Apologies From America

Inevitably as I travel to the mission field, groups from all around the United States have gathered in airports to visit missionaries from Mexico to Peru, to India and the Philippines. It has become quite fashionable to take a "Missions Trip." Yet, I am embarrassed and indignant about the testimonies these American church groups are exporting around the world.

It was a Sunday night and my wife, daughter, son-in-law and I were in the car planning to visit a church we had been told about by a friend. As we drove into the parking lot it immediately became apparent that there was either no evening church service or we had missed the time. There were only a couple of automobiles and two or three individuals in sight. I drove up to one gentleman and ask him, "Do

you have a church service tonight?" He replied, "Well, no, our sports teams meet on Sunday evening, and we have some small groups meeting in homes." So we thanked him and proceeded back out to the highway. I knew of another church not very

far away. We headed to that location, thinking they surely had an evening service - but again, the same thing - a practically empty parking lot. About the time we arrived, two men drove up in their car and proceeded toward the church door. I drove over to them, stopped, and asked, "Do you have church tonight?" The answer was rather shocking, "No, Sunday nights are movie nights. Tonight we are showing Gods and Generals. You might get a little religion out of that," the man responded. So, back out to the highway again! It's now getting rather late, and we are not sure if we will find a church open tonight or not. There's one more opportunity close by. Sure enough, there is a parking lot full of cars, but no one in sight, so obviously the service has already started. The four of us entered the rear of the auditorium and took a seat near the back, while a group of rather interestingly dressed folk sang from the choir loft. Now, to make a long story short - this church group had just returned from a "Missions Trip" to Mexico. The 47 member missions team, male and female, were wearing white T-shirts with their church emblem on the front. They sang a number of choruses and *Kumba-ya* type songs. There were also a number of testimonies in which the individuals seemed sincere. Then there was a slide presentation.

Later that evening my wife asked me if I noticed anything particularly interesting about the slides. My immediate observation was that the Mexican church people were dressed far more appropriately than the American missions team. The Mexican ladies wore dresses while the majority of the American women wore jeans.

Several years ago, I had the privilege to take an outstanding group of college age young people to Venezuela. After our nine day visit, the national pastor, as well as the America missionary, told me how much they appreciated the testimony, spirit, and standards of our group. We had ministered in song, preaching, house-to-house soul winning, and had a very fruitful missions trip. Some time before our group went to Venezuela another team had visited in which their dress and ministry was unacceptable. The Venezuelan pastor was even forced to refuse them opportunity to sing in his service, due

to their inappropriate dress.

Is it compromise? Has the Word of God changed? Does music, dress, philosophy and standards shift with the times and culture?

Probably 30 years ago, I first heard a dear brother and pastor preach. My what a pulpiteer. Such an impression his messages had on this young preacher. Repeatedly, I heard him as again and again he challenged my life. Then, I received an e-mail that this man of God was about to cross over to glory. In that e-mail the writer gave a wonderful tribute and closed with II Timothy 4:6-8. The passage was copied from the New American Standard version. It has been a long time since I have heard this brother preach, but years ago, it was the KJV all the way. Possibly, he would have objected to the NASV quote.

Then during that very same period of time, a mailing came out from a Bible College that I respected for many years. It was an advertisement for their "Senior Days." Listed as requirements for dress, the brochure stated, "Men should wear a collared shirt and dress pants to classes and chapel. Jeans and athletic pants can be worn for other activities (no shorts, please). Women are asked to wear a skirt or dress to classes and chapel. Jeans, khakis, capris, or knee-length culottes are appropriate for free time (no shorts, please)."

There was a time in recent history that this school would never have allowed jeans or capris on the young ladies. And those culottes have become "walking shorts" and a joke among the young people. So you mark it down, the parentheses will disappear from their literature real soon.

There will be severe accounting for the ungodly export by American

churches of this modernistic, carnal compromise to the regions beyond. It is our own *United States of America* standing in need of mission teams from afar coming here holding for the pure, uncompromised Word of Life.

For almost nine years I have been traveling to India. It has been quite grievous to repeatedly encounter American groups bringing worldly philosophy, standards, multiple Bible versions, and contemporary music to India. Again, it's often the case where

many of the Indian church members have much higher regard for Biblical separation than the mission teams from America. With many readers from other countries around the world. I feel compelled to apologize for the confusion often created by the steady parade of American trekkers purporting to represent Christ in your countries. It is inconsiderate and thoughtless, let alone, unbiblical to misrepresent our Lord in this manner. Please count this as an apology from America. Should we not have higher regard as ambassadors for the One whom we represent?

