resurrection of Christ just as Baptism began it. It completes the holy anointings that mark the whole Christian life: that of Baptism which sealed the new life in us, and that of Confirmation which strengthened us for the combat of this life. This last anointing fortifies the end of our earthly life like a solid rampart for the final struggles before entering the Father's house.

Even a casual perusal leaves one with the obvious conclusion that the one percent is a huge "chunk of the pie." Christ's ninety-nine percent plus man's one percent equals a system of "works" that is absolutely contrary to biblical teaching. Thus the Eucharist and prayers for a deceased Pope.




ON THE LIGHT SIDE

NEWS BITS FROM HERE AND THERE



COLOMBIAN DRUG TRAFFICKERS – It has recently been discovered by authorities that a vessel, similar to a submarine, was under construction by Colombian drug traffickers in which they were planning to smuggle cocaine. It was located 370 miles southwest of Bogota. However, this is not the first time they have discovered a submarine. Back in 2000, police raided a warehouse near Bogota and found a 100 foot long steel submarine under construction. What do you suppose the drug traffickers were up to? Well, according to the head of Colombia's secret police they use the submarines to carry cocaine offshore to boats that would in turn take the cocaine to Central America or Mexico, and then eventually deliver it to the United States.

IS THE U.S. SELLING F-16s TO EASE ANTI-AMERICAN SENTIMENT IN ISLAMIC NATIONS? – Congress has recently received reports describing proposals to sell armaments to Pakistan and India. It is being promoted as necessary to improve security, prosperity, and development of the entire region as a whole. Negotiations are to begin with Pakistan on obtaining F16s and information is being requested by India for the possible sale of multirole combat aircraft. These sales would be a major shift in policy after years of sanctions. Pakistan has been in the news over its nuclear ambitions and their tolerance for Islamic extremism. President Bush tried to head off Indian worries by opening the door of conversation to them on future warplane purchases. India is contemplating a multibillion dollar purchase of fighter planes, including U.S. built or foreign made aircraft

FORMER U.S. ATTORNEY GENERAL DEFENDING SADDAM HUSSEIN – Under

President Lyndon B. Johnson's administration, Ramsey Clark served as U.S. Attorney General. However, he has now joined the defense team of former Iraqi President Saddam Hussein. On December 29, 2004, he announced in Amman, Jordan, that the U.S. should be tried for alleged "war crimes" in Iraq. It is reported that Clark has also been involved with the defense of former Yogoslav leader Slobodan Milosevic, on trial for war crimes in The Hague. Ramsey Clark, though a former U.S. Attorney General, is a frequent and longtime critic of much that is American.

UNITED AUTO WORKERS DECLARED SOME MARINES UNWELCOME – It seems a bit silly to me, but the UAW has a rule that no one driving a foreign car can park in their parking lot. Okay, I say, it's their lot, I guess they have the right to make their own rules, but it is difficult to know exactly where cars are made. For example, the Hyundai Sonata is made in Montgomery, Alabama. Ford Motor Company owns English Jaguars, Land Rovers, and Swedish-built Volvos. The PT Cruiser owned by Chrysler is manufactured in Mexico. Anyhow, that's their choice. So I guess they felt driven to set another rule for "their parking lot." The UAW took steps to ban reservists from the neighboring Marine Corps reserve center from parking in "their lot" if their cars display pro-George Bush bumper stickers. BORDER PATROL – The Senate approved a budget amendment sponsored by Senators Kay Bailey Hutchison and John Ensign that increases the number of Border Patrol agents by 2,000 without increasing discretionary spending. The \$352 million cost of the agents (Continued on page 9)

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will be offset by reductions elsewhere in the discretionary budget. The law responding to the recommendations of the 9/11 Commission, signed by

wants no border – In a news conference, March 16, 2005, Mexican President Vicente Fox declared that walls built by the United States along stretches of the U.S./Mexico border "must be demolished." Fox said that the walls are "discriminatory" – which is certainly true: They discriminate between the sovereign territory of the United States and the sovereign territory of Mexico. He also said they are "against freedom" – an arrogant and ironic statement from a man who leads a government from which

SCHOOL RETRACTS Q U E S T I O N S D I S P A R A G I N G RELIGIOUS BELIEFS

- After a presentation on the

infamous Scopes trial and the creation-versus-evolution debate, an American history teacher required his students to answer disparaging homework questions such as: "Are you willing to accept the truth as revealed by the newest and best methods of science or will you rely upon traditional notions that seemed to work for centuries?" Another question sought to undermine students' religious beliefs by asking: "Are the Biblical accounts of creation and of the miracles literally true? If not, what is the role of these tales in religious teaching?"

