I. Faith

A Game Warden in the Upper Peninsula of Michigan sat in his church's Missions Conference. He was deeply moved by the challenge of Faith Promise. Who are you? Here are the marks and distinctives:

- A. We believe "Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith;" Hebrews 12:2.
- B. We believe "For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ." I Cor. 3:11. Jesus said, "I will build my church..." Matt. 16:18.
- C. We believe God's Word sets forth the autonomous/ independent local Church with the episkopos (pastor) and diakoneo (deacon) -1 Tim. 3 - as officers of the church

NEEDLES THAT DON'T HURT: Researchers at the Georgia Institute of Technology may soon deliver an ouchless alternative, called microneedles. These near-invisible pokers, made from silicon, metal, glass or biodegradable polymers, are as much as 500 times smaller than an ordinary hypodermic – too minute to irritate nerve endings, says Mark Prausnitz, lead investigator for Georgia Tech's microneedle research program.

An array of 400 embedded in an adhesive patch could gently puncture the skin, making it permeable to extended-release medication such as insulin, which contains protein molecules too large to slip by skin cells unassisted. Or, attached to a syringe, a single microneedle could deliver drugs directly to cancer cells. Though licensing deals are already in the works, the technology must still be cleared by the FDA. Expect your painless shot within the next five years. -*Popular Science 3/2004*

ZELL EXCELS AGAIN: Sen. Zell Miller (D.Ga.) has become the first Democratic senator to cosponsor SJ RES 26 (HJ Res 56 in the House), the Federal Marriage Amendment. The lead Senate sponsor is Republican Sen. Wayne Allard of Colorado. In addition to Democrat Miller, the Senate cosponsors so far include five Republicans: Sam Brownback (Kan.), Jim Inhofe (Okla.), Jeff Sessions (Ala.), Jim Bunning (Ky).), and Richard Shelby (Ala.). *Human Events 2/2004*

WHERE HAVE ALL THE **JOBS GONE?** By 2015 more than 3.3 million U.S. jobs are projected to leave the United States. About 14 million jobs or 11% of the U.S. total have been identified as "at risk" of being sent abroad. Such jobs as telephone call centers, data entry and computer operators, business and financial support, paralegal and legal assistants, diagnostic support accounting, services, and bookkeeping, and payroll are "at risk." SO. WHO IS ABLE TO **DETERMINE AGE?** Isn't there a way to figure out how old a person is based on biology – DNA from blood or cheek-swabbed cell. There are no biological tests that can determine with any accuracy one's age. According to Steven Austad, author of Why We Age," if the person is extremely elderly, over 75 or 80, it's very difficult for anyone to estimate better than within, say, 20 to 25 years, how old they are." A countless number of factors influence the aging process, most notably one's genetic history, socioeconomic status and personal habits. Until we better understand the intricacies of aging, there will be no algorithm, no deterministic way for a doctor to enter a set of facts and a blood test into a computer and have it spit out an age. Life, to put it simply, is too complex. Popular Science 3/2004 [Note: "Life is too complex." Yet, life could evolve from nothing!! Then over a short span of 100 years or so

FREEDOM OF RELIGION??

VIETNAM: Government recognizes Catholic, Protestant, Buddhist, Cao Dai, Hoa Hao, and Muslim religions. However, authorities curtail religious activities deemed threatening to the state. Some 400 congregations with the Evangelical Church have been shut down. Church buildings have been demolished and authorities have tried to force Protestant ethnic minorities to recant their faith.

SAUDI ARABIA: State religion is Wahhabism, a stringent Sunni school of Islam. Members of all other religions are forbidden from worshipping publicly. Non-Muslims may worship in private, but in practice don't know when their activities will attract the attention of the "religious police." They risk imprisonment, lashings, and deportation. Distributing non-Muslim literature, including Bibles, is illegal.

ERITREA: About half the population is Christian, but only Muslim, Orthodox Christians, Catholics and members of the Evangelical Church may worship without registering. *World 2/2004*



THE POPE & THE EPISCOPAL BISHOP: T h e Pope's June encyclical on Europe concluded: "There must be entrustment to Mary. The whole Church looks to Mary."

The Episcopal bishop of Virginia has told his diocese's annual meeting that it's better to live with heresy than split the denomination over homosexuality. Someone has said: "Better to be divided by truth than united in error." *Calvary Contender* 3/2004

AMERICA'S CIVIL

RELIGION: Ancient Rome was religiously inclusive, working all its cultural religions into a single civil religion. DNA MORMONS AND **EVIDENCE:** Recent DNA evidence questioning the accuracy of Mormon history is providing an open door to evangelism of Mormons. The Book of Mormon describes how Israelites emigrated to the Americas 2,600 years ago, with the now extinct Lamanites and Nephites becoming the ancestors of American Indians. But anthropologists say there is no match of Jewish DNA with that of American Indians. An inaccurate Book of Mormon creates questions about the foundation of Mormon teaching. BAPTIST BRAWL: Robert Sloan, President of Baylor University is pushing a plan that would make the Southern Baptist school a world-class research university while also strengthening its Christian identity. But it seems the "old regime" (Baylor's previous president and some faculty) are doing everything they can to keep Baylor from being recognizably Christian.

