Sermon of the Month

THERE MUST BE A TURNING FROM SIN, SELF, AND SATAN UNTO THE SAVIOUR.

RESURRECTION POWER

Someone has said, "The true Christian has a MIND through which Christ thinks, a VOICE through which Christ speaks, a HEART through which Christ loves, a HAND through which Christ helps, and a LIFE through which Christ empowers."

There they were 12 cowardly disciples, hidden away in an upper room in Jerusalem. This was a fearful bunch with seemingly the whole world as their enemy. Their leader lay in a tomb and they were all alone. Put yourself in their place. You are deposited smack-dab in the middle of a hostile world. The tentacles of darkness have embedded the minds and hearts of those around you. They hate you and desire to kill you. In this world just described many who name the name of Christ will pay the ultimate and supreme price. Yet, these martyrs cannot be silenced. The blood of the witness is the seed of His church. Nearly three centuries of brutalities and atrocities will be poured out upon His people. During

ten periods of intense persecution, dynamic growth for this humble, small band of fearful disciples marks their early beginnings. How can one explain the boldness and willingness to die. when shortly before, they hid behind closed doors? The Apostle Paul said in Philippians 3:10,11: "That I may know Him, and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being made conformable unto His death; if by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead." The disciples and the early church manifested resurrection power. It was only through the truth of Christ (The Way, The Truth, and The Life - the resurrected Christ) that those who had feared could be bold, that those who had clung so desperately to life could courageously lay it all down.

I. Do you know Him?

Again the Apostle Paul said, "That I may know Him..." We too have access to know Christ and the resurrection power of Christ. This is not to know about Christ. It is not just an assimilation of facts. This is a personal knowledge and relationship with Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour. Do you know Him in the free pardon of sin? Do you know Him in His death, burial and resurrection? Have you asked Christ to forgive you of your sins, come into your heart, save your soul, and give you eternal life? The question is – Do you know Him?

II. The Power of His Resurrection

If you do not know Him, you cannot know the power of His resurrection. The power that raised Him from the dead is the power that regenerates and gives eternal life. The 120 disciples that hid themselves in fear were only able

to come out in boldness through their knowledge of Him and His resurrection power. The martyrs who courageously poured themselves out were only able to do so in the power of the resurrection.

Often the finger of condemnation is so easily pointed at Thomas. Is he not called "Doubting Thomas"? After all, he neglected that meeting. The other disciples saw the risen Lord, but Thomas missed out. Then, after eight days and it's Sunday again, Thomas, with head and heart down low, was present this time. It was going to take seeing to believe. Yes, some call him "Doubting Thomas," but Dr. Peter Marshall called Thomas or Didymus "The Palestinian Missourian." Thomas was one of those "show-me" kind of disciples. First, Jesus said, "Peace be unto you." Then said Jesus to Thomas, "Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing." Thomas got the rebuke. Now listen to what Thomas says to Jesus as he cries out, "My Lord and My God." Adonai and Elohim – My Foundation and Stay, My Prince and Judge.

Now this is the Thomas that tradition records as going to India. I have personally been to Madras and Chennai. The Christians there say it is all because of Thomas. That record of tradition says that Thomas came preaching Christ and many were born again. The story goes that Thomas was martyred, possibly by Brahmin Priests. Shot through with arrows or spears, Thomas boldly proclaimed Christ. What enabled him to go to India, the one called "Doubting Thomas," and there in that strange land, lay down his life for Jesus? Do you remember those

SERMONS IN MINIATURE

- 1. "Beware of false prophets....By their fruits ye shall know them" (Matthew 7:15, 20). "Mark them....avoid them" (Romans 16:17-18). Once upon a time, a man fell in a ditch. He screamed over and over again for help. He desperately needed to get out of that deep ditch. Confucius walked by and said, "A wise man would not walk so near the pit as to fall in." Buddha walked by and said, "Your desires make you want to get out of the pit. Change your desires." A Hindu walked by and said, "You just think you are miserable in the pit; change your thinking." Jesus walked by and helped the man out of the pit.
- **2.** Do beliefs govern actions? If so what are you doing? Is a child known by his doings? (Proverbs 20:11) Hey, what about adults!
- **3.** Some people seem to be all stings. They live a life of bitterness and criticism. It appears their goal is to bring others down – down possibly to a level that makes them look better. The story is told of a number of beehives that were moved from a cold region to a very mild tropical type climate. For a period, the bees gathered honey for the coming winter. BUT eventually the bees learned they were in a land of perpetual summer, and they ceased to work and prepare for winter. As the account goes the bees spent their time flying around stinging people. Read II Thessalonians 3:11 and note I Timothy 5:13. "...they learn to be idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not." Isn't it sad when life's only occupation is to sting?