A vigilant parent contacted Pacific Justice Institute on behalf of his daughter, who was subjected to this assault. PJI wrote a legal demand letter to the Superintendent of Schools, reminding him that federal and state law prohibit government hostility toward religion....Moreover, California law requires written parental consent before students answer any questions which probe their religious beliefs. In response to the letter, the school principal thanked PJI for bringing this matter to his attention, and acknowledged that the questions "should not have been asked and will not be asked again."



EPISCOPAL CHURCH HIRES MUSLIM CLERIC

- The newest staff member at St. John's Episcopal church in Denver, Colorado, is a Muslim Imam. Ibrahim Kazerooni was formally installed on November 14, 2004 as the director of the church's Abrahamic Initiative, a bridge-building effort among Christians, Jews, and Muslims according to The Denver Post on 11/11/04. This is probably the first time in history that a Muslim cleric has become a staff member in a church. Church representative Greg Movesian said, "We hope this appeals to people who don't look upon people of other religions as a target for conversion but rather potential partners in maintaining a civil society." - From 1960 to 1996 Guatemala suffered through a civil war that left more than 100,000 people dead and 1,000,000 Guatemalans as refugees. At least 30% of the 14,280,000 Guatemalans whose country is slightly smaller than the State of Tennessee - are unable to read or write and 75% of Guatemalans have annual incomes that are below the poverty line. Most pastors are paid \$30-\$60 a week, and Christian school tuition is \$5 a month. The history of war and the resulting poverty in Guatemala have created numerous legal problems for the churches in that country. During the first week of January 2005, attorneys from Guatemala met with attorneys for the Christian Law Association to map out a strategy for setting up a "CLA of Guatemala." MAN DIES AT BENNY HINN HEALING CRUSADE

A 52-year-old man died of an apparent heart attack on January
22, 2005 while attending Benny
Hinn's "healing" crusade in

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Gul Miran, 42, a farmer in Nangarhar province.

Like many other farmers in Afghanistan, Gul Miran had planned to pay back the loan with the proceeds from his crop of poppies, which would eventually be turned into heroin. But as part of its steppedup effort to combat the drug trade in the country, the government had ploughed under his fields, and Gul Miran was left with nothing.

"I accepted the girl in return for my loan," said Haji Naquibullah, who had advanced Gul Miran the money. "We had an agreement. He would (pay me back) regardless of whether his crops were wiped out by the weather or by the government. "In a year or 18 months, I will marry her off to my youngest son," he said. "He is 19 years old and has been married to his first wife for two years but has not had a child yet."

Payenda Gul, who grows poppies in the Shinwar district, was forced to give his 17-year-old daughter to a 38-year-old in order to pay his debt. "When you have an agreement with an opium dealer, nothing but the opium can be paid but they cannot refuse the daughters. It is a way in which a dealer can find a wife for himself or for a son. The son may be disabled or he may be growing older and not had a wife. It is easy to present him with a pretty girl." - As reported by www.JewishWorldReview.com/ JALALABAD, Afghanistan [By the way, one editorial I recently read reminded us that at least 70% of the trafficking of drugs from Afghanistan and the Middle East are being financed by American consumers, consequently, financing our own destruction. UNSAFE ABORTIONS – Up to

10 million Asian women have unsafe abortions annually, accounting for half of all pregnancy-related deaths. The United Kingdom reports, "Britain's largest provider of abortions stands accused of advising women to circumvent British regulations on later terminations by flying to a clinic in Barcelona [Spain] where the operation is provided—illegally." *Daily Telegraph* [Bloody murderous hands worldwide.]

INTOLERANCE FOR BIBLICAL ABSOLUTES –

The concept that all cultures, all religions and all human ideas are inherently equal is the battle cry of those spouting the new tolerance and promoting the concept that there are no absolute truths. What is actually happening is that many concepts considered absolute truths by a majority of Americans for hundred of years are being replaced. One state allowed license plates that read "2Sexy" and "2Hot4U," yet denied a person who wanted to put "Pray" on

her plates, claiming it would violate separation of church and state. It's not tolerance but intolerance for biblical absolutes. Just ask someone who is pro-abortion if she is tolerant and accepting of someone who is pro-life. Or ask some who support homosexuality and gay marriage if he believes that a Christian who believes homosexuality is a sin is equally entitled to hold his position. Anything to do with Christianity must be eradicated from all public forums while religion is promoted as a positive multicultural experience.

Researcher George Barna reports that 44 percent of American's contend that "the Bible, the Koran and the Book of Mormon are all different expressions of the same spiritual truths." Of course, anyone who has even skimmed these books knows that, while there are some similarities, they are opposed to each other in many important ways.

