The Right Kind of Fathers

their fathers by always serving the head of the house first at mealtime. Dad was given the choicest morsels at the dinner table, and a libation was poured to honor all the fathers of the tribe living and dead.

Some of the fathers of ancient Greece sat down to meals in their own special throne-like chairs. At banquets it was considered respectful for sons to anoint their fathers with oils and perfumes.

Julius Caesar was the first man to be called "Father of his country" but there have been many others since his day and in our own dear America our youngsters know George Washington by the same title, "Father of his country." Along with Washington, we have had the Pilgrim Fathers, Puritan Fathers, and the Founding Fathers who framed the Constitution. For more than a century the senior member of the House of Representatives was called "Father of the House."

THE ORIGIN OF FATHER'S DAY:

The originator of this special day was Mrs. John Bruce Dodd. Dodd planned Father's Day in 1910 as a tribute to her father, who had devotedly raised his family of six children after the death of his wife. She asked that all who had a living father wear a red rose. Those whose fathers had passed on were to wear a white rose. Although ever since then Father's Day was celebrated in many states, it was not until 1936 that the third Sunday in June as officially designated as Father's Day.

WHAT ARE FATHERS MADE OF?

Someone has said the following about fathers –

A father is a thing that is forced to endure childbirth without an anesthetic.

A father is a thing that growls when it feels good...and always laughs very loud when it's scared half to death.

A father is sometimes accused of giving too much time to his business when the little ones are growing up.

That's partly fear, too.

Fathers are much more easily frightened than mothers.

A father never feels entirely worthy of the worship in his child's eyes.

He's never quite the hero his daughter thinks...never quite the man his son believes him to be. This worries him, sometimes.

So he works too hard to try to smooth the rough places in the road for those of his own who will follow him.

A father is a thing that gets very angry when the first school grades aren't as good as he thinks they should be.

He scolds his son—though he knows it's the teacher's fault.

A father is a thing that goes away to war, sometimes.

He learns the ruggedness of a soldier's life and would run the other way except that the war is a part of his only important job in life, which is making the world better for his child than it has been for him.

Fathers grow old faster than other people.

THE TRUTH SHALL MAKE YOU FREE



The Truth Shall Make You Free

Jesus said, "Ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." The Founding Fathers of this nation understood those words from the beginning. Circulated in 1772 "The Rights of the Colonists" written by Samuel Adams stated:

"The right to freedom being the gift of the Almighty...

"The rights of the colonists as Christians...may be best understood by reading and carefully studying the institution of The Great Law Giver and Head of the Christian Church, which are to be found clearly written and promulgated in the New Testament."

Later Samuel Adams made this commentary in lieu of independence:

"Neither the wisest constitution nor the wisest laws will secure the liberty and happiness of a people whose manners are universally corrupt."

Several times I have heard a popular radio host say something to the effect that "America is great because of freedom." That's not altogether true. Remember Jesus said, "Ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." Freedom, whether it is freedom of speech or freedom of press – freedom requires responsibility and responsibility demands restraint, but there can be no restraint without right living. But how can there be right living without the Righteous One, Jesus Christ? Again, Samuel Adams stated:

"A general dissolution of principles and manners will more surely overthrow the liberties of America than the whole force of the common enemy. While the people are virtuous they cannot be subdued; but when they lose their virtue they will be ready to surrender their liberties to the first external or internal invader....If virtue and knowledge are diffused among the people, they will never be enslaved. This will be their great security."

Knowing and doing the Truth will secure freedom. This protesting parade of perverted people demonstrating against everything patriotic and pure is diametrically opposed to all that spells TRUTH and FREEDOM.

As I stood at the Liberty Bell Pavilion, the inscription, "Proclaim Liberty throughout All the land unto All the Inhabitants Thereof", moved me. The crack in the Liberty Bell reminded me how fragile liberty is. Then I was reminded of Isaiah 61:1 & 2 "To proclaim liberty to the captives..." and "proclaim liberty throughout the land..." Leviticus 25:10. Jesus is "...the way, the truth, and the life:..." hey, there is no freedom apart from Jesus.

