

On June 14, 1954, President Eisenhower supported and signed into law the Congressional Act, Joint Resolution 243, which added the phrase "under God" to the Pledge of Allegiance: "In this way we are reaffirming the transcendence of religious faith in America's heritage and future; in this way we shall constantly strengthen those spiritual weapons which forever will be our country's most powerful resource in peace and war." President Eisenhower then stood on the steps of the Capitol Building and recited the 'Pledge of Allegiance with the phrase "one nation under God" for the first time.



## My Personal Message To You

Dear Friends:

At our recent Sunday School Class fellowship, one of the newest members was asking about The Voice in the Wilderness. I shared a bit about the missionary work and printing ministry. Then came the obvious question. I cannot recount the number of times family and friends have asked, "What do preachers do all day?" I've asked the same thing about some of you lay people too. So the question is mutual I'm sure.

Well quite frankly, it was interesting to outline our monthly routine even for myself. On the first of each month the material for *The Voice in the Wilderness* publication is due for the following month's edition. For example, you hold in your hand the September edition of *The Voice in the Wilderness*. This material for September was given to Ron, our graphics and layout person, on August

5th, 2003 (our target date is around the first of the month). It took Terry and I several days to organize the research (this research is worked on almost every day throughout the month) for this issue and then type out the approximately 40-page manuscript before emailing the material to graphics on August 5th. Then about two or three days later a proof copy is ready for us to look over. The proofing process takes about two days before going to film.

Sometime after the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month we print out The Voice in the Wilderness missions checks as well as a letter of encouragement to each individual missionary. The exact date in which the checks go in the mail depends primarily on when the money comes in. For seven years now (since I've been serving with The Voice in the Wilderness) never has there been enough money given each month to

meet the monthly goal for missions. I was once asked, "Do you know what faith promise is?" I responded with the question, "Have you ever lived by faith promise?" The Voice in the Wilderness, its missionary outreach, as well as my grocery bill are all operated on faith and free will gifts of those who care. The most grievous time of each month for me personally is when it's time to send money to our missionaries who desperately need that check from The Voice in the Wilderness, and yet the money has not come in. Finally, when funds are available, it takes at least an additional day to ready them for the post office and mailing. But, oh, what a joy it is to help some of our Lord's choicest servants carry the gospel light to a world of darkness.

Then sometime about mid-month my wife prepares and updates the computer mailing list on disk for the Bulk mailer. Shortly thereafter we receive enough copies of the current edition of *The Voice in the Wilderness* to package for our overseas subscribers and church bundles. The bulk mailer handles the domestic mailing and we handle the overseas and church bundles. Terry and I need to be in the office a couple of days around the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month just to take care of this process.

Now in between all that comes the regular mail flow, recording contributions, sending receipts, bookkeeping, phone calls, answering letters, inquiries, questions, research for *The Voice in the Wilderness* publication, (calling, writing,

### CHRISTIAN EDUCATION Part II

(See the August 2003 Issue for Part I)

The Rev. Jonathan Dickinson, first president of Princeton said: "cursed be all that learning that is contrary to the cross of Christ." By the way, it is very interesting to note that every president of Princeton was a minister until 1902.

In 1740 Thomas Dilworth published his book, *New Guide to the English Tongue*. Noah Webster used Dilworth's book along with the Bible in his earliest school here in America. Dilworth stated his objective was to "[Rescue] poor creatures from the slavery of sin and Satan by setting 'the word of God for a Lantern to our feet and a Light to our Paths.'" The first lesson in Dilworth's schoolbook started out by teaching words with three letters or less. Note carefully the theme:

No Man may put off the Law of God.
The Way of God is no ill way.
My Joy is in God all the Day.
A bad Man is a Foe to God.

Noah Webster stated: "Education is useless without the Bible. The Bible was America's basic textbook in all fields. In my view, the Christian religion is the most important and one of the first things in which all children, under a free government ought to be instructed...."

The founders and Charter of Yale College made their goal and intentions perfectly clear:

"Every student shall consider the main end of his study to wit to know God in Jesus Christ and answerably to lead a Godly, sober life."

