



FROM HERE AND THERE

A pro-family advocate is outraged that a California public school teacher would pass out homosexual pledge cards to her kindergarten students. The pledge cards were produced by the Gay, Lesbian and Straight Education Network and featured oaths that students would not use "anti-lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender language or slurs," that students would intervene on behalf of homosexual students when possible and that they would actively support safer school efforts. In the same report on FoxNews. com, a spokesperson for the school agreed that the pledge was inappropriate for the kindergarten students and said that the pledges were meant for middle school and high school students." The Sudanese female journalist had violated the decency law by wearing pants and was fined \$200. Hussein has declared not to pay a penny and vowed to keep wearing her trousers. Isn't it amazing how this dress, clothing, modesty issue keeps popping up around the world. Sadly, churches in America are plagued, not only by a comeas-you-are casual mentality, but "I defy you to preach about my clothes" attitude. An open, obvious, in-your-face refusal to respect the Pastors' request is weekly exhibited by those who profess to love the Lord, but disobey His commands. Church meetings are fraught with obscene exhibitions. These carnally clad seem to have addiction withdrawal symptoms when not adorned with the world's fashions.

World Magazine 2009 reported – Venezuelan president Hugo Chavez arrived in Moscow September 10, 2009 ready to buy tank and other weaponry sufficient to double his armored vehicle arsenal. Chavez has



previously amassed tanks at the Colombian border and has renewed tension over Colombia's plan to allow U.S. troops to use Colombian bases for anti-narcotics operations. The Moscow stop was part of a world tour that included six countries. In Iran, Chavez emphasized the "axis of unity" between the two countries and announced plans for a "nuclear village" in Venezuela with Iranian assistance, "so that the Venezuelan people can count in the future with this marvelous resource for peaceful uses." The two oil-rich states plan to trade uranium yet to be mined in Venezuela for nuclear energy produced in Iran, which has earned Tehran UN Security Council sanctions.

The Obama Administration is working overtime to weaken immigration law enforcement measures as a way of granting "back door" amnesty to illegal aliens. At a time when many local law enforcement agencies are finding success in stopping illegal immigration crime, the Obama administration has decided to interfere. According to the Houston Chronicle "Several members of a key U.S. House committee called for greater oversight of a controversial federal program that allows local law enforcement to detain suspected illegal immigrants, citing a recent report that questioned it effectiveness." "The record is incomplete, at best, as to whether or not this program is a success,' said House Homeland Security Chairman Bennie G. Thompson, D-Miss, who also raised concerns about the potential for racial profiling."

The Davidson County (Nashville) Tennessee Sheriff's Department significantly reduced crime in the two years after taking advantage of this federal program (287) (g). More than 4,000 jailed illegal aliens were placed in removal proceedings. But still, the Obama administration and leftists in Congress are not convinced. They will not stop with misleading government reports and kangaroo court congressional hearings. It is clear which side the Obama administration is on when it comes to illegal immigration. Js your light darkness? Js your light darkness? Js yo

"Take heed therefore that the light which is in thee be not darkness." (Luke 11:35)

These are the words of Jesus as He teaches about the light within the body. What a startling statement He is making. How is it that light can be darkness? Is there such a scientific phenomenon in the physical realm? Obviously, this is a possibility in the spiritual.

Today, must a gospel preacher expose the blindness of this age? Darkness, depravity, and devoid of discernment all characterize this generation. The "Light," the "Truth," – Christ is hid from them. They tolerate the ways, lack of morals and customs of this world with a vicious intolerance of the godly and righteous. The eye of light they plucked from its socket to leave a blackened wound of blindness. O' dear God, help the blinded eye, the fallen-in-the-ditch, the blind trying to lead the blind. The eye is evil, and the light be darkness.

Even in the church some have taken the light of God's love, grace, and mercy to their license, licentiousness, and lust. Thus, the truth of what Christ said; if "thine eye is evil, thy body also is full of darkness." It is this evil liberty taken that blots the light from the eye. Sinful desires have blinded the light of Christ and no longer can we spiritually see and discern.

The world will kick the gold dust of materialism into the eye of light and darken the understanding as well. Mammon is an enemy of the light. Many a minister and believer has fallen into a dark place in pursuit of this world's glitter.

Then there are those who refuse to be taught. The spirit will guide, they have an impression, this education stuff is not of the Lord. Soon the blindness of ignorance fills the eye with darkness.

