about the *Wordless Book* the first week of school. While we were living in the state of New Hampshire, my parents, my brother, and I learned to trust in the Lord to supply our daily needs. God used many different circumstances to teach me to rely upon Him.

During my sixth grade year, my parents felt that God was moving them. Our new ministry was in the south – far away from our family and friends. It was while in Virginia that we had our first contact with *The Voice in the Wilderness*.

As a high school student, I started drifting from God. I graduated from high school and attended Pensacola Christian College. At PCC, even though I was around teaching and preaching of God's Word on a daily basis, I drifted away from God even more. I finally got so cold and callous that I just quit going to school.

I returned home to where my parents were serving in a new ministry in North Carolina. I started working construction for a man in the church. Through this ministry in North Carolina, God really started working on my heart. The church had a bus outreach, and I was allowed to work with the third grade boys. Upon the completion of my degree, I started teaching at a Christian school in South Carolina. Rebekah and I were married a year later and ministered in that same school the following year. It was during a teacher's conference that God started working on our hearts to do

Rebekah Lilly's Testimony

Standing outside our home, I had cornered one of my neighborhood friends. "Don't you know you're a sinner? Get saved. Get saved now!"

As a little five-year-old girl, I knelt down by the sofa in our living room and accepted Jesus as my Saviour. From that point on, I became even more a part of my parents' ministry. Because my parents had promised the Lord to always provide a Christian education for their children, I attended a Christian day school in the mountains of Vermont. As my third grade year approached, my parents followed the Lord's leading and we embarked on a new journey in my education experience – home school. The Lord's perfect direction provided us with an excellent Christ-centered curriculum that would continue to educate me through my senior year.

From Vermont through Virginia and North Carolina, across the plains to the Northwest and South to Dallas, Texas, - my life surrounded my family's ministry of serving the Lord. The challenging curriculum I learned from was constantly being supported by daily adventures.

During my senior year of high school in Dallas, after praying, searching, and researching, I said goodbye to Mom and Dad, and I set a goal to complete a Bachelor's Degree in Education at Pensacola Christian College. The Lord amazingly met every college need and

"American courts today appear to have forgotten our founders' deep roots in the Bible. This judicial amnesia could have severe consequences for our nation. Whether America thrives or flounders in the 21st Century could primarily depend upon who wins the battle for the courts in this generation. Will it be those judges who remember our biblical roots, or those who want to replace them with secular substitutes?

"For 150 years after the Declaration of Independence proclaimed America's freedom from England, our leaders universally recognized the biblical foundations that undergirded our nation's legal system. President Abraham Lincoln, who emancipated the slaves after the Civil War, still rightly understood in the mid-nineteenth century that God alone was the grantor of America's rights. He understood that the Almighty had given these rights to every person in all times and in all places, including those African slaves who had been brought to America against their will. By the close of the nineteenth century, however, America's leading jurists had set themselves on another course - one that was intended to deny the hand of God in this nation's legal

system.

"Prior to 1900, American lawyers all studied the law using a book by William Blackstone called Commentaries on English Common Law. The first 140 pages of this book outlined the biblical principles that controlled both British and American common law. America's Founders used Blackstone's principles to undergird a new legal system in their emerging nation. In fact, Blackstone's fourvolume Commentaries, published a decade before the Declaration of Independence in 1776, became more popular in America than in England. America was a blank slate for formulating a new legal system based entirely on the principles of the Bible


"After 1900, legal trendsetters like Christopher Columbus Langdell at the new Harvard Law School began to deliberately substitute evolutionary legal principles for the fixed, immutable and unchanging laws of God that were previously the basis of American jurisprudence. Charles Darwin published his earth-shattering book promoting evolution, *The Origin of Species*, in 1859. The biology principles outlined in that book almost immediately began to

infiltrate other areas of learning. One of these areas was the law, where some jurists had already been looking for a way to eliminate God from the legal equation.