- 4. There are those self-appointed Tare Exterminators and Wheat Inspectors who go about as champions of every juicy bit of gossip that comes along. They run off half-cocked, with half-truth and do a whole lot of damage to the cause of Christ. "He that answers a matter before he hears it, it is folly and shame unto him" (Proverbs 18:13). "And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity; so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body" (James 3:6). Persuaded they are ripping out the tares when all along they damage the wheat (Matthew 13:24-30). Their instrument "is set on fire of hell."
- **5.** Something stinks! A skunk is a skunk is a skunk is a skunk. Does a skunk ever say, "Phew Whee, what stinks?" The stink is the stinker. Then where is the source. "Thou hypocrite." One's own self is the source of the stink. Beware when a bitter, critical spirit arises. There may exist the beam (Matthew 7:3-5).
- 6. "Give not that which is holy unto the dogs, neither cast ye your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn again and rend you" (Matthew 7:6). It is a waste and dangerous to give the holy unto those who do not want the truth. That does not restrict sharing the gospel with the lost. To the contrary, they need the gospel truth. But there are those, as Matthew Henry describes, who cannot receive "instructions, counsels, and rebukes, much less comforts" being hardened scorners. They are unrecoverably and unreclaimably wicked.

REWS BITS FROM HERE AND THERE

BATTLEGROUND STATES-

This year there may be as many as 16 states battling with same-sex marriage legislation. Ten of the states could see amendments to uphold the biblical view of marriage between a man and a woman. Seven states have seen homosexual couples filing lawsuits for the right to marry. Seth Kilbourn, who is the leader of the Marriage Project for the Human Rights Campaign, said, "Let's not forget that California lawmakers passed a [homosexual]marriage bill [in 2005]. If we can defeat the ballot measure, I think we can move forward again with that bill." Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger vetoed the bill to which he is referring. Several states will have the marriage amendments on their ballots this year (Alabama, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Wisconsin, and Virginia); others are in the midst of petition drives (Arizona, Florida, Illinois); yet others are having law suits decided in their courts (California, Connecticut, Iowa, Maryland, New Jersey, New York, and Washington State). President of the Alliance for Marriage Matt Daniels (supports the biblical definition of a man and woman) says, "We're in a race" and "we don't know who will win." The Washington Times 1/2/06

clinton caught – Here is something that the news media did not cover extensively. Hillary Clinton's "New York Senate 2000" has settled to pay \$35,000 civil penalty and admit reports made to the government were inaccurate by \$721,895 from donations. Peter Paul, the man who financed the fund-raiser and filed the complaint, said, "It's a kind of vindication, but this is only one battle." Mr. Paul is suing former President Clinton and his wife on other matters. Marc Elias, the attorney for "New York Senate"

2000", said that the settlement "makes clear that there was no violation of federal election law by the Hillary Rodham Clinton for Senate Committee in connection with the Aug. 13, 2000, event." Mrs. Clinton has also given back \$2,000 in contributions to clients of the now famous Jack Abramoff. *The Washington Times* 1/2/06

IS MEXICO INVADING THE

US? – Are Mexican soldiers crossing the border and entering the United States? According to the FBI, men dressed as Mexican soldiers have entered the US over 200 times since 1996. The latest incident took place 50 miles east of El Paso, Texas. The spokesman for the Mexican Embassy, Rafael Laveaga, said, "It's just allegations. We don't deny criminal activity on the border, which would be foolish to do. Cartels are a global force right now. If there is any field where the US and Mexico have been able to build relations, it is in combating crime. We have been able to build a confidence-based relationship with the US." ONE LINERS – On the heels of his recent comments about Ariel Sharon's recent stroke being a Heavenly chastisement, Pat Robertson, due to "scheduling complexities" will not be the keynote speaker this year at the National Religious Broadcasters convention.