Yale's Charter states "Which has received the favorable benefactions of many liberal [generous] and piously disposed persons, and under the blessing of Almighty God has trained up many worthy persons for the service of God in the state as well as in the church."

Faculty member Benjamin Silliman wrote this testimony:

"It would delight your heart to see how the trophies of the cross are multiplied in this institution. Yale College is a little temple: prayer and praise seem to be the delight of the greater part of the students."

Education in America had such a rich heritage deeply rooted in the Bible—God's Holy, Inspired, and Infallible, Word. How then today is it that many so- called "Christian Schools" employee progressive philosophy, teach from secular textbooks, and have gone the way of the world in dress, music, and standards? Even "Christian Colleges" have moved far from the old paths by teaching students there are errors and contradictions in the Bible. Mom's and Dad's have farmed-out their God-given responsibilities while they chase the dollar and pleasures of this age. It seems so simple to me. We can have a happy home. Our children do not have to go to the devil. We must get back to the Book!

For my wife and I, we made the education of our daughter a priority. After prayer and research we made the choice to home school. This would not only be a commitment but

also a lifestyle. Now I am not saying this is the only path that would be right in the sight of the Lord. Yet the God-given responsibility to rear and train our daughter was taken seriously, and we simply tried to follow God's leadership and direction for our family. Just as we would study, compare, and learn about any product that would have a direct influence on our life, we did the same in searching for an educational curriculum. At the top of our list was to find a Bible-based curriculum. It was to be one that had the Scripture foundational throughout the teaching not just added on to the end. We were looking for the strongest Biblically based in education we could find. Next on the foundational level was a curriculum that covers all the basics beginning with phonics for reading. After research we choose a complete curriculum, organized a schedule for a nine-month school calendar, set the time of school training each day, and then notified all our friends, relatives, and church folk that my wife and daughter would be working at home Monday-Friday. We asked that they respect this designated time and not disturb us until school time was over each day, unless of emergency. You may ask, why be so rigid? Simple. God had blessed us with a child. We had dedicated that child back to Him for His service. It was imperative that we do our very best to educate, train, and direct her to do her best for Him. By having a schedule, set time, and solid curriculum, we were teaching

her character, obedience, discipline, and hard work, along with the fundamentals of reading, writing, and arithmetic. I know many of you see young people today that are rude, characterless, or cannot follow through on commitments, etc. Somewhere the fundamentals are not being taught. May God help us all to do what is right.

This responsibility must be with the parents. As Christians my wife and I took this very seriously. Repeatedly I have become acquainted with marriages that are a mess. Pastors cannot find men qualified to be deacons due to divorce and remarriage. Dare we ask what's wrong with the kids? Dare we ask what's the problem at school? Dare we ask what's wrong with America? Dr. David C. Gibbs, Jr. explains this sad plight in his article in The Legal Alert July 2003 www.CHRISTIANLAW.org "When I think of America in 2003":

"When I think of America, I remember a nation where morality was once defined in the pulpits and was encouraged by the Congress and all fifty state legislatures. I remember a nation where compassionate, committed individuals honored God and cared for each other and their communities. I remember a nation where Americans believed in the Word of God and were committed to following the principles established therein. I remember an America where the church provided the social values to build strong communities. families. and governments.

However, when I look at America today, things appear quite different. Sadly, I see a dramatic decline in our nation's view of morality.

 Over 50% believe that having a baby outside of marriage is morally acceptable.

- Only 34% believe that gambling is morally wrong.
- Nearly six out of ten Americans consider sexual activity between unmarried persons as acceptable behavior.
- While less than 10% consider cloning humans to be acceptable, over 50% of Americans believe that medical research using stem cells obtained from human embryos is morally right.
- 66% of Americans believe that divorce is morally acceptable.
- One out of four Americans believes that abortion should be allowed "under any circumstances."

## THE BREAKDOWN OF THE FAMILY

The decline that I now see in the basic moral fabric of America is evidenced by a corresponding breakdown in our nation's family structure.

- In the last 20 years, the number of children raised in single-parent homes has gone up 230%.
- Today, over 30% of all children do not live in a two-parent home, and one in four children live with a single parent.
- Last year, one third of all lesbian households had children living with them.
- One-third of all births, including 40% of first births, last year were to unmarried women, and nearly two-thirds of women under age 25 having their first child were not married.
- Nearly 20% of children between the ages of 12 and 14 are sexually active, and approximately 15% (one in seven) of sexually active 14-year-old girls become pregnant.