"By the 1870's, Oliver Wendell Holmes, Jr. began to see the solution to an American legal system without God in the evolutionary principles of Charles Darwin. Holmes, who was considered a great legal philosopher and jurist, boldly announced in the 1870s that there was no "brooding omnipresence in the sky" (i.e. God) that mankind was obligated to be subordinate to in the legal arena. Holmes' ideas were heralded by other legal thinkers of that day as new, modern theories destined to leave behind the religious underpinnings of the past, which these jurists believed were holding back progress in the nation.

"By the beginning of the 20th Century, elite new law schools like Harvard were undermining the authority of God in the law. Legal educators eagerly abandoned the biblical principles memorialized in the Declaration of Independence, enshrined in the Constitution, and taught in Blackstone's

Commentaries.

"Lawyers began attending law schools that ignored Blackstone and taught a far-reaching, progressive legal theory of case precedents that permitted the law to evolve, expand, and grow in whatever shape these jurists desired. This was the beginning of judicial tyranny in America. Judges no longer saw themselves as subordinate to God's law, but began to believe they could alter the law in any way they thought would be best for society.

"After this deliberate judicial move away from God, American jurisprudence coasted for half a century on the collective biblical memory of the past. But, by the 1960s, American elitists in education and in other academic fields began to join these evolutionary, anti-God legal philosophers. Since then, the God of the Bible that guided and inspired the Founders and American jurists for nearly two centuries has been gradually pushed out of America's legal system.

"Blackstone, the Founders, and all early American lawyers and judges recognized that God had created humanity for Himself. Therefore, all people were entirely dependent, not only on the physical laws of the universe, but also on equally applicable moral laws. God's moral laws are as immutable and fixed as the laws of gravity and physics, said Blackstone.

"No law enacted by man, Blackstone said, is legitimate unless it reflects the moral law of God revealed in the Bible. That is the primary reason, for instance, why murder, adultery, theft, and lying are wrong. These basic principles are found in the Ten Commandments – the basis for both biblical faith and American law.

"All governments, Blackstone said, must be grounded in God's moral revelation in order to function properly. Therefore, all societies must be based on God's foundational principle of families, beginning with one man and one woman united for life.

When they have a matter, they come unto me; and I judge between one and another, and I do make them know the statues of God, and his laws.

Exodus 18:16


"That biblical revelation is the real reason why homosexual marriage is wrong for all societies. It is also the primary reason why today's homosexual advocates and many judges who support this movement are so intent on simultaneously undermining the biblical basis for law in America through an invented legal principle of 'separation of church and state,' which was first imposed on America in a 1947 United States Supreme Court decision.

"The Supreme Court's support of abortion in 1973 is illegitimate for the same reason. Supreme Court justices do not have the authority to contradict God's moral code and call it law. The erroneous legal reasoning in *Roe v. Wade*, as well as in other recent Supreme Court rulings on homosexuality and other moral issues, is merely the logical conclusion of an evolving secular legal philosophy that began heading down the wrong road in 1872 when Oliver Wendell Holmes, Jr. first declared the death of God in the legal world.

"Blackstone correctly argued that no law of society is a valid law if it contradicts the moral laws of God. That is the only legitimate basis on which to oppose the legalization of abortion, of euthanasia, or of gay marriage. The moral law of God was the foundation for all American law in both the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution.


"It is absolutely amazing to consider how strange this basic American legal philosophy now sounds in a nation where every citizen is considered 'free' to live in any sort of licentious manner. But Blackstone and America's Founders believed that all rights and all freedoms must be based on the recognition of every citizen's individual duty owed to the Creator God. Every American freedom granted in the Declaration of Independence was originally recognized by the Founders as arising from a corresponding individually

Mission Spotlight - Venezuela






The "Christ" of Catholicism stays on the cross. Did you notice the crucifix Pope John Paul II carried? The "Mass" is a perpetual sacrifice offered over and over again. Yet according to Rome's teachings, not even sufficient alone to take care of sin. In the Church of Divina Pastora at the entrance, a large room to the left houses burning candles and life size models on a cross and carrying a cross.