In an article in *Christian Century*, Robert Benne analyzes the conflict between the new administration – which, along with the younger generation of faculty members, believes that Christianity can inform academic excellence and the old guard who "disagree with Sloan's contention that Christianity has intellectual content."

Twenty percent of the Baylor faculty opposes the Baylor 2012 plan, which builds up the graduate schools, requires faculty scholarship, and, most importantly, mandates that the content of Baylor courses reflect Christianity. Forty percent are neutral, and 40 percent support it. Critics of the efforts to re-Christianize Baylor argue that integrating faith and learning will make the university lose credibility in the secular academic world.

Mr. Sloan has hired some highpowered scholars who are committed Christians. The church desperately needs a research university with PhD. Programs, so that talented Christians can pursue education at the highest level, without wasting time with the obstacles put before them by the anti-Christian academic establishment.

But the academic world itselfbogged down in pseudo-knowledge such as porn studies, politically correct but bogus "reconstructions" of history, and an overarching relativism that makes learning all but impossible—could use a Christian university. Without some foundation for truth. the educational enterprise cannot last for long. World 2/14/04 [By the way, some "fundamental Christian schools" recommend secular institutions to their own graduates in order to give credibility to credentials!]

NEWS BITS FROM HERE AND THERE



FUNDAMENTAL LAW IN **IRAQ:** The founding fathers of a new Iraq are set to publish their first blueprint for constitutional government. Major points of concern will cover the conduct of future elections, religious freedom, Kurdish autonomy, and control over oilfields. In one area, in particular, the two drafts differ over how to define religious freedom. The agreement stipulates that the constitution "will also respect the Islamic identity of the majority of the Iraqi people, while providing guarantees of religious freedom for all Iraqis." Leading Shiite cleric Ayatollah Ali Sistani has prodded thousands of Muslims into the streets not only to protest the existing plan for elections but also the contest constitutional language diluting the clerics' power over state affairs.

The potential for religious conflict was underscored on February 14, 2004, when four Baptist pastors from the United States traveling south of Baghdad came under attack. Insurgents, riding in a car behind the Americans, sprayed their vehicle with bullets, killing John Kelley, 48, a Baptist pastor from Rhode Island, and wounding three other American clergymen.

An Iraqi Baptist pastor in Baghdad said the group was traveling on what is locally called the "Babylon Road," having ordained a local pastor to start a new church south of the capital. They had been in Iraq for nearly two weeks.

How this constitution is worded will determine whether the rule of law applies when Christians and other minorities are attacked. *World* 2/28/04

NO MERCY – Sudan: For 20 years, there has been civil war between Sudan's Muslim government and Christian communities in southern Sudan. Government planes, helicopter gunships, and troops have been attacking the Fur people in the Darfur region bordering Chad. Although most Furs are Muslims, they are treated as enemies of the government because they are non-Arab.

Gangs of "Arab militia" called Janjawid (armed horsemen) carry out most of the ground attacks, supported by government forces. They have massacred thousands of civilians and tortured thousands more. More than half of Darfur's one million people have been forced from their homes. At least 100,000 of those have fled across the border to refugee camps in Chad. Sudanese planes have bombed refugee camps on both sides of the border.

Darfur is in a remote part of the country. The government has cut access by aid groups and human rights monitors. The United Nations now regards the worsening situation in Darfur as probably the worst humanitarian crisis in the world at this moment according to the UN undersecretary for human affairs. *God's World News 3/2/04*

readers who are the compassionate ones have no room in their hearts for someone who maintains the scriptural position held by many Bible believing churches and preachers less than a generation ago. Prayer, the Bible, the sanctity of life, and the Ten Commandments have been willingly surrendered by that compassionate crowd of – "In the name of love and unity" *churchgoers*.

Charles Wysong, president of The American Rights Coalition, puts it succinctly: "So what the Federal Courts mandated for the Courthouse, Christians had already done voluntarily to their own walls. But what the ACLU meant for evil, God meant for good." This statement was made in lieu of the Ten Commandments being forbidden in a Georgia Courthouse by order of the 11th Circuit Court of Appeals.

After this action was taken, The American Rights Coalition of Tennessee decided to conduct a survey throughout just "one" county. The results should be interesting to note:

- 1. Of the fifteen Christian bookstores, only one had a copy of the Ten Commandments.
- 2. Of the fifteen Christian schools in the area, only one had a copy anywhere in their building.
- 3. Of the twenty churches surveyed, only one had a copy on public display.

Then in another survey by The American Rights Coalition, they found that less than one percent of teens and adults in sound Bible churches can name the Ten Commandments.

"What neglect! These are the family values' that God intends

DEFICIT OF DECENCY IN AMERICA:



Zell Miller (D-GA) delivered the following speech on the floor of the United States Senate 2/12/04 addressing several social issues facing the country:

"The Old Testament prophet Amos was a sheep herder who lived back in the Judean hills, away from the larger cities of Bethlehem and Jerusalem. Compared to the intellectual urbanites like Isaiah and Jeremiah, he was just an unsophisticated country hick.