- -The elections in Canada took a turn to the right this year with Conservative Leader Stephen Harper replacing Prime Minister Paul Martin.
- -With the confirmation of Samuel Alito (the fifth Roman Catholic to be on the

current court) to our nation's highest court, conservatives hope that there will be a change of the Roe v. Wade law.

- -After an 18-year career as the chairman of the Federal Reserve Board, Alan Greenspan retired and turned controls over to Ben Bernanke.
- -In Idaho, State Senator Robert Geddes proposes a plan to help with overcrowding of prisons by having prisoners share beds.

SUPREME COURT SUPPORTS NEW HAMPSHIRE – According to *World (1/28/06)*, the Supreme Court

overturned previous rulings by lower courts concerning the New Hampshire law about the notification of parents for a minor to have an abortion. In her opinion, Justice Sandra O'Connor stated "states unquestionably have the right to require parental involvement when a minor considers terminating her pregnancy."

"ABORTION IN REVERSE"-

"With abortion, a mother chooses to kill her child. With euthanasia, a child might choose to kill his mother." In the recent Supreme Court case of Gonzales v. Oregon, Oregon's law was upheld. So far, this law has enabled 200 people to take their own lives. The ruling upheld the concept of state law over federal law. This is just a start of a slippery slope. Case in point - the Netherlands. Euthanasia started out only for those who asked for it; and now doctors may kill those who "lack free will" to consent to end their lives (the mentally handicapped and children). Chief Justice Roberts and Justices Thomas and Scalia voted against this law. World 1/4/06



AREAL TEST

Questions show what schools once accomplished - with a lot less money than today.



The next time you hear a plea for a tax increase in your area to enhance the quality of education, be bold enough to ask the people in charge "What enhancements have you achieved with the money you already have?"

I couldn't help thinking about that a few days ago when my wife, a favorite aunt, and I spent most of a week emptying the home of Henrietta Abels, a devoted 99-year-old Christian woman who had died not long before. In the process, we ran across a little booklet called *Stephenson's Iowa State Eighth Grade Examination Question Book*. The 59-page pamphlet, published in 1924, was to help eighth-graders take the test at the end of their elementary years that would qualify them to move on into high school.

The bottom line is that most high-school seniors in 2006 would find the eighth-grade guide of 1924 quite a challenge. The questions covered 10 different subject areas—and you might enjoy (or you might not) matching your wits against those of a typical Iowa eighth-grader 80 years ago.

Arithmetic. A wall 77 ft. long, 6 ½ ft. high, and 14 inches thick is built of bricks costing \$9.00 per M. What was the entire cost of the bricks if 22 bricks were sufficient to make a cubic foot of wall?

Geography. What waters would a ship pass through

in going from Duluth to Buffalo? With what would the boat be apt to be loaded? What, probably, would it be loaded with on a return trip?

Grammar. Define five of the following terms: antecedent, tense, object, conjugation, auxiliary verb, expletive, reflexive pronoun.

Physiology. (a) Beginning with food in the mouth, trace the course of digestion, naming the juices with which the food is mixed and the results. (b) What is the reason that spitting on the street is dangerous to the health of a community?

Spelling and Orthography. Select the proper prefix and place before each word in the following list (up, under, out, fore, over): spread, balance, hold, sight, ground, shine, current, brush, roar, burst.

Writing. Give five movements to develop accuracy in penmanship. Tell what you seek to do in using each movement.

History. (a) What colonies were founded in America because of religious reasons? By whom was each founded? (b) Give the cause, time, and result of each of the wars in which the United States has been involved.

Civil Government. Name three township, three country, and three state officers and state what office each person holds. Why do so many men dislike holding township offices?

Music. Draw a staff. Place on it the scale in half notes in the keys of G, D, and F. Write the scale that has a sharp on the fifth line and another sharp on the third space.