The oppressiveness of this place is very real. This is not the message of the resurrected Christ and life eternal through Him alone. The message of Divina Pastora is idolatry, the mass is a works system, and Catholicism is man-made religion of bondage not God's salvation by grace through faith in Jesus Christ alone!

JUDGEMENT IS TURNED AWAY BACKWARD - "...and judgment is turned away backward and justice standeth afar off: for truth is fallen in the street..." (Isaiah 59:14). Dr. Ralph Colas wrote: "Someone has said, 'things are not getting creamier – they are getting crummier!' A recent news item from New Hampshire related that Daveen Litwins, rabbi of a Jewish Reform synagogue in Florence, NH, helped write a resolution supporting gay

"The resolution declared, 'As rabbis we believe it is our obligation as people of faith to vigorously defend the dignity of every human being, consistent with the principle that each of us is created in the divine image. We are changing the basic terrain of the world we inherited.'

marriage for 100 Reform rabbis in

"While these religious leaders say they are changing the 'basic terrain of the world,' they are NOT changing the plain teaching of the Word of God. In Paul's letter to the church of Corinth he gave a list of sins, including homosexuality, but to the believers he wrote, 'And

such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of God' (I Cor. 6:11).

"I thank the Lord for those who refuse to embrace the godless culture and instead seek to obey, without reservation, the precious truths of God's Word."



SAINT'S ALIVE – The small limestone slab was retrieved from a local quarry by stonemason Johnny Beeston and his wife, Ruth, of Somerset, England, and for many years marked the final resting place of their beloved cat "Winkle." But then a local potter spied the tombstone and rightly guessed that it was no ordinary monument: At Sotheby's recently, the 10th century carving of St. Peter fetched the equivalent of nearly \$386,000.

ENTANGLED IN THIS WORLD FROM "A" TO "Z"

- One morning Christi received

a piece of paper that suddenly shattered the future for her daughter. You see, she had been served with a legal notice that she was being sued by her former lesbian co-habitant, Leslie (not her real name). Leslie was not suing for Christi's assets or her earnings. Rather, *Leslie sued for the most valuable thing to any loving mother...* the right to visit and raise her daughter.

Christi alone was the biological mother of this two year old. She alone had given birth to her. She alone was her legal guardian. Leslie had never adopted the girl. Futhermore, Christi had no legally binding relationship with Leslie via contract, marriage, or any form of domestic partnership.

But after Christi's case had been heard, the unthinkable happened. The Utah State court judge residing over the case ruled against Christi, declaring that Leslie had a right to frequent and regular visitation of Christ's daughter. This court order virtually shattered the established case precedence that had always protected the rights of legal parents and guardians over their children.

Each year, thousands upon thousands of single parents are set free from lifestyles and relationships they feel are wrong or harmful to themselves and their children. For you see, Christi had given her life to Christ and had new spiritual life. Yet, there are complicated entanglements

MUSLIMS PLAN TO BUILD 5TH MINARET ON TEMPLE

MOUNT – In a issue of *News From Israel* we read: "Jordanian Wakf officials are planning on building a fifth minaret on the Temple Mount, and Israel has not objected to the proposal, a senior Jordanian official said.

"We informed the Jerusalem police chief that we are going to build a fifth minaret at the site," said Dr. Raierf Najim, the vice president of the Jordanian Construction committee, in a telephone interview with *The Jerusalem Post* from Amman.

"Najim, who is overseeing the renovation of the southern and eastern Temple Mount walls, said the planned minaret was the brainchild of Jordanian King Abdullah II and would be constructed near the eastern wall of the Temple Mount.

"Four other minarets exist on the Temple Mount; three near the Western Wall and one near the northern wall.

"Jerusalem police declined comment, but Najim said Wakf officials inferred from the silence of the Jerusalem police chief, Cmdr. Han Franco, that Israel had no objection to the plan.

"An Internal Security Ministry spokesman said that his office was not aware of any such request, while the Antiquities Authority declined comment on the matter.

