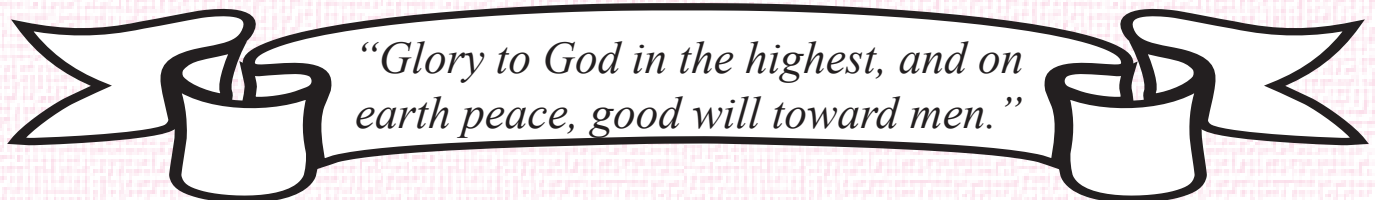

Sophie Muller

How Her Work Continues

by Bruce Peterson



Bruce Peterson met Sophie Muller and became deeply burdened for the work God was doing through her life. Now years later, Bruce continues to raise support for The Jungle Bible Institute and those that are serving in the jungle where Sophie once worked. While Sophie was ministering in the jungle and even after her homegoing, The Voice in the Wilderness, Inc. printed Bibles and invested thousands of dollars in helping the churches and workers serving along side Sophie. As you will see in the following report, there are many who have taken the mantle and today continue this pioneer work of Sophie Muller. Bruce Peterson reports:

We are very thankful that the strong work that Sophie [Mueller] began more than sixty years ago with indigenous people has continued through the Bible Institute and we have been able to train over the years indigenous people to carry out the work. At the current time there are about sixty-two people, including

children, living on the property and sixteen indigenous people are attending the Bible Institute.

In Colombia the area that we serve is an area where missionaries have left because of the political situation. This gives us a great opportunity to evangelize and disciple areas that are closed to the outside world.

In this vast area there in Venezuela and Colombia there are at least 350 villages that have churches and approximately 300,000 indigenous people.

...included [is] a picture of Sophie [Mueller] when she left to go to Venezuela. It is her passport photo as a thirty-two-year old woman and [then a rather recent photo in her hut at the Bible Institute shortly before her death...]

The entire income for the Jungle is \$3,200.00 a month which takes care of all of the staff, their families and students, plus all of the river travel which today is very expensive because of the price of gasoline. So you can see, that this is a great deal of ministry that is being accomplished over a vast area for very small investment. {Editor: Bro. Peterson and current supporters have been able to give far more than The Voice in the Wilderness in consistent monthly support for which we are thankful.}

In 1990, I had the opportunity of meeting Sophie [Mueller] in Argentina and she shared with me her thirty-year prayer request concerning a Bible Institute in the Jungles of Venezuela to carry out her work. She knew that she was coming to the end of her ministry. Two years later the project was presented to Andy and Joan Horner at Premier Designs in Dallas, Texas, and the company contributed

the initial money to build the Bible Institute. It has been a great joy these last twelve years to be involved with the Bible Institute and see many indigenous people, being taught the Word of God, and then return to their village. All of our staff, except the director are graduates of the Jungle Bible Institute.

Nowhere in the will was The Voice in the Wilderness, Inc., or Dr. J. Royce Thomason mentioned. As many know, Sophie was saved under the ministry of Jack Wyrzten. Before she left the jungle, Sophie was living at The Word of Life Bible Institute. Thankfully, today, Bruce Peterson, Total Life Management, Premier Designs, and Word of Life continue support of Sophie's work and The Jungle Institute. 





Of the 1.5 million students that took the SAT tests this past year, only 15% did so in cursive. Penmanship teachers say that students learned the cursive way so that they can understand what they are reading. (*World* 10/28/06)

If you are traveling to the Caribbean, Canada, Mexico, South America, Central America or Bermuda and are an American citizen, be prepared to take your passport with you. In order to make our borders more secure, Congress passed the Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act which will go in effect on January 8, 2007. (*The Washington Times* 10/23/06)