Planning Ahead ... First Lady Day

Dear Church Family:

The month of May brings the special opportunity to honour our Mothers. I know many churches plan a special day in May for this occasion. Here is a suggestion that will surely be a blessing for your congregation. Have a special Sunday in honour of your FIRST LADY – the Pastor's wife. Proverbs 31:10-31 describes the virtuous women. Take time to study this portion of Scripture. Thank God for dedicated wives, mothers and those special Ladies serving as one with and help-meet to Pastors around the world. The following could be used during the month of May for Mother's Day and a "FIRST LADY" day.

"FIRST" LADY FOR CHRIST ...that in all things Christ might have the pre-eminence.

For wives, mothers, and all young ladies in Christ, let us declare May as "First" Lady Month for Christ. Here is an acrostic using the word F-I-R-S-T to describe the virtuous woman of Proverbs 31.

F aith – A VIRTUOUS woman – a woman of strength made so by her faith and fear in the mercy, love, grace, and wisdom of her righteous and Holy God.

I ntegrity – A VIRTUOUS woman – a woman of holiness and wholeness, fixed and firm in honesty.

R econciliation – A VIRTUOUS woman – a woman reconciled to God with the ministry of reconciliation in the husband, home, and hearts of those around her.

S tewardship – A VIRTUOUS woman – a woman of industry well able to furnish her household.

T rust - A VIRTUOUS woman - a woman called blessed by her children, a woman trusted and praised by her husband.

In American history, the U.S. president's wife was not referred to as the "First Lady" until Zachary Taylor used the term in reference to Dolley Madison. Within a decade

Zachary Taylor's 1849 eulogy, "First Lady," had become the standard as the title of the president's wife.

Beginning with Martha Washington, many of the president's wives set forth an example of dignity and grace in their role as a leader. Though a very private person, she understood the pressures of this very public role. With her aristocratic Virginia roots, Martha Washington was criticized as too "royal" by some Americans wary of all things British. "At the same time, she was decried as too common by those who feared that her habits of recycling old gowns and of retiring early during receptions might confirm the suspensions of the world that America was an uncivilized wilderness. But to all who visited the president's house—in New York City or later in Philadelphia - Lady Washington was the model of grace and propriety; eventually these qualities won her the affection and respect of all America." Ref-First Ladies of the White House by Skarmeas, page 5.

Sara Polk and her husband brought to the White House a marriage that was a true partnership. She often told friends that she believed that she and her husband were predestined by God to lead America. Upon arriving to the White House, Sarah immediately made her presence felt. Believing that dancing in the White House rooms would be undignified, she banned all dancing, card playing, and drinking. When the "First Lady" entered the room during her husband's inaugural ball, the music and dancing ceased in her honor. Known to possess a balance of ego and humility, she used her leadership role while insisting, "I recognize nothing in myself; I am only an atom in the hands of God." Ref – First Ladies of the White House, Skarmeas, page 23.

Lucy Hayes, mocked in the press as "Lemonade Lucy," immediately established a White House policy banning alcohol at all receptions. She resisted all efforts by the temperance movement to become part of their leadership and maintained a firm belief that hers was essentially a private role in a public setting. She was the first "First Lady" to hold a college degree. She had the education, resources, and opportunity to make the role of "First Lady" an active, independent, and powerful one. However, Lucy focused on her family responsibilities and her husband. While not totally shunning public duties, she was the first president's wife to travel without her husband

and to deliver prepared speeches. Lucy also took an active role as president of the Women's Missionary Society at her church during her husband's presidency. Ref – *First Ladies of the White House, Skarmeas, page 36.*

In Titus 2:3, the mature lady in Christ is exhorted to be an example and teacher of "good things" to the younger women in Christ. Today the life support system has been removed, and death is eminent for many. The departure from the biblical model by so many women in our church today has left us vulnerable. So called "Women's Liberation" and the farming out of our Godgiven privileges and responsibilities has thrown our children to the ravening wolves. What has happened to the heart of mothers who no longer want to teach and train and love their children with the kind of affection that should be obvious to the woman in Christ?

No wonder our families, children, and marriages are out of control. The very stabilizing element so critical to the home has been eroded. Without these godly women actively engaged in their biblical role, Titus says the Word of God will be blasphemed (Titus 2:5).