"A spokesman for Prime Minister Ariel Sharon, Raanan Gissin, told the *Post* the building of the minaret is 'within Jordan's religious autonomy' as the traditional overseer of maintenance at the site.

"Najim said construction work on the minaret – which is estimated to cost 250,000 Jordanian dinars (\$352,000) – would begin in 2005, after a design similar to the four existing minarets is completed.


"He added that the tentative location chosen for the planned fifth minaret, just north of the Golden Gate near the eastern wall, would not require 'deep excavations.'

"But leading Israeli archeologists, who have been decrying the lack of archeological supervision at the site for the past four years, lambasted the plan.

"Indicative of the close Israeli-Jordanian relationship is the fact that Franco, the Jerusalem police chief, went to Amman with his deputy to work out prayer arrangements for Muslim worshipers at the Temple Mount.

"Jordanian officials suggested that the five Temple Mount minarets would symbolize the five pillars of

Islam, which include fasting and praying, although in the interview Najim conceded that the number five was not sacrosanct, with other mosques containing fewer or more minarets." –Jerusalem Post, 22 September 2004

WHAT IS HAPPENING IN ISRAEL? – "Israel is a country with phenomenal growth. New roads, construction, and a sincere sense of optimism appeared to be the order of the day...Israelis officials...were firm in their commitment not to cave in to the forces opposing the existence of the Jewish state.

"On the surface, there is a quiet hope that Mahmoud Abbas (Abu Mazen) will rein in the terrorists and make peace with Israel. On the other hand, many leaders are suspicious, knowing that for decades Abbas was Yasser Arafat's right-hand man. Abbas has never retracted his public statement that the Holocaust never happened; and while he speaks peace to the West, his Palestinian Authority publications and broadcasts continue to spew their hatred of Israel. When the recent suicide bombing took place in Tel Aviv, Abbas condemned it to Western leaders. However, his PA publications in Arabic honored the bomber as a martyr and ran stories in support of his family.

"Psalm 83 makes it clear that those who hate God hate His people For, lo, thine enemies make a tumult: and they that hate thee have lifted up the head. They have taken crafty counsel against thy people, and consulted against thy hidden ones. (vv.2-3) Furthermore, their ultimate goal is to destroy Israel and the Jewish people. They have said, Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation; that the

name of Israel may be no more in remembrance. (v.4)

"The very real question is, does Abu Mazen want genuine peace, or is he among those who will take all they can get at the moment, then seek to destroy the Chosen People and possess their land?" *The Friends of Israel – W. Sutter 5/2005*

ESTIMATED ELEVEN MILLION ILLEGAL ALIENS

IN U.S. – The Washington Times reporter Stephen Dinan recently wrote that more than 6 million illegal immigrant Mexicans now live in the US, making up more than half of the nation's nearly 11 million illegal aliens, according to a new study. The report, by the Pew Hispanic Center, found that illegal immigrants have dispersed far more widely than 15

years ago, with nearly 40 percent now living outside of the six states that traditionally have attracted the most immigrants. Arizona is now fifth on the list, vaulting ahead of Illinois and New Jersey and trailing only California, Texas, Florida and New York. "The rapid growth of the undocumented population has been the principal driver of growth in the foreign-born populations in new settlement states such as Arizona, North Carolina, Georgia and Tennessee," wrote Jeffrey S. Passel, a senior research associate at the center. Mr. Passel's study found that between 80 percent and 85 percent of Mexican-born people now in the US came here illegally. Mr. Passel's study estimates that 485,000 new illegal immigrants arrived every year between 2000 and 2004, an increase of 23 percent, to 10.3 million in 2004. Given that rate of growth, he calculated there are nearly 11 million now. The report also estimates that there are more than 3 million US born children in families headed by illegal immigrants.

