Are you ready for a challenge. Invite your hardest working friends to try this challenge. Gather a 12 inch stick and an 18 inch length of yarn for each player. Tie one end of the yarn to the top of the stick. At the other end of the yarn, make a hoop about five inches around. Each player must try to catch the hoop with one end of the stick and one hand by swinging the stick around and pushing it up and into the hoop. It takes some practice, but the first player to catch the hoop will be the "Hoop Stick" champion.

PRISCILLA'S PIECES

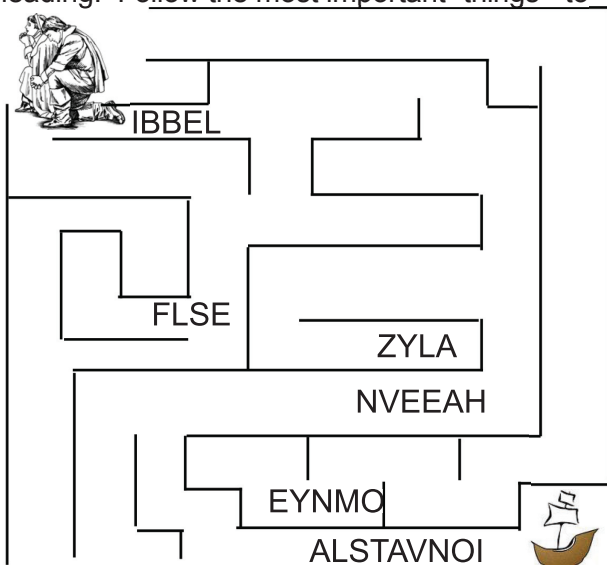
Try this game when getting together with special friends – Bubble Bowling. Cover a table with a cloth and put two objects at the end to represent a goal. Divide the group into two teams, giving each player a straw, and place a bowl of soapy water on the opposite end of the table from the goal. The teams play one at a time with one member dipping the straw into the sudsy water and blowing a bubble toward the goal, while the other tries to blow the bubble to the goal. If the bubble crosses the goal before it pops, it is a point scored. Alternate teams until the winning score is reached.