Obviously, the devil, himself, is persistently firing his darts of evil at the eye of light. Can this occur in what may initially seem to be the most noble of pursuits? We are not talking a heart of evil pursuing the darkness of the alleyway or gutter, but the desire that seeks a noble and high office. Yet along the journey the flesh arises and darkness steps on the scene. Charles H. Spurgeon illustrates it this way:

"I have also seen this light turned to darkness in the case of the student who has gathered great erudition, and enrolled himself among the learned. He begins to criticize. Do not condemn him for that: he judges very properly at first, he criticizes things that ought to be criticized; but he stops not there. Once having his critical faculty aroused, he is like a boy with a new knife; he must cut something or other. Nothing comes in his way more often than the Scriptures; and he must have a cut at them. He whittles at Genesis; he makes a gash in Deuteronomy; he halves Isaiah; he takes slices out of the Gospels, and cuts the Epistles into slivers.

Js your *light* darkness? Js your *light* darkness?

You see, he has so sharp a knife that he must use it. By-and-by, from a critic he advances to an irreverent faultfinder, and from that to an utter unbeliever, hard in the mouth and stiff in the neck. His light has blinded him. He has taken his own eve to pieces that he might study its anatomy, and henceforth the light will be of no more use to him than to the dead."

It has been my experience to hear several dear friends in the ministry say, "this verse should read or this word would be better translated." Maybe their intentions were good in the beginning. But that new penknife got the best of them and soon began to cut out the very light they once embraced. With modern Bible versions the Word has been cut, criticized and corrected until the light which was in them has become darkness. Some in their zealous pursuit have even called it "higher criticism." It was a "big bang" heard round the world - the Darwinian evolution of the Bible. Is this natural selection or yet survival of the fittest - whichever "Bible" sells the most survives!

that hoped to reach youth with a positive message of hope. Sponsored by the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association, the tour was scheduled to visit four cities. Each concert was to feature seven hours of music interspersed by brief messages from Franklin Graham. *Minnesota Christian Chronicle/Hite's NL*

"Christians can't lose the fight over marriage in the Western world - and non-Christians can't win it," says Christopher Ashe in a position paper for the Christ on Campus Crusade Initiative. Marriage is 'part of the Created Order,' he says, so it 'exists as a significant institution in the world whether or not societies conform to its beneficial disciplines.' Ashe reminds Christians that when we try to convince the lost world that marriage works best when done God's way, we have no reason for desperation – as if anyone or any group could destroy marriage. "It is not within the power of humankind finally to destroy Created Order" he says. What in the World/Hite's NL Healthcare sharing ministries lobby to be heard - Representing about 34,000 families but growing, healthcare sharing ministries (HCSM), in which a pool of believers share their insurance costs, are pouring limited resources into lobbying efforts to ensure they are not left out of a final healthcare overhaul. But they face



a long road. Samaritan Ministries International, Christian Care Medi-Share, and Christian Health Care Ministries are not recognized by the federal government as official health insurance providers. That's bad news if Congress passes a bill that includes mandates requiring individuals to purchase federally approved insurance plans. Such mandates are gaining wider bipartisan acceptance and are expected to be a part of any changes. "We are looking at complete obliteration of the ministries as they exist," warned James Lansberry, president of the Alliance of Health Care Sharing Ministries.

These groups should be worried: Mandates would grant broad new enforcement powers to the Treasury Department, which would task the IRS with collecting the penalties for individuals and employers who forgo government-approved insurance. "The mandate is going to be a bigger problem than people think," worries Lansberry. "It's a backdoor reduction in our freedom to make individual healthcare choices." Edward Pitts/ World

AQUILA/PRISCILLA IIINISTRY

To our faithful supporters and those who care:

We are privileged in this edition of *The Voice in the Wilderness* to open our Ministry Travel Journal so that you can read the specifics of the teaching endeavor that The Voice in the Wilderness's Aquila/Priscilla Team completed in mid-September. This is not simply a report of how Steve and Rebekah Lilly served in Venezuela, but a testimony of the great things our Lord is accomplishing through the partnership of those who are answering His prayer request to send forth labourers. Truly, you will see how the fields in Venezuela are ripe to the Gospel and while many Christians are working in the harvest, more labourers are needed to stop those dictators, socialists, communists, and occults who desire to spoil the fruit. Please read with an open heart and allow the Holy Spirit to direct you in applying your "feelings for missions" toward action in your own life and local ministry. For surely we all can daily do more to gather His harvest...until He comes.