The apostle Paul writes in II Corinthians 10:16-18, "To preach the gospel in the regions beyond you, and not to boast in another man's line of things made ready to our hand. But he that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord. For not that he that commendeth himself is approved, but whom the Lord commendeth." I heard one preacher describe this section as glory giving and glory living. It should be our desire to do all to the glory of God.

After all, we are doing God's business, and this business is:

- I. A serious business.
- II. A soul winning business.
- III. Our Sovereign's business.

Yes, this business of carrying the Gospel of Jesus Christ is a serious business. To preach the Gospel in the regions beyond requires us to be sober and vigilant (I Peter 5:8). Again, this is a serious business – a life and death venture. We are dealing with the eternal, never dying souls of men.

"What shall it profit a man if he gain the whole world and lose his own soul?" (Mark 8:36). Do we see the value of one's soul here as weighed against the value of the whole world? And then, Proverbs 11:30, "He that winneth souls is wise." When we venture out with the gospel from Jerusalem to the uttermost – to preach the gospel in the regions beyond – it is indeed a serious business, a soul winning business.

Could those who dare go to foreign shores claiming to be on a mission do so without recognizing that this is our Sovereign's business? Jesus said in John 20:21 "As my Father hath sent me, so send I you." Whether in Mexico, Venezuela, India, or just next door, people are watching. How do we represent Christ? Again Jesus said, "As my Father hath sent me...." It is inconceivable that the Father sent or Jesus went in such a casual manner as we see so many go today. The dress, attitude, and total demeanor do not reflect the spirit in which the Father sent His Son. This is our Sovereign's business; as the Father sent the Son, we are being sent by the Son to represent the Father in the same manner in which Jesus represented His Father. SEDUCING SPIRITS AND DOCTRINES OF DEVILS

Is there any question that the celebration of Halloween is satanic, connected to the Druid Festival of the Dead? The devilish mixture of religion produces a destructive instrument. Pope Boniface IV consecrated the Roman Pantheon to the Virgin Mary using it as a temple to pray for the dead and added the ungodly, unscriptural teaching of Purgatory. Then Gregory IV added to the confusion, and the feast became known as All Saint's Day. On the contrary, *Malta Network* reports that Cardinal Ratzinger (current Pope Benedict XVI) applauded German writer Gabriele Kuby for "educating the public" concerning Harry Potter's "subtle seduction" that is "undermining the souls of Christianity." Going a giant leap further is John Granger in his book *Looking for God in Harry Potter* which states that "the gospel has rarely, if ever, been smuggled into the hearts and minds of readers so successfully and profoundly" (*ChristianityToday.com*).

Still another form of this seduction that is invading our children today is the card game Yu-Gi-Oh. Focus on the Family Online reports that the cards originated in Japan and "were a flop until the artists included mild cartoon erotica." Now this fad has spread to our American homes as a child's game of fun and a Saturday morning cartoon. The cartoon includes the dark, the evil, the Ouija board, mysticism, etc. (*Focus on the Family.com*) Beware of seducing and evil spirits. Please know the Scripture:

- [1] Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;
- [2] Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;
- [3] Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth.
- [4] For every creature of God is good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving:
- [5] For it is sanctified by the word of God and prayer.
- [6] If thou put the brethren in remembrance of these things, thou shalt be a good minister of Jesus Christ, nourished up in the words of faith and of good doctrine, whereunto thou hast attained.
- [7] But refuse profane and old wives 'fables, and exercise thyself rather unto godliness.
- [8] For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.
- [9] This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptation.
- [10] For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Saviour of all men, specially of those that believe.
- [11] These things command and teach.
- [12] Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity.
- [13] Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.
- [14] Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of the presbytery.
- [15] Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all.
- [16] Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee.



A LEGACY LEFT BEHIND?!

Recently, my wife and I went on family vacation with my parents to visit my uncle and aunt in Connecticut. While there, we visited my Dad's old stomping ground of Northfield, Massachusetts, which is also the birthplace, homestead, and grave site of D. L. Moody.

This was Rebekah's first trip to the Moody homestead. It was inspiring to walk the same ground where a great man of God once lived and ministered. As we walked up to the birthplace, my Dad began to retell some of my family's stories of the Moody family. As a nurse, my Grandmother took care of Mrs. Will Moody (D.L. Moody's daughter-inlaw) and attended her Bible studies for women. My Grandfather also worked for Moody as a carriage driver and carpenter. Granddad would set up tents so that thousands of people would be able to stay on the campus and hear the Word of God.