"But Amos had a unique grasp of political and social issues and his poetic literary skill was among the best of all the prophets. That familiar quote of Martin Luther King, Jr. about 'Justice will rush down like waters and righteousness like a mighty stream' are Amos's words.

"Amos was the first to propose the concept of a universal God and not just some tribal deity. He also wrote that God demanded moral purity, not rituals and sacrifices. This blunt speaking moral conscience of his time warns in Chapter 8, verse 11 of the book of Amos, as if he were speaking to us today:

"That 'the days will come, sayeth the Lord God, that I will send a famine in the land. Not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the word of the Lord. 'And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east. They shall run to and fro to seek the word of the Lord, and shall not find it.'

" 'A famine in the land'. Has anyone more accurately described the situation we face in America today? 'A famine of hearing the words of the Lord."

"But some will say, Amos was just an Old Testament prophet – a minor one at that – who lived 700 years before Christ. That is true, so how about one of the most influential historians of modern times?

"Arnold Toynbee who wrote the acclaimed 12 volume A Study of History, once declared, 'Of the 22 civilizations that have appeared in history, 19 of them collapsed when they reached the moral state America is in today.'

"Toynbee died in 1975, before seeing the worst that was yet to come. Yes, Arnold Toynbee saw the famine. The 'famine of hearing the words of the Lord.' Whether it is removing a display of the Ten Commandments from a Courthouse or the Nativity Scene from a city square. Whether it is eliminating prayer in schools or eliminating 'under God' in the Pledge of Allegiance. Whether it is making a mockery of the sacred institution of marriage between a man and woman or, yes, telecasting around the world made-in-the-USA filth masquerading as entertainment.

"The Culture of Far Left America was displayed in a startling way during the Super Bowl's now infamous half-time show. A show brought to us courtesy of Value-Les Moonves and the pagan temple of Viacom-Babylon. "I asked the question yesterday, how many of you have ever run over a skunk with your car? I have many times and I can tell you, the stink stays around for a long time. You can take the car through a car wash and it's still there. So the scent of this event will long linger in the nostrils of America.

"....[Zell Miller goes on to describe in detail music, rap, dancing, etc. in the entertainment world.]

"But as bad as all this was, the thing that yanked my chain the hardest was seeing that ignoramus with his pointed head stuck up through a hole he had cut in the flag of the United States of America,

"This is the same flag that we pledge allegiance to. This is the flag that is draped over coffins of dead young uniformed warriors killed while protecting....[that kid]. ways, including the Pledge of Allegiance and the display of the Ten Commandments. And today I join Senator Shelby and others with the Constitution Restoration Act of 2004 that limits the jurisdiction of federal courts in certain ways.

"In doing so, I stand shoulder to shoulder not only with my Senate co-sponsors and Chief Justice Roy Moore of Alabama but, more importantly, with our Founding Fathers in the conception of religious liberty and the terribly wrong direction our modern judiciary has taken us in.

"Everyone today seems to think that the U.S. Constitution expressly provides for separation of church and state. Ask any ten people if that's not so. And I'll bet you most of them will say 'Well, sure.' And some will point out, 'it's in the First Amendment.'

"Wrong! Read it! It says, 'Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion or prohibiting the free exercise thereof.' Where is the word 'separate'? Where are the words 'church' or 'state'?

"I highly recommend a great book entitled *Original Intent* by David Barton. It really gets into how the actual members of Congress, who drafted the First Amendment, expected basic Biblical principles and values to be present throughout public life and society, not separate from it.

"It was Alexander Hamilton who pointed out that 'judges should be bound down by strict rules and precedents, which serve to define and point out their duty.' Bound down! That is exactly what is needed to be done. There was not a single precedent cited when school prayer was struck down in 1962.


"These judges who legislate instead of adjudicate, do it without being responsible to one single solitary voter for their actions. Among the signers of the Declaration of Independence was a brilliant young physician from Pennsylvania named Benjamin Rush.

"When Rush was elected to that First Continental Congress, his close friend Benjamin Franklin told him 'We need you...we have a great task before us, assigned to us by Providence.' Today, 228 years later there is still a great task before us assigned to us by Providence. Our Founding Fathers did not shirk their duty and we can do no less.

"By the way, Benjamin Rush was once asked a question that has long interested this Senator from Georgia in particular. Dr. Rush was asked, are you a democrat or an aristocrat? And the good doctor answered, 'I am neither.' I am a Christocrat. I believe He, alone, who created and redeemed man is qualified to govern him.' That reply of Benjamin Rush is just as true today in the year of our Lord 2004 as it was in the year of our Lord 1776.

"So, if I am asked why – with all the pressing problems this nation faces today – why am I pushing these social issues and taking the Senate's valuable time? I will answer: Because, it is of the highest importance. Yes, there's a deficit to be concerned about in this country, a deficit of decency.

"So, as the sand empties through my hourglass at warp speed – and with my time running out in this Senate and on this earth, I feel compelled to speak out. For I truly believe that at times like this, silence is not golden. It is yellow."