#### **ALCOHOLISM**

Rampant abuse of alcohol and drugs also illustrates and corresponds

with the decline of morality in America.

- 10.5 million adults exhibit symptoms of alcohol abuse, while 7.5 million are considered "problem drinkers."
- Nearly one in five adults lived with an alcoholic as a child.
- Over 25 million Americans drove under the influence of alcohol last year, and 8 million drove under the influence of illicit drugs.
- 47% of high school students reported that they had used alcohol within the last 30 days.
- Over 90% of high school seniors have tried alcohol, and almost one-third of these admitted having more than 5 drinks in a row in the last two weeks.
- Nearly 50,000 newborns suffer each year from Fetal Alcohol Syndrome, Alcohol Related Birth Defects, or Alcohol Related Neurobehavioral Disorders.

#### **DRUGS**

- 6% of Americans Abuse illegal drugs, and another 10% are addicted to prescription drugs.
- Use of the drug "ecstasy" increased 71% since 1999, and 1 out of 12 high school seniors have tried it.
- Tobacco use is the number one cause of preventable deaths in the U.S. causing one in five deaths overall.
- Over 100,000 teenagers become regular smokers every year.
- 29% of senior high school students reported being offered drugs at school.
- One in four students admitted using marijuana within the last 30 days.
- 20% of high school seniors smoke daily.

VOODOO **DECLARED** OFFICIAL RELIGION BY HAITIAN **PRESIDENT ARISTIDE** – Voodoo has been declared an official religion by the government of Haiti. Haitian president Jean-Bertrand Aristide issued an executive decree declaring Voodoo a religion with the same status and rights as others on the island. #### SAME-SEX MARRIAGE -

Canada's federal government has

unveiled draft legislation to legalize same-sex marriage. The proposed law would change the definition of marriage from the union of a man and a woman to the union of "two persons to the exclusion of all others." It also states that religious communities would remain free to define marriage as they see fit. Canada's justice minister says the draft legislation takes nothing away from traditional marriage, but ensures equal treatment for all Canadians. Same-sex marriage is already legal in Ontario and British Columbia. Agape Press 03..... MEANWHILE, BACK ON THE HOMEFRONT -President Bush said he respects homosexuals but draws the line at gay weddings, and he disclosed government lawyers are exploring measures to legally define marriage as a union between a man and a woman. "I believe in the sanctity of marriage. I believe a marriage is between a man and a woman, and I think we ought to codify that one way or the other." Bush said, "That is the definition of marriage, and we've got lawyers looking at the best way to do that." President Bush went on to say, "I am mindful that we're all sinners, and I caution those who may try to take the speck out of the neighbor's eye when they got a log in their own." Gay-rights activists took offense at Bush's comment "we're all sinners," interpreting the remark as directed at them. "While we respect President Bush's religious views, it is unbecoming of the president of the United States to characterize same-sex couples as 'sinners," said Matt Foreman, the National Gay and Lesbian Task Force's executive director. STEM-CELL RESEARCH CLONING ENDORSED BY AMA – The American Medical Association (AMA) issued a statement showing endorsement of cloning and stem-cell research, even though both processes result in killing human embryos. Many doctors are alarmed and dismayed that the organization would take a stance that actually violates the tenet of the Hippocratic Oath that has governed medicine for hundreds of years: "first do no harm." AMA has gone from representing 90% of practicing physicians in the U.S. to currently representing only 40% said Dr. Eugene Rudd of the Christian Medical & Dental Associations. COURT HANDS DOWN Landmark Parental Rights Decision – In

California the Ninth Circuit set new precedence for the protection of parents and children from social workers who abuse their discretion. The decision reversed a three-judge panel decision, and strips social workers of the absolute immunity enjoyed by prosecutors. Social workers will now only have limited, qualified immunity for their actions, similar to police officers. "This case is about social workers no longer being given the same immunity as prosecutors. For the last fifteen years, they had unfettered discretion to do what they wanted. They will now be held accountable when they maliciously violate the rights of parents of their children. This is a landmark case for increasing the accountability of social workers. After all these years, a social worker will now need to think twice before abusing the rights of parents." *Brad Dacus, The Pacific Justice Institute* 7/03