(Pre-Journal: In 2005, we made our first trip to Venezuela under the Aquila/ Priscilla Ministry. Because of that ministry, our hearts became emblazoned with the need of the Venezuelan people, and our desire to return for ministry only intensified as the time past. What a privilege it has been to continue serving as staff missionaries for The Voice in the Wilderness, even as Satan, himself, has sought to destroy the "Voice" through verbal attacks and financial downfalls. Committed to maintaining that "Voice" through this ministry, we accepted the Lord's open doors for extra jobs which provided a financial base to continue. While still keeping our ministry responsibilities, our extra jobs began to pay bills and miraculously provide additional money for projects. Early in 2009, the Lord once again impressed upon us the need to help in Venezuela. In February, we stepped out on the faithful footprints again and placed \$150.00 into a savings account and began preparing letters and a DVD presentation to mail to supporters, stating that our financial needs in returning for a six week ministry in Venezuela would be \$10,000. The goal seemed daunting, but knowing this was clearly God's direction, we continued working. "Praise the Lord Days" arrived several times as we checked the mail and opened special gifts for our trip from those who cared. As the \$150.00 gradually grew, we contacted one of our host pastors, Bro. Carlos Ramos and began to work with him to schedule six full weeks of teaching, preaching, and training. Soon trip dates were finalized, airline tickets purchased, and our savings account was depleted. Because we desired to be a blessing through The Voice in the Wilderness ministry, we continued to pray that God would provide the complete \$10,000 so that this teaching trip could be fulfilled debt free. Our extra job money added to the account up until the week before our departure, and then the Lord revealed His surprise...our church in the mountains, committed to give and then the Lord took over the service and a special offering was taken which doubled the gift with six additional dollars to spare! With goal met, we wrapped up office responsibilities and boarded a plane—with our Pastor praying that we would run into President Chavez and win him to the Lord!).

First Few Days (Aug 5-7)

Bleared-eyed from our overnight flight to Venezuela, we deplaned to find our luggage and walk through customs. Steve was relieved that our handchimes made it through inspections...only the wordless key chains seemed to be of curiosity to the agents. Pastor Rafael was there to meet us (with his neck in a brace due to his recent car accident) and help us get from the international to the national airport. After a four hour layover and forty minute flight to Barquisimeto, we finally placed our feet on the grounds of our home for six weeks and shook hands with our two host pastors, Bro. Carlos Ramos and Bro. Estelvio Garcia.... They drove us to the apartment in Sabana de Parra. The church ladies from Pastor Estelvio's church and Bro. Garcia (owner of the apartment) had worked hard to prepare everything to be "perfect" for us. It is very nice...3 bedroom, 2 bath, kitchen, air condition in one room (yea!), no running water (yikes!). We left soon after to go to the Bible Institute Graduation Service. When we arrived, Dad had just been picked up from the airport, and was preparing to preach the graduation message...(8/6) Bro. Carlos came and took us to Barquisimeto (a large city 30 minutes away) to shop for things we would need...(8/7) Sunrise in Sabana de Parra isn't the only thing that wakes you. car horns do as well. Then soul-winning in a new church plant area, Chivacoa. Three were saved!....

Week One (Aug. 8-14)

(8/8) Steve taught on being a Godly Father in the men's Sunday school while Rebekah taught on being "Daughters of the King" with the ladies at the Sabana de Parra church. For the night service we were at Bro. Carlos's church where Rebekah enjoyed playing the keyboard for song time since this new church has no one who can play for them. (8/9) Started English lessons at Bro. Estelvio's church this morning. 39 were in attendance, with all ages present. Bro. Estelvio and his wife Xiomara are eager students. They want to learn English so they can talk to Dad without an interpreter. VBS for the afternoon was canceled because the person with the keys to the public school, where the VBS is to be held for the week, could not be found. (8/10) English Classes (ESL) in the morning...Still having difficulty with the water problem. It has to be trucked in everyday, but when it comes, we are teaching, and when we return, the water is out....The key was found and VBS began this afternoon with Steve teaching about Heaven. Over 20 children came to be saved....Still no water. Pastor Estelvio came and set off a



water bomb(?), and then came the water. We all hurried to take a shower at 11pm while there was opportunity. (8/11) Bro. Estelvio did his homework – today, he "Preached" the Abraham and Isaac story in English!...Lunch with a church member – pollo (chicken) and aroz (rice)....VBS this afternoon was almost rained-out. Steve taught the crucifixion and resurrection story while the children sat under the sheltered walkway of the public school....



Took Dad to the airport, but his flight was delayed because of the rain. We sat in the airport all evening waiting for the flight. While we were waiting, we used the cabina (phone booth) to call the states. Get this! – The principal of the Christian school in Asheville where we occasionally substitute has been calling all over the States and e-mailing Venezuela, trying to get up with us. Enrollment changed and they lost a teacher and they want us to teach part-time when we get home.