Do protestors check the truth? Add Oprah Winfrey to the list of Rosie O'Donell protestors who do not check the facts or know the truth. Oprah says of Bowling for Columbine produced by Michael Moore, "I'm encouraging everybody to go and see it because it will really get you thinking about where we are as a nation," never bothering to check whether many of the "facts" in the so-called "documentary" were even true. Moore's seething pile of lies, half-truths and misrepresentations, was anything but what a normal person would even consider to be a "documentary." Along with that Hollywood crowd and the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences, the film's other biggest fans are the French – the French know good anti-Americanism when they see it.

In America they can protest, however where were these "anti-war protestors over the years when Saddam Hussein slaughtered hundreds of thousands of his own people—not only with artillery but with poison gas? Did American "anti-war" protestors hold huge demonstrations against him? Where were they when Saddam sent his army into neighboring Kuwait to murder, steal, and destroy? Did American "anti-war" protestors demonstrate against Iraq then?

Read on about more protestors: The native villages of McGrath, Takotna, Nikolai, and Telida in Alaska depend on moose meat as a primary food source. State biologists say there are about 500 adult moose in the 520-square-mile area. They produce about 350 calves per year. Trouble is, wolves and bears kill about 250 of those—as well as about 100 of the adult moose. The McGrath Native Village Council says the local wolf population is out of control. "The people of McGrath are suffering right now because they do not have enough food on their table," says board member Ted Spraker. To increase moose numbers, state game officials say a predator control program will help protect moose calves during their extremely

vulnerable first two months of life. But Friends of Animals, a national "animal rights" group headquartered in Connecticut, threatens to harm Alaska if it harms any predators. However, the governor of Alaska approves the Game Board's plan.

Keep reading – more protests. I call this "San Francisco Style." The 9th U.S. Circuit Court of appeals says it could immediately ban the use of the Pledge in the public schools of nine Western states. But it will hold off until the U.S. Supreme Court rules on the case. In the decision last summer, the appeals court upheld a lawsuit by Sacramento atheist Michael Newdow. He had sued the Elk Grove Unified School District for requiring his eight-year-old daughter to say the Pledge of Allegiance. So the 9th U.S. Circuit Court ruled that the words "under God" make the Pledge "unconstitutional." However, our President and his administration have strongly condemned last summer's ruling along with the House of Representatives that voted 400-7 to condemn the court's actions also. It is to be noted that Michael Newdow is divorced, and his daughter lives with her mother. Mother and daughter do, however, support the use of the Pledge of Allegiance.

The protests against the TRUTH are becoming more and more open and obscene. Since 2000, WRAZ-TV in Raleigh, NC, has instituted a policy that says the station will not broadcast reality programming that demeans marriage, according to the Raleigh News and Observer newspaper. That policy developed after the Fox network produced one of the first reality shows. We commend those of WRAZ in Raleigh for their stand against this direct attack on decency. On the other hand, the soap opera "ALL My Children" has recently aired the first daytime lesbian kiss. Of viewers polled 41 percent said go for it and 33 percent

expressed disgust. The Hollywood and TV debauchery continues to plunge to even lower degradation.

There are protests and debate within the United Nations. The president of Rwanda, Paul Kagame, believed that waiting for U.N. approval to stop Saddam could be tragic. After all, he had seen what could happen. In 1994, Rwanda's Hutu government led a 100-day massacre of members of the minority Tutsi tribe. They slaughtered as many as a million people in homes, churches, and even hospitals. But the United Nations did nothing but debate "the situation in Rwanda." Now President Kagame says, "I wish the same people had demonstrated when genocide was taking place in Rwanda." One cab driver in Rwanda even reported that he survived the 1994 genocide by hiding for two months in a pit latrine.

Samuel Davies preached what was needed for peace during the troubling American Civil War period:

"Ye that love ease and shrink from the dangers of war; yet that wish to see peace restored once more; ye that would be happy beyond the grave and live forever – attend to my proposal. It is this: A THOROUGH NATIONAL REFORMATION. This will do what millions of money and thousands of men, with guns and swords and all the dreadful artillery of death, cannot do – it will procure us peace again, a lasting, well-established peace."

All fifty state constitutions speak of the Almighty God of the universe, who gave America Freedom and liberty.