U.S. prosecutors are preparing to interview 12 Chinese citizens after Beijing agreed for the first time to let U.S. law enforcement authorities question witnesses in China. Scott Christie, the assistant U.S. attorney prosecuting the case in New Jersey, said 11 of the 12 Chinese due to be questioned are employees of Datang, the Chinese company alleged to have received the stolen trade secrets. China recently agreed to allow the FBI to station an agent in Beijing as part of the US's extended intelligence-gathering activities in the "war on terror." Business Standard, 2/03

#### SHIPPING OUT **SELLING OUT AMERICA** - In

the August 2003 *Time* magazine the following story was reported. "U.S. companies are expected to send 3.3 million jobs overseas in the next 12 years, primarily to India, according to a study by Forrester Research. If you've ever called Dell about a sick PC or American Express about an error on your bill, you have already bumped the tip of this "offshore outsourcing" iceberg. The friendly voice that answered your questions was probably a customerservice rep in Bangalore or New Delhi. Those relatively low-skilled jobs were the **HISPANICS HOPE FEDERAL** first to go, starting in 1997.... By taking advantage of lower wages overseas, U.S. managers believe they can cut their overall costs 25% to 40% while building a more secure, more focused work force in the U.S.... On the other side of the world, educated Indian workers are quickly adjusting to their new status as the world's most sought-after employees.... Financial-services companies in the U.S. are expected to move more than 500,000 jobs overseas in the next five years, according to a survey by management consultant A.T. Kearney, and India is by far the top destination. U.S. banks, insurance firms and mortgage companies have been using outsourcing to handle tech support for years. Now these firms are using Indian workers to handle the business operations - say, assessing loan applications and credit checks - that the technology supports.... In April, J.P. Morgan Chase said it would hire about 40 stock-research analysts in Bombay – about 5% of its total

research staff. Novartis employs 40 statisticians in Bombay who process data from the drug company's clinical research.... Outsourcing lower costs by playing the savings game:

**EXPANDS** BILL **OPPORTUNITIES** - Tomas graduated high school with honors and now attends college. He hopes to be either an architect or a computer programmer someday, but admits it seems like a dream. Tomas isn't a U.S. Citizen though he's lived here for 10 years. His parents came to the U.S. illegally. His father has legal residency, but the rest of the family is still waiting to obtain their own. Tomas is counting on the passage of the federal Student Adjustment Act (H.R. 1684). It would allow students like him, who have lived in the country for more than five years and demonstrate "good moral character," to pay in-state college tuition, rather than the more expensive out-ofstate rates given to students who don't have legal residency. However, the bill probably will not be voted on for another year or two. North Carolina now has the fastest-growing Hispanic population of any state, having seen a rise from 76,726 in 1990 to 378,963 in 2000. Now consider this – Would a bill that offers in-state tuition rates to illegal aliens reduce opportunities for U.S. citizens and deserving legal immigrants? Do all our school systems have adequate and abundant classroom facilities and staffing at present or would we need to build larger, bigger schools?..... OPEN BORDERS – According to the Immigration and Naturalization Service, at least 78,000 illegal aliens from terrorsupporting or terror-friendly countries live in the U.S. They are among an estimated seven to eleven million illegal aliens who have crossed our borders illegally, overstayed visas illegally, jumped ship illegally and evaded deportation orders illegally. More than 300,000 illegal alien fugitives, including 6,000 from the Middle East, remain on the loose despite deportation orders. As many as 1,000 illegal aliens a day trample across the border at Organ Pipe National Monument in southern Arizona. Some 200,000 illegal border-crossers and 700,000 pounds of drugs were intercepted at Organ Pipe last year alone. *Imprimis 4/03....* Immigration will account for 96 percent of the increase in the school-age population over the next 50 years. Take a look at the following chart:

If we are serious about meeting the needs of children already living in the U.S. – immigrants and native-born alike—then it is imperative that we take a real look at how mass immigration is affecting the schools, job employment, health care, etc.