CATHOLICS VS. CHRIST-

Intelligent Design has been in our media recently with the decision in Pennsylvania against the Dover school board. Now Roman Catholic teachers and priests are coming out on the side of Darwin. Fiorenzo Facchini, who is a professor of evolutionary biology at the University of Bologna, wrote in the official Roman Catholic paper, L'Osservatore Romano, "If the model proposed by Darwin is not considered sufficient, one should search for another. But it is not correct from a methodological point of view to stray from the field of science while pretending to do science. It only creates confusion between the scientific plane and those that are philosophical or religious." Another Catholic Cardinal Christoph Schonborn wrote in an article to the New York Times, "Evolution in the sense of common ancestry might be true, but evolution in the neo-Darwinian sense - an unguided, unplanned process of random variation and natural selection - is not." Newly elected Pope Benedict has also weighed in on the controversy by saying that we as humans "are not some casual and meaningless product of evolution." {Editor: We must remember that Darwin proposed a theory, not a fact. Archeologists have been digging near the biblical city of Gath recently. One of their discoveries has been a ceramic shard that contains the earliest known Philistine inscription having two names that are similar to Goliath. Also around Amman, Jordan, archeologists have discovered artifacts of the ancient nation of Edom. Until recently, scholars have stated the biblical reference to the nation was not legitimate. SAINTS CELEBRATED – It was fifty years ago that Jim Elliot, Nate Saint, Pete Fleming, Ed McCully, and Roger Youderian gave their lives trying to reach the Waodani (some of you may know them as the Auca) tribe of Ecuador. These five men's death sparked an interest in missions during the 1950's and 1960's. For those of you who do not know, Jim's wife Elizabeth and Nate's sister Rachel went into the village of the men who killed their loved ones and witnessed to them. Today there are over 200 believers of the Waodani tribe. Let us take what these five men demonstrated to us and continue on reaching the world for Christ.

IS DARWIN DIVINE?- "By now, the Christian conservatives who once dominated the school board in Dover, Pa., ought to rue their recklessness in forcing biology classes to hear about 'intelligent design' as an alternative to the theory of evolution" (New York Times). Judge John Jones III wrote in his opinion that "the overwhelming evidence is that (intelligent design) is a religious view, a mere re-labeling of creationism and not a scientific theory.... It is an extension of the fundamentalists' view that one must either accept the literal interpretation of Genesis or else believe in the godless system of evolution." SAVED STRETCHERS – Imagine yourself in a gym and hearing the following exchange: "Relax. Stretch out now, slowly. Now open your body up. Open up your mind. Now, feel the presence of God." This exchange may not be as absurd as you think. Mary Swan Murphy, a Christian who began practicing yoga about 30 years ago, is one of the 16.5 million Americans involved in yoga today. Yoga is part of the Hindu religion; but women like Mrs. Murphy are trying to change that into an avenue to worship Christ. "We're creating another entity here. We're bringing into the postures an intention of focusing on God and the Scriptures." Laurette Willis says that yoga is "the missionary arm of Hinduism and the New Age." Pastor Matt Ristuccia of the Westerly Road Church stated, "what's important is that things like yoga be an incidental part of life. Christians need to understand the broader context so that they can be aware. It's part of being a responsible Christian. And as Christians, we are meaning-makers. Jhis Month In History

Queen Ka'ahumanu served as regent-prime minister of Hawaii after the death of her husband, King Kamehameha. Together with her son, King Kamehameha II, they ended all idolatry and human sacrifice on the islands. On this date, March 31, 1820, the first missionaries, led by Hiram Bingham, arrived in Hawaii on the ship, *Thaddeus*. Hiram learned the Hawaiian language, devised a twelve letter alphabet and, with his associates, translated the Bible into Hawaiian. He originated Hawaii's first newspaper and pastored the first church. The Queen received Christ and helped spread the Gospel throughout the islands. Just prior to her death, Queen Ka'ahumanu was presented with the newly completed version of the New Testament in the Hawaiian language. Her last words were: "I am going where the mansions are ready."