George Washington said, "No people can be bound to acknowledge and adore the invisible hand which conducts the affairs of men more than the people of the United States." Our National Anthem proclaims: Praise the power that hath made and preserved us a nation!...And this be

In response: Please let me explain. It takes 30-60 days for any request placed on our mailing list to go into effect. It takes 30-60 days for your request to be activated. So, a request submitted the last of March will be entered into the system and the subscriber should receive the May issue.

NATIONAL AND WORLD NEWS

SCHOOL **PUBLIC TEACHERS WARNED TO** STIFLE THEIR ANTI-WAR **PROPAGANDA** - The Education Commissioner in the state of Maine had to warn elementary and middle school teachers to stifle their anti-war propaganda. Dozens of complaints were received about students being told that anyone fighting in a war against Iraq would be unethical. Some students had just said good-bye to parents sent overseas while others came home from school "upset, depressed, crying."

WHAT HAS **SENATOR** HILLARY **RODHAM CLINTON BEEN UP TO LATELY?** – Well, Senator Clinton aggressively is moving fundraising and policy matters and fueling speculation that she plans to run for president in 2008. She brought civil rights leaders to Washington to discuss a broader campaign against Bush judicial nominee Miguel Estrada. Even to the chagrin of some Senate Democrats, she is assuming a bigger role in crafting the party's agenda and message for the next election. Clinton was recently awarded a seat on the Armed Services Committee. This will provide her an opportunity to build a foreign policy resume in the years ahead. These new roles are providing her the ideal forum to put her imprint on Democratic policies, cement her relationship with key

party activists and lay the groundwork for what several senators and party strategists believe will be a presidential run in 2008. However, some Democrats want Clinton to run now, though many strategists believe she should give voters another four years to forget, or at least forgive, the scandals that dogged her husband's eight-year presidency. Senator Clinton has said she will not run in 2004 and "has no plans to" in 2008. But several Democrats said her White House ambitions are growing increasingly apparent. The Washington Post 3/5/ 03



ARE YOU EXERCISING **YOUR BRAIN? - Studies show** that by the time we reach 85 half of us will have some form of dementia. However, doctors are also saving there are ways to delay the onset of mental deterioration. So, just think about it. If you build muscular strength by physical exercise, your brain is also strengthened through mental exercise. Dr. John Morley, director of geriatric medicine and a professor at the St. Louis University School of Medicine says, "When you live in front of a television screen, you're not using your brain. Instead, you need to consistently challenge your brain so it will age healthfully." That old saying I've always heard "use it or lose it" seems to apply here. The brain goes quicker if you don't use it. Dr. Morley recommends reading, listening to the radio, undertaking new projects and taking an active part in meaningful conversation. He suggests that you exercise your brain every single day.

COULD AN FBI AGENT HINDER AN INVESTIGATION INTO OSAMA BIN LADEN? – The

FBI has an agent on its payroll who actively hindered an investigation into Osama bin Laden, even before the events of 9/11, and more recently stalled a probe into those who actively funnel monies into known terrorist organizations. HOMESCHOOLERS THREATENED BY PENDING BILL – The California

Senate is presently considering a bill that could greatly intimidate homeschoolers and other parents in California. SB 950, which is sponsored by Senator Alarcon, would add "habitual truancy" to the definition of child abuse in Welfare and Institutions Code Section 300. This provision enables a child to be immediately taken from their family and put into the juvenile court system with no prior opportunity for parents to make their case. Under present law, truancy is addressed through the school district, where parents are entitled to make a defense before any action is taken against the child or family. Those who would potentially lose their children as a result of this bill would include homeschoolers wrongfully accused of truancy or any child who has up to five unexcused absences. Such unexcused absences usually include family vacations outside scheduled school vacation days. "This dangerous bill creates an unnecessary fear that parents will have their children taken with no due process whatsoever," said Brad Dacus, president of the Pacific Justice Institute. Should this become law and be enforced against nontruant families, the Pacific Justice Institute will contest this in federal

court as a fundamental violation of parental rights. *Pacific Justice Institute 3/16/03*