Dad told of how Mr. and Mrs. D. L. Moody were out for a carriage ride and saw two girls on Northfield Mountain making straw hats for income. Mr. Moody turned to his

wife and said that these girls should have an education that they may learn not only academically but also spiritually. This was the start of the Northfield Seminary for girls (a seminary in those days was considered a high school).

We approached the house, and noticed that no one was there to give a tour. In fact, there was a flyer saying that we could call someone to come. but it was only "by chance" that we could get in. We were disappointed, but we walked around the house and looked in the windows. As we came around the final corner before going to the car, Dad told us that this was Moody's study. His chair, Bible and other books were there, as well as Ira Sankey's organ. If only we could have gone in, we would have been able to look through them. Amazingly though, while Northfield School has been responsible for the upkeep of the site, no one has carefully preserved this important aspect of our Christian heritage.

As we walked a few yards from the birth site, in the shade of a sprawling tree, two simple stones marked the graves of Mr. and Mrs. D. L. Moody. It was interesting to see what people had left there for "good luck." On top of his gravestone

someone had left a quarter. Others had left patches from years in which they had graduated from the school; while some had left scarves and pieces of cloth - all for "good luck." Despite the present-day secularism of "luck" decorating the site, the Moodys' legacy of being buried facing east for the coming of the Lord, left a greater testimony for the faithful.



Pictured here are the gravestones of Mr. and Mrs. Moody. They are facing east so that they will rise to meet our Saviour face to face. The caption under Mr. Moody's dates reads, "He that doeth the will of God dwelleth forever." Mrs. Moody's caption states: "His servants shall serve Him and they shall reign for ever and ever." Notice the pieces of cloth and patches that were placed there for "good luck."

Driving through this campus that now was being used for secular purposes, we approached the auditorium. Dad told us this was where Moody held his crusades many years ago. It was here that men like R.A. Torrey would come and preach to the multitudes that gathered. Dad continued to tell stories as we drove down to the house where Moody and his family lived while they were in Northfield (it is now the offices for the Northfield Schools).

We then drove about ten minutes to the school Moody built for boys. Mt. Hermon was started as a school

- The July/August issue of AARP Bulletin states when it is the best time to have surgery. Doctors-in-training usually begin their internships in July, therefore this month may not be the best time to have surgery scheduled. Dr. David Shereer says, "But if you're having

surgery that can wait, it's probably wise to postpone it for a few months. I certainly wouldn't want to be the patient at a teaching hospital who gets open-heart surgery on July 2."

"BEWARE OF FALSE 'NEW **FRIENDS***** – "Q.) My 83-year old father befriended a young couple and their children two years ago. In the last year I've found out he has given them most of the money in his savings and checking accounts. He only has his house left, and I'm afraid he'll lose that, too. It doesn't do any good to talk to him. How can I protect him? A.) What you describe could be a classic case of financial exploitation. It often begins when a 'new friend' connives to isolate a person from his family, then slowly takes control of his finances. When the money is gone, the 'friend' may disappear, leaving the person heartbroken and destitute. You can report your concerns-anonymously if you wish- to the hotline of adult protective services, the local agencies that are responsible for investigating suspected financial exploitation. Investigators are trained to distinguish between cases of genuine friendship and exploitation. If wrongdoing is suspected, they will turn the case over to law enforcement authorities." The film is developed! What an interesting picture! In just a glance, that moment in time is evident to the viewer. What is the picture? It is pages upon pages, neatly bound and creatively covered. It is the number one best seller in children's literature. You know! Even the media reports each time a new installment will arrive. People stand in line all night. They put their name on the early book reservation list. They even participate in special events to celebrate its unveiling. Children across the world are avidly reading this new literature. It must be good. It gets them excited about reading. Their imaginations are working overtime. They cannot put it down. All children should read it - Yes?!?

As Christians, we know that our sin nature constantly requires daily reprimand. We seek the Lord daily for discernment and wisdom so that we can live in a righteous, godly manner. A small child's sin nature is, at times, very evident, but thankfully, instruction can train the child in what is right. For example, a child may desire and crave a bag full of Oreo cookies. He might even be unhappy if the "need" is not met. Yet wisdom maintains the danger of eating 60 cookies. Children, and even adults, will not just stumble into what is righteous and good. They must be taught, instructed, and trained. This applies not to just cookies but every area of life.