Two different ministries sent out mailers advertising reading and study materials for youth. Significant was the very contemporary look and language of the publications. Even though the student books discuss how the thinking of Pop Culture is so different from Biblical teaching, the hair styles, dress, and demeanor of the young people pictured in the catalogue reflected the world not His Word. Can you believe this one title? "Post-Modern Youth: Exploring Cultural Shift, Creating Holistic Connections, Cultivating Authentic Community." One author counsels parents on how to help "Christian" teens deal with "Dirty Dancing at the Prom and other Challenges." Local Missions

Thank God for ministries like Hephzibah House who reach out to the hurting. It is often difficult to explain how many ever start down the path of rebellion. Here is an excerpt from Hephzibah's recent letter.

"We have often been asked how it is that daughters of Godly, responsible homes end up at a ministry like ours. The possible answers to this scenario are plentiful, but one is often a part of the situation: the parents have been undermined by forces and influences without their knowledge.

Obviously a youngster in a government school is going to have a myriad of voices in her life that are antithetical to those positions, principles and standards of her home. These worldly influences assure the youngster of "her rights," that her parents are: hopelessly out of touch with reality, old-fashioned, overly strict, dictatorial, and are standing in the way of happiness. This daughter will be taught the evolutionary hypothesis, humanistic values and secular goals. No wonder such a child sees little in the Biblical morality and values of her parents to admire. Living for self and for the moment are much more enticing than crucifying the flesh. Adapting the "feeling orientation" of her peers is seemingly more fulfilling than living under the "shackles" of Bible Christianity.

One can surely understand a pliable, plastic mind and a fallen nature succumbing to the godless and worldly environment of a government school, but what of the youngster who is home-schooled, or who is in a godly, separated Christian school? Many a trusting parent has found out too late that their child has been undermined by members of his extended family

(older siblings, uncles, aunts, cousins, grandparents, etc.) Other youngsters have had their head and heart turned by a member of a youth group, Sunday school class, church member or close friend or neighbor. In each case, the personality doing this evil and undermining work is a secret enemy of the parents.

These whispering adversaries of the parents have convinced themselves they need to "help" this poor, unfortunate youngster who has the sad misfortune to be in a tyrannical, "puritanical" home. Lest this hapless youngster be permanently injured by this harsh home setting, they set about to "rescue" this child from its deleterious effects. They promise aid, comfort and assistance if this daughter ever seeks "liberation" from the "chains" of her awful situation. In a season of self-will and rebellion, many youngsters decide to take advantage of these evil offers of assistance.

Parents cannot be too careful about the personalities who have access to their impressionable and naive children, especially if there is a question about the loyalty of that child to her home and family. Isolation is not the answer either, but rather seeking to gain the heart of one's child, and consequently their loyalty to the Lord and the family in which God placed them."

Venezuela Missions

"....We have seen the tension building up for several years in Venezuela. President Hugo Chavez has a goal to increase the National Guard force to 1 million men. He has bought war ships from Spain, thousands of rifles from Russia and is now junking his F-16's to purchase war jets from Russia and China....

This could very well be the 11th hour for open American missionary work in Venezuela. On January 11, 2006 President Hugo Rafael Chavez Frias of Venezuela is quoted in the newspaper "El Impulso" in Barquisimeto saying, 'The only war possible for us will be an invasion from the North American Empire. For this war we must prepare...this (marks) a change in our military doctrine.' Regardless of the causes of tension between the Venezuelan government and the current U.S. government it seems as if Mr. Chavez has placed all of his energy into an open conflict with the U.S.

Mr. Chavez is no friend to the American Missionary. He recently reacted to remarks by Pat Robertson and stopped the approval of all missionary visas.....

....During the year 2004, I either called or sent letters to over 120 pastors asking them to send church planting teams, evangelistic teams and Bible teachers to Venezuela. We wanted to train the young church leadership, have mass evangelistic crusades and strengthen the national churches. Only four pastors responded....We praise the Lord for the souls saved and the churches that were strengthened however it was a weak effort. It was weakened by the lack of urgency to reach the open hearts of the Venezuelans before they would be closed by the Communistic philosophy against the Americans and their "religion."

In this 11th hour in the harvest field of Venezuela the missionaries are not running away but charging the gates of Hell with compassion and pulling lost souls out of the fire. There are not yet four months and then cometh harvest. Look on the fields for they are white already to harvest."