PAKISTANI CHRISTIANS FEAR INCREASED

ATTACKS – Identifying Christians with Americans, Muslim clerics make serious threats. Pakistani Christians fear the rhetoric may spark an attack on Christians. "Tension and fear are increasing day by day," a confidential spokesman told Christian Aid. "Please pray that our Heavenly Father will give us wisdom and courage to face this situation." New laws, if adopted, will make praying five times a day mandatory for all residents; all business will have to cease during those times, wearing the national dress will be compulsory, women's freedoms will be greatly curtailed, and Islamic education will be compulsory for all. "Christians are particularly concerned that the implementation of Shariah law will formally legitimize the persecution of non-Muslim communities."

And while mothers can cry where it shows...fathers have to stand there and beam outside...and die inside.

Fathers are men who give daughters away to other men who aren't nearly good enough...so they can have grandchildren that are smarter than anyone else's.

Fathers fight dragons...almost daily.

They hurry away from the breakfast table off to the arena which is sometimes called an office, or a workshop. There, with calloused, practiced hands they tackle the dragon with three heads; Weariness, Work, and Monotony.

And they never quite win the fight but they never give up.

Knights in shining armor...fathers in shiny trousers, there's little difference as they march away to each workday.

I don't know all that good fathers do when they go to the life beyond, but I've got an idea that after a good rest, he won't be happy unless there's work to do.

He won't just sit on a cloud and wait for the girl he's loved and the kids she bore. He'll be busy there too...repairing the stairs...oiling the gates...improving the streets...smoothing the way.

DAD, ARE YOU TOO BUSY?

In these days of the high cost of living, most fathers have to work long hours, possibly on two different jobs, in order to keep the wolf away from the door. It is very easy in such case to neglect to show your children

the love they need. It will be easy for you to decide to rest on Sunday instead of going to church with them. One of the most beautiful sights I ever see is to look down from the pulpit and see a whole family seated together in a pew. The church service is not a convention to which the family should merely send a delegate. It is something that should be looked upon as a family duty. You owe it to your children to set them a religious example. You brought those children into the world. God has entrusted them to your care, and you must not fail in your awesome task. One of the best definitions I ever heard of parenthood was given by a little sixyear boy. He said, "Parents are just babysitters for God."

The Bible is clear in the fact that a man who does not provide for his family is worse than an infidel, and my hat is off to any father who works hard and long to make an honest living. However, that is not the most important thing in life. Fathers, don't let your "business" cause you to lose your children. So often we hear someone say, "If I had it all to do over again, I would spend more time with my kids." I have heard others say, "My children used to want to talk with me, but I was too busy to listen. Now I want to listen, but they are too busy to talk to me." If you do not take the time to get acquainted with your children today, tomorrow they will be strangers to you.

In the affluent society in which we live, too many people have the wrong idea about so many things. We are prone to pity the children who do not have all the things we see others have. We get the misconceived idea that what they need is the abundance of things. How many times have I heard young dads say, "I came up the

hard way and never did have much. I don't want my children to have it rough like that. I am going to give them everything they need." The truth of the matter is that your desire to save them from what you term "a hard life" may just be the worst thing you can do. I believe that any informed person who deals with the confused, wayward youth of today will tell vou that the problem with most of them was not the absence of things they did not have, but the pampering with abundance. I cannot pity the child who does not have expensive material things nearly so much as I do the one whose father does not have time to play with him, talk with him, and pray with him.

COMPANIONSHIP

Dad, you must begin early in your child's life to relate to him if you want to be able to communicate in the teen years. You cannot buy your child's affection with expensive gadgets, cars, motorcycles etc. Friendship, companionship, affection is a result of two people sharing a significant moment. It comes from having a common experience. A father must give of himself and make time to do so. An unknown poet once wrote —

When mother comes and tucks me in,
She says she trusts me so.
She knows I'll be kind and true,
Wherever I may go.
But, when Dad comes and tucks me in,
He leaves the room a sight.
Most everything is all upset,
By our big pillow fight.

Fathers, you have a tremendous

privilege to build for eternity. Your houses will some day crumble. Your stocks and bonds will become useless one day. Your cars and boats will become outdated, but that child's immortal soul lives on.