Back to our picture. Let's take another look. Have children stumbled upon a good read? Literature affects a person emotionally, intellectually, and spiritually. If the author has developed a creative setting and intriguing character, the reader will immediately be captured by the story until the last page. Even then, the story lives on in the reader's world of imagination, consuming his mind and influencing his dreams and beliefs.

I remember even when I was young, reading of the prairie days, dreaming of living on the prairie, and believing that one day my life could exemplify the girl on the prairie. The imagination is a wonderful gift and books are an excellent way to inspire and cultivate an active imagination. Yet, with books being so influential

and gaining the access to our most inner thoughts, shouldn't some discernment and wisdom be applied to not just cookies, but what we read – especially what the children read?

History effectively gives a background on the growth of children's literature. In the 1600s, the Colonial Puritans believed in a sin nature, therefore, they strove to train their children to reject sin and accept the truths of the Bible. The literature of that day, Bunyan's Pilgrim's Progress and the New England Primer, reinforced this same philosophy. The 1700s continued the same ideas of goodness, touching the heart of the child with its creativity. Mother Goose and Robinson Crusoe entertained while holding firm to Biblical truths. Children's literature blossomed in the Golden Age of the 1800s with the original publication of the Brothers Grimm and Lewis Carroll's Alice in Wonderland. Childhood entertainment had been discovered, but the honest, pure, and just were not forgotten in McGuffey's Readers and Noah Webster's Blue-Backed Speller. The Golden Age continued with Louisa May Alcott's Little Women, which emphasized the virtues of goodness, and on into the early 1900s with Just-So Stories and Uncle Remus Tales. Sadly, the golden light was quenched in the 1960s with a Dark Age philosophy in modern dress. The pure and just of the Colonies was replaced

with a modernistic and realistic philosophy of Europe. Literature began to expound upon the struggles of man. It became depressing, and much was poorly written. Today, literature has become infested with complex symbolisms, pessimism, death, tragedy, and hopelessness.

Take another look at that picture. What do we see? Not just a book on the best-seller list, but a picture of our society. So many in America have forsaken God. They are depressed and hopeless, and it has polluted this new era of literature. Remember what books affect the emotions, the spirit, and the mind. Do we want death, tragedy, fascination of evil, hopelessness, and depression influencing the minds, emotions, and spirits of our children? We must protect them, even from what they may have stumbled into that seems as good

as those 60 cookies.

Case in point: While working with a group of young people, I continually noticed one boy's constant obsession with the fantasy world. He fed his imagination daily

with the current fad of children's material, which included sorcery, magic, and the unbelievable. He was fascinated by the strange, the spooky, the eerie, the evil. He drew pictures, he wrote stories, he played cards – all devoted to this mysticism.

One day, while I was speaking with his mother, she voiced concerns over his apathetic and unwilling attitude. With fear in her voice, she repeated his conversation on how depressed he was with life and how he just wanted to kill himself.

He lived with the new era of children's fads, it invaded his mind, and it soon controlled his beliefs and dreams.

"Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report: if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on **these** things."

We pray that someone who has the vision and finances would reopen the Northfield campus and use it for what it was intended -- to train up men and women for the glory of God.

BIKE PATHS COST \$225

Paul Revere was born in Boston in January of 1734 and died in May of 1818. At this site, it was sad to hear that an elementary student did not even know who Paul Revere was or what he had sacrificed for our country.

PICTURE OF A PATRIOT

Born of French Huguenot descent in December 1734, Paul Rivoire (later changed to Revere) entered the New World. At age thirteen, Paul got involved in ringing the bells at his church, and, along with his friends, organized the Bell Ringers Association. Young Paul studied in Boston, became a silversmith, and eventually served in the French and Indian War. As the Colonies' desire for freedom mounted. Revere became politically active as leader of the Boston craftsmen. He was one of those in the Boston Harbor on December 16, 1773. The Boston Committee of Correspondence and the Massachusetts Committee of Safety hired him as a courier. With these qualifications, he was chosen by a Patriot leader, Dr. Joseph Warren to warn Lexington and Concord of the eminent attack of the British troops. Riding quickly, Revere not only warned the Patriot leaders endangered of being captured by the British, but also alerted all other colonist to take up arms to defend their liberties. Amazingly, some were not interested in news of the British and demanded that Revere deliver his news more guietly. Revere adamantly replied. "Noise! You'll have noise enough before long. The regulars are coming out!" With this enthusiasm and determination, nothing could squelch this desire for a free country.
