In October/November, Steve made his introductory trip to India with Dr. Williamson. During a non-stop, condensed trip, they were able to travel and hold several profitable meetings with the Indian pastors that The Voice in the Wilderness has encouraged and supported over the years. Plans were to continue to travel on to Agra, India where God has enabled The Voice in the Wilderness India office to be established through God's servant, Bro. Babu, Nevertheless, under God's timing. Steve and Dr. Williamson returned to the states, before scheduled, due to the critical health of Dr. Williamson's father. Thankfully. they arrived back on US soil after a 14 hour flight, just before Albert Williamson's homegoing. Upon arrival back to our Asheville Office, we visited Dr. Jackson's office for our first 8 week check on Baby Lilly. Embedded in our hearts forever are the doctor's words, "I can't find a heartbeat." Yet God proved Himself faithful through the miscarriage by already giving us a Christian doctor in a pro-life office, wonderful parents who prayed with us, and an encouraging church family at the new Asheville Church plant. All this recorded here, not for your sympathy, but to give you the opportunity to look through our eyes and catch a glimpse of God's hands daily lifting us to heights of heavenly comfort. As we continue to work in His will, we regularly are praising the Lord for giving us the opportunity to serve in ministry. Just in January 2007 APM has been privilege to:

- Hand-out 125 tracts for the new Asheville church plant during visitation
- Hold two Bible Clubs for 40 elementary city children
- Travel in the state of Virginia representing The Voice in the Wilderness Ministries
- Teach 15 Christian school first-graders while a teacher struggled with heart and blood pressure difficulties
- Complete end-of-the-year financial reports for The Voice in the Wilderness
- Hand-package and mail 1,000 copies of the Jan/Feb publication plus 12,000 by bulk mail
- Teach Children's Church
- Minister with hand chimes music in churches as we travel
- Create a new website page for The Voice in the Wilderness, "CrossVue School of Missions" and design and record the first of many teaching mini-modules for the web
- Give 175 hours in office work for The Voice in the Wilderness—e-mail, website, missionary communication, financial, subscriber correspondence, grounds maintenance, etc.

We praise the Lord for these opportunities of service and look forward to many more that God will give. Please pray as we determine and plan for **APM's next missionary venture**, whether to the New York City, India, Venezuela, or other places desiring help from APM. Also pray as APM investigates the **prospect of expanding ministry abilities** with a certificate for Teaching English as a Second Language obtained through classes at a Bible College. This class focuses on using English as a tool for presenting the gospel to the unsaved, along with equipping the missionary with a certificate used to gain easier access into countries unfriendly to the gospel.