#### CDC REPORTS TOO MANY POCKETS OF LATE-VACCINATED TODDLERS –

About 75 percent of the nation's toddlers get vaccinated on time, protecting them from getting and spreading - nine diseases. But coverage varies widely among states and major cities, with pockets of the country where far too few youngsters are up-to-date on their shots, federal health officials recently warned. Getting shots late or not at all does not just endanger the unvaccinated child. He or she in turn can spread disease to people with weakened immune systems like elderly grandparents, friends with cancer, pregnant neighbors or younger children a reason that so-called community immunity is vital to public health. Also many of those who enter this country illegally are coming from countries where no vaccination effort was given and therefore are living here without proper immunization. But since they are here illegally, they will not go and take care of health needs. Much of the U.S. health care system such as hospitals, clinics, health departments, are overburdened even now with those who need financial assistance, or perhaps have no insurance. Again, if we are concerned about those who are here legally in the U.S. and need financial assistance with health care, we must attempt to control the ever-increasing flow of immigration.



IF YOU PLACE YOURSELF IN THE PUBLIC EYE, THEN BE PREPARED TO BE IN THE MORNING NEWS: Sen. John Edwards acknowledged recently he was late in paying property taxes on his homes here and in North Carolina. The tax bill, sent out in February and due March 31, might have been lost in the mail. Edwards might not have received it because he sold one house, moved into a rental, then bought his current \$3.8 million home in the Georgetown neighborhood. Wake County, NC, records show Edwards has been tardy paying property taxes every year but one between 1994 and 2002. The 2003 bill for \$9,782 was just sent; Edwards' Raleigh home is worth \$987,091. He also has been late making some yearly car tax payments in North Carolina. "People pay late when they are short of cash, "said Thad Beyle, a political scientist at UNC-Chapel Hill, "but that likely wasn't a problem with Edwards. Sen. Edwards is seeking the Democrat nomination for President. ACT 8/03 -[The "poor" Democrats certainly have an elected official in John Edwards who understands poverty!]

#### JUDGES WANT TO KEEP PARENTS OUT OF THEIR CHILDREN'S AFFAIRS – The

Florida Supreme Court in a 5-1 decision, struck down a 1999 law signed by Gov. Jeb Bush that requires parents to be notified at least 48 hours before their children under 18 can obtain abortions. Their reasoning; The privacy guarantee under the Florida constitution applies to everyone, including minors, and is stronger than such rights provided under the U.S. Constitution.

**ONE-WAY TICKET** – A Republican who wants to replace Rep. Bernard Sanders as Vermont's sole member of the U.S. House, is offering the avowed socialist a one-way ticket to Scandinavia. The Washington Times reported on 7/03 that Mr. Sanders, an independent, interrupted Federal Reserve Chairman Alan Greenspan when Mr. Greenspan told a House committee that the U.S. had the world's highest standard of living. Mr. Sanders said that honor belongs to "Scandinavia." Greg Parke, a Republican who wants to replace Mr. Sanders said, "I suppose if you are a socialist and believe that half of your income should be confiscated by the government, Scandinavia would truly be heaven on Earth. Therefore, I am hereby offering Bernie Sanders a one-way ticket to Scandinavia. What might surprise my socialist opponent is how outdated his views truly are. #### SEXUAL ABUSE

- 67% of victims of sexual assault are under age 18.
- 34% of sexual assault victims are under age 12. One out of every seven victims of sexual assault is under age 6.
- 40% of offenders who victimize children under age 6 are under age 18.
- An estimated 325,000 children under 18 are victims of "commercial sexual exploitation" such as prostitution and Internet exploitation.

#### **VIOLENCE**

- Students commit 14,000 violent crimes against teachers every year.
- 10% of all teachers have been threatened with injury by their students.
- Over 800,000 children, ages 12-17, carried a handgun last year.
- Approximately 3 million youths were at risk for suicide during the past year.
- In the last 20 years, reports of missing children have increased 468%.
- Every 40 seconds, another child is reported missing in America.
- For every three babies born, one child is aborted.
- Homosexual advocates promote the idea that same-sex relationships are normal, while a staggering 39% of women and 23% of men in homosexual relationships reported physical abuse.