SAUDIA ARABIA - One week after arresting 40 Pakistani Christians, Saudi Arabia's mutawaa religious police broke into another private worship service, arresting five expatriate Christian elders in Riyadh. High-ranking Muslim sheikhs reportedly took part in the April 29 raid on a congregation of 60 Ethiopian and Eritrean Christians who had gathered for prayer. The crackdown on Christians has yet to provoke the Bush administration to enforce sanctions more than six months after naming the Saudi kingdom one of the world's worst religious persecutors. "We don't

FOOLISH JUDGES – ["A wise King scattereth the wicked, and bringeth the wheel over them" -Proverb 20:26; "When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice: but when the wicked beareth rule, the people mourn" Proverb 29:2; "Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil..." Isaiah 5:20.]

The Supreme Court of the United States has made yet another foolish ruling, this time determining that it is unconstitutional to execute murderers who are under 18 years of age when they commit their crimes, regardless of how heinous. The 5-4 ruling overturned the death sentences of about 70 juvenile murderers across the land. Writing the decision for the majority, Justice Anthony Kennedy said, "Our society view juveniles... as categorically less culpable than the average criminal," thus revealing that his authority is not the U.S. Constitution but the shifting sand of public opinion. God established the death penalty for murder immediately after the Flood and it has never been rescinded. God told Noah and his sons, "Whoso sheddeth man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed: for in the image of God made he man" (Gen. 9:6). This was upheld in the Law of Moses, with exceptions for accidental killings and for those committed in the act of self-defense or against a thief breaking into one's home. No exceptions were made for youth. In fact, the Bible specifically says that young rebels are subject to death. "For every one that curseth his father or his mother shall be surely

put to death: he hath cursed his father or his mother; his blood shall be upon him" (Lev. 20:9). In fact, it is not only youth who are murderers who are in danger of God's judgment. "The eye that mocked at his father, and despiseth to obey his mother, the ravens of the valley shall pick it out, and the young eagles shall eat it" (Prov. 30:17). This generation is in for a great shock when it learns that the very pampering it so loved was what kept it from learning the fear of God and possibly fleeing to Christ for safety. owed duty to God.

"Every man created by God is duty bound to subordinate himself to God in society. America was founded specifically to protect and defend the right of every citizen to carry out his duty to God as each see fit. Included in man's duties to God are the moral duties that men owe to one another when they choose to live together in societies. But the Founders never envisioned the protection of rights such as alleged 'rights' to pornography or sexual license that are not grounded in God's moral laws. On the other hand, the Founders did envision the protection of the religious expression of every individual in America. Faith is a free gift of God to be received or rejected individually. In America, therefore, even Buddhists, Muslims, and atheists are protected in exercising their own faith or lack of faith. But the basis of the freedom that even non-Christians enjoy in America is the biblical Creator God who does not force faith on anyone. If America as a society does not continue to honor and acknowledge God, all religious rights will eventually disappear along with our rights to life, liberty and happiness.

"One of the most important legal principles expounded by Blackstone was that law may only be imposed on an inferior by a superior. The King was not a superior, but was equal to the citizens and inferior to God. God is the only superior able to impose moral laws on mankind. That imposition is primarily what many modern citizens and jurists are seeking to avoid today under our 'new' American law.

"Blackstone acknowledged that there are some areas in the law where God has not clearly given moral principles to follow. One example would be whether to set the speed limit at 50 or 60 miles per hour. Blackstone calls these morally neutral laws 'municipal law,' areas where citizens are free to decide the law for themselves. However, in areas where God has clearly set down moral laws, such as in the prohibition of murder and theft, any laws imposed by governments or judges that are contrary to these moral laws of God are illegitimate.

"That is the biblical basis upon which America was founded. It is a heritage we barely remember in twenty-first-century America, but which we urgently need to acknowledge and reclaim if we intend to protect and maintain our unique and free nation and our precious system of government and law.

"Modern judicial tyranny sets itself up against the laws of God and seeks to organize society by its own rules. We must return our legal system to Godly principles if we expect our nation to endure for another 250 years. We must oppose judicial tyranny and support judges who respect God's law and who seek to preserve the moral laws of God incorporated by our Founders into the legal fabric of our nation. It is only when we resubmit our nation to God's moral laws that freedom can be protected for all our citizens and our nation can continue to be the America we have all known and loved."