SCHIAVO - "THE BOTTOM

LINE" – Much has been said about the Terri Schiavo case. Let us now consider Bible prophecy from 2 Timothy 3 concerning the last days. This prophecy, written 2,000 years ago under divine inspiration, is a precise description of conditions in "Christian" societies today. America is known as a "Christian nation." Professing Christians had a major role in its formation, and the majority of its citizens even today profess some sort of faith in Jesus Christ and a large percentage attend some sort of church. This is the exact type of situation the Spirit of God describes in 2 Timothy 3. It describes apostasy

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among professing Christians. The conditions it describes have always applied to "pagans" outside of Christ; it applied to those who lived before the Flood; the amazing thing about this prophecy is that it describes the same wicked conditions among those in the last days who have "a form of godliness," those who profess Christ yet commit spiritual adultery with the world (James 4:4; Rev. 17). Every point of this prophecy has some bearing upon the Terri Schiavo case, but consider just a few:

"perilous times" – If Terri could talk she would undoubtedly tell us that it is perilous times!

"men shall be lovers of their own selves" - Michael Schiavo claims that he is doing this only because he loves his wife, but his actions state more loudly that he is a lover of himself more than a lover of his wife and of God and His holy laws.

"without natural affection" - A complete lack of natural affection is required for a man to remove food and water from his wife and watch her slowly starve to death.

"trucebreakers" - Michael Schiavo made a solemn covenant or truce when he married Terri, promising before God and man to love and cherish her and be faithful to her until "death do us part," but he has brazenly broken his marriage vows. "incontinent" - incontinent means without self control: Michael Schiavo is living with a woman out of wedlock because he is incontinent.

"fierce" - what could be more fierce than for a husband, with the assistance of judges and police and doctors and nurses, to starve his wife to death?

Indeed, the Terri Schiavo case reminds me that we are in the last hours of this age, that the time is short. "He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus" (Rev. 22:20).





Bangalore, India ("When the miracle failed to save a life," Deccan Herald, Jan.23). Bogus "faith healers" like Hinn bring reproach to the cause of Christ. (No one ever died when they were seeking healing from HIM [CHRIST].) Benny Hinn claims to have received the anointing of the late female evangelist Kathryn Kuhlman, and that might well be true, as she also was bogus. In his book Healing: A Doctor in Search of a Miracle, Dr. William Nolen dedicates an entire chapter to his experiences investigating Kuhlman's healing crusades. Though sympathetic to Kuhlman as a person, Nolen was unable to document medically even one case of physical healing. At the time of his investigation, Dr. Nolen was chief of surgery at Meeker County Hospital in Litchfield, Minnesota. In his book Occult ABC, Kurt Koch described his own research into Kuhlman's healing ministry. He carefully followed up on a list of 28 cases of alleged healings in Minneapolis, Minnesota. "Ten had not been healed, seven had experienced an improvement in their condition, eleven had diseases in which the mind can play an important part. realizing the promises and power in HIS BOOK!

Dr. Ricky Tippett gave me a copy of the following. I pray we will not be trapped in this box of excuses. Let me share with you the letter written by one missionary who after 20 years of ministry observed how mission churches were handicapped by the dependence upon foreign money:

"I have kept to the last what seems to me the most serious indictment of the work of the church. Most of the churches in India are not self-supporting. This is a very serious matter. Analyzed critically, it means this: Indian Christians take their religion so lightly and superficially that they are not prepared to contribute adequately to the support of their own churches and their own ministers.

"...It seems to me that so long as Indians are not prepared to sacrifice whatever is necessary to support their churches, this is convincing proof that the church has failed in its fundamental objective—to convince people of the truth of

Christianity, for surely it is true in this, as in all ages of all peoples in all countries, that the only real test of conviction is the desire and willingness to sacrifice.

"It is a shameful thing that we cannot stand comparison in this matter with our Hindu and Muslim [people]. I think we have a right to ask the Missions why they have allowed things to come to such a pass, why they have so pauperized and weakened us that the indigenous church instead of being a sturdy, virile, self-reliant body, able and willing to be selfsufficient, is a feeble, weedy, topheavy administration, the member of which are always turning to the West with imploring eyes, and abject, outstretched hands asking for alms.

"In this, I maintain the church has failed in its most important work, and the measure of its material success in obtaining foreign men and foreign money is the exact measure of its spiritual failure in this country."

Now let us look again to The Voice in the Wilderness missionary

work. In Venezuela I give a big thank you and commendation to a pastor and his congregation for their step of faith to match dollar for dollar their giving with that of The Voice in the Wilderness for their new church construction project. The Chavez government has created problems, the people are poor, even one pastor, wife and children were robbed and terrorized; but these precious believers have been liberated from the box of unbelief and empowered by the promises of God's Book!

O' sweet chariot of mercy grace Benevolent Master show Thy face.