MUST ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY

Every child, in order to have a well-rounded, properly adjusted life, MUST have a strong male and strong female image with which to identify. I think most child specialists are agreed that the boy needs a strong male image more than the girl does. She needs a clearly defined female image more. However, the girl also needs a father's companionship. According to figures I have been able to gather, the majority of cases of adolescent girls committing suicide, or attempting to do so, are cases where there is parental deficiency a poor father-daughter relationship.

One of the saddest tragedies that have ever befallen our country is this insane trend toward a unisex society. men looking like women and women looking like men. Several leading New York psychologists made an extensive study of the abnormal behavior of so many of today's youth. They too found that much of it could be contributed to the fact that the children did not have the proper parental influence. They reported that one reason so many boys don't seem to be able to decide whether they want to portray the male image, strive to identify their gender, or else style their hair like women, wear feminine clothing etc., is because they did not have a strong male image in the home. Likewise, the girls who wish to dress mannish and assume the role of men are often those who have no strong female image. Mother wears pants and bobbed hair to look like a man, smokes cigarettes, drinks liquor and "cusses" while daddy wears long hair, even longer in some cases than mom's, wears his clothes fashioned almost identically with those of his wife, and the child grows up hardly knowing which is his father and which is his mother. Now this is not the idea of some prejudiced crackpot but rather the finding of learned men who have spent a lifetime studying human behavior.

Dr. Tell Forrest, a psychiatrist for the William Alanson Foundation has made some startling disclosures on this subject and one of his colleagues from Reed Army Hospital says, "When fathers do not take leadership roles, boys so often are overcome with femininity and take on an exaggerated masculine behavior to conceal it."

The worst result when Dad doesn't assume responsibility and leadership, when he fails to be the very zenith in masculinity, he then creates the modern Mom who is obliged to, or else desires to take over completely in her son's and daughter's life. This reversing of sex roles in the home is creating much of our psychological and sociological problems. Someone has said, "Even though he may be a senator, governor, college president, or industrialist, a man may make his most significant contribution to his country by the farreaching, yet unsung, kind of job he does as a father."

A MODEL PRAYER FOR FATHERS:

Dad, I hope you are a praying father. If you are not, you are failing in one of the most important fields.

Effective prayer can never be that which is read from some prayer book. It can never be that which has been committed to memory and then said over and over. However, may I give you here a model prayer that will just about cover every aspect of your duty as a father? From it you can enlarge your sincere prayer to God.

"I have a boy to bring up. Help me, Lord, to perform my task with wisdom and kindness and good cheer. Help me to see him clearly, as he is. Let not my pride in him hide his faults. Let not my fear for him magnify my doubts. Quicken my judgment, so that I will know how to train him to think, and to be in all things, pure and simple.

"Give me great patience and long memory. Let me remember the hard places of my own youth, that I may help when I see him struggling, as I struggled. Let me remember the things that made me glad, lest I forget that the child's laughter is the light of life.

"Teach me the love that knows no weakness, tolerates no selfishness. Keep me from weakening my son through granting him pleasures that end in sickness of soul. Grant that I may love my son wisely. THE STAR-SPANGLED BANNER

The "Banner' was a most substantial physical object weighing about 200 pounds. It was 30-feet high with a fly of 42 feet having an area of 1,260 square feet. The red and white stripes were two feet wide. Its white stars were hand woven and hand-dyed explicitly for its creation. The flag contained about half-a-million stitches and was flown from a staff that was 97 feet high. A crew of two dozen men was needed to handle it.

This Star-Spangled Banner was a battle flag created during the War of 1812. It outlasted the British bombardment of Fort McHenry, with untrained militia and guns that dated back to the Revolution. Their unbending defiance was expressed even in the huge flag.

Oh, say, can you see, by the dawn's early light,
What so proudly we hailed at the twilight's last gleaming,
Whose broad stripes and bright stars, through the perilous fight
O'er the ramparts we watched, were so gallantly streaming?
And the rockets' red glare, the bombs bursting in air,
Gave proof through the night that our flag was still there,
Oh, say does that star-spangled banner yet wave
O'er the land of the free and the home of the brave?