#### SEXUAL CONTENT

"Our failure as Christians to continue to influence public morality has allowed our culture to become saturated with sexually explicit content.

• 20% of adults admit to visiting a sexually oriented website, and

- such websites had 27.5 million visitors last year.
- One in three children, ages 10 to 17, from households with computers have experienced unwanted exposure to sexually explicit material online.
- In a study of time spent online during one month, children spent nearly 65% more time on Internet pornography sites than they did on Internet game sites.
- The average American will view 14,000 sexual references on TV each year.
- The "family hour" of prime time television now contains an average of more than 8 sexual incidents.
- Nearly one-third of television "family" shows contain sexual references.
- Two-thirds of all TV shows last year contained sexual content.

"When we read these statistics and remember that the majority of Americans still identify themselves as Christians, we must ask ourselves some difficult questions. What is being preached today from America's pulpits? Are Biblebelieving Christians striving to influence our communities for Christ? Are we regularly involved in winning others to the Lord, or are we content to watch America become a secularized nation that value other "diverse" religions (or no religion) more than it values the Biblical Christianity on which it was founded?

"A closer examination of how Americans view homosexuality and abortion reveals a growing trend among Americans, and even among some Christians, to separate their own personal moral convictions from the shared morals convictions that should guide society.

 60% of Americans think that homosexual acts should be legal.
 Yet 29% of those who think

- homosexual conduct should be legal still believe that homosexuality is morally wrong.
- Only 37% believe that abortion is morally acceptable. However, nearly 80% believe that abortion should be legal in at least "some circumstances."
- Even 15% of those who think abortion should be legal under any circumstances still believe that abortion is morally wrong.

"Allowing this dichotomy between what is legally permissible and what is morally acceptable denies the fact that every society needs to have a shared set of moral principles that it enforces. Those that claim government cannot or should not legislate morality forget that even in secular societies, government legislation still indicates to the nation what that society believes is morally acceptable.

"Today, there is an increasing advocacy for a "diverse" society that not only encourages immoral behavior but also seeks to quiet all Christian opposition to such immorality. While claiming in the name of "tolerance" to respect the beliefs of all, many Americans are now critical of any opinions that contradict the secularization of society, particularly those that arise from Christian beliefs. Sadly, these statistics show that many Christians have allowed such criticism to deter them from defending their faith in the public arena. However, we Christians should never allow ourselves to embrace the secular definition of "tolerance" in order to excuse our own complacency. We abandon moral principles to our own detriment, to the detriment of our children, and to the detriment of society as a whole.

"As Christians, we cannot allow hostility toward Christianity to silence us. Rather, such criticism



became a dedicated Christian. He once explained to a searching congressman friend: "If you are convinced you are a sinner, that Christ alone can save you from the sentence of condemnation; if you make an unconditional surrender of yourself to His service, He will in no wise cast you out."

Francis Scott Key became a lawyer, a district attorney for the District of Columbia, and was considered a "devout and exemplary man." He often taught a Bible class, and had Bible reading and prayers twice a day in his home. He was very busy as a prosperous lawyer, and in his own family, for he had eleven children.

One statesman had often scoffed at Christianity and studied other religions, but he watched the life of Francis Scott Key, and the Lord used Key's witness to bring the man to the Lord.

He was thirty-five years old when he boarded the British ship

to intercede for some prisoners. Key was told he would be detained because of the attack that was soon to take place. He paced the floor and watched as the early light of day would dawn. The flag was still there! He pulled out a letter from his pocket and began to write words down to express his feelings. Little did he realize he was writing the national anthem of the United States.

I have often wished his other hymns were as well-known, for they express his faith in the Saviour and the atoning blood. Here is one great evangelical hymn with wonderful words of praise to God. Mediate on this hymn!

Lord, with glowing heart I'd praise Thee
For the bliss Thy love bestows,
For the pardoning grace that saves me,
And the peace that from it flows....
Praise, with love's devoutest feeling,
Him who saw thy guilt-born fear,
And the light of hope revealing
Bade the bloodstained Cross appear....
Let Thy love, my soul's chief treasure,
Love's pure flame within me raise
And since words can never measure,
Let my life show forth Thy praise.