God is always looking after us. We had to guit our extra jobs to make the Venezuela trip, and now, before we even get home, we have a little something extra to help pay the bills! Finally, the airport announced that Dad's flight would be leaving soon, so we said goodbye and left to do some grocery shopping. After shopping however, we found that Dad's flight had eventually been canceled. Back to the airport we went. There are no more flights to the US for 3 days! We went back to the apartment, while Pastor Estelvio, Bro. Carlos and Dad jumped in the car for a roller-coaster night ride to Caracas. They made it just in time for Dad to make his morning flight out to Miami. (8/12) ESL this morning....This afternoon while Bro. Carlos and Bro. Estelvio made up for lost sleep, we found out that the game room below our apartment will allow us to check our e-mail there. Now we don't have to wait to ride to the next city to phone home. (8/13) Taught Moses and the burning bush at ESL this morning. 205 children came to VBS this afternoon. After Steve's Salvation lesson, about 20 children came for salvation, and we gave all the children a wordless keychain....Evening services with Bro. Estelvio. Rebekah sang a special in Spanish. (8/14) Steve went on visitation while Rebekah stayed at the apartment to wait for water. Finally water arrived and Rebekah spent the morning cleaning and hand-washing clothes. In the afternoon we went with Bro. Estelvio to shop for decorations for the couple's banquet tonight. We helped decorate and then Steve preached

to 27 couples about God's Pattern, Purity, and Permanency of marriage. One lady accepted Christ.

Week Two (Aug 16-22)

(8/16) Steve taught Sunday school at Bro. Carlos's church and then we both taught a children's service. Wow!- 75 children crammed in a back alleyway listened as we taught...Bro. Carlos dropped us off at our apartment building promising to return in one hour to take us to San Pablo



for the evening service that Steve was to preach. One problem - the night watchman was not on duty and we were left stranded on the street. We walked to Bro. Garcia's house and to Pastor Estelvio's house, but no one was home. We walked to the Sabana de Parra church and thankfully the assistant pastor, Bro. Hector was there preparing for the upcoming VBS. He called Bro. Garcia to come and unlock the building. We got to the apartment with 10 minutes to spare....We made it to Pastor Josue's church and we played the handchimes. As we rang "It is Well with My Soul", the guard dogs struck up an unharmonizing accompaniment! About 40 are attending this new church plant and two came for salvation during the invitation. (8/17) No water yesterday, and none today, so it's the dip and pour method and lots of powder! Morning ESL classes still going strong and afternoon VBS is off to a rainy but good start with over 250 unchurched children. (8/18) "Sally" made an appearance today at VBS after Steve taught the lesson "Saved, Smile, Serve." Many raise their hands for salvation today. (8/19) Busy week.... APM's Venezuela ESL classes in the morning, VBS in the afternoon, and our English outreach classes for the unsaved community in Yaritagua are at 7:00 each night. Over 40 people are attending the class and at least half are unsaved. We are praying many will accept Christ because of this class. Tonight just before ESL classes we were able to call the States and then we had to find the bathroom, because Rebekah had developed the stomach scourge. Unfortunately (at least for the next person to enter the bathroom) the toilet was not working! Thankfully, Imodium kept her out of the bathroom until after the class. (8/20) A boy in VBS went crazy when Steve gave the invitation and tried to run out and break the windows in Bro. Carlos's car. It took 4 men to restrain him. His father worships a "beast-like lady" up in the mountains and has basically forsaken him. The men are going to try to continue helping and working with the boy. (8/21) Morning ESL classes down due to a lot of sickness in Sabana de Parra....We saw over 80 children accept Christ in VBS this week....Night classes started a little rough due to having to move to a smaller classroom space. Our forty students were packed in with no air condition. After the students learned to tell the Crucifixion/Resurrection story in English, we gave the entire gospel story in Spanish. Bro. Carlos then gave an invitation and seven souls accepted Christ and one lady rededicated her life to the Lord. Amen! And Amen! Certificates and refreshments were given and students were invited to attend church on Sunday to hear Steve preach. (8/22) Visitation in Sabana de Parra – 2 were saved. We spent the afternoon (continued on page 20)

preparing lessons, sermons, sending e-mails and I made our first true Venezuelan meal – Arepas con jamon y queso (cornbread sandwich with ham and cheese).

Week three (Aug. 23-28)

(8/23) Many of our night ESL students came to church and brought family with them. Steve preached and 6 came to know the Lord....Night services were at Pastor de la Cruz's church where we played the chimes and Steve preached on Missions. The altars were flooded with people praying for the growth of their church and lost family. (8/24) Last week of morning ESL classes.....Went shopping this afternoon for camp supplies for the next two weeks. (8/25) Started VBS at a new church area in San Felipe with Pastor



Niller and his family. Over forty children sat under a tree as we told stories and taught a Bible lesson. After VBS we drove about a mile to the mayor's office building where we set up our ESL materials and began a second week of outreach to the unsaved community. Forty unsaved, unchurched people filled the meeting space and learned how sin came into the world through the Adam and Eve story. (8/26) ESL and VBS in San Felipe and evening services in Sabana de Parra. We were treated to "Venezuela's best pizza" after church. They put corn on their pizza and it was really yummy! (8/27) Bro. Carlos's car

has been having trouble all week. He has had to borrow someone else's car everyday to take us to San Felipe. Today, during our ESL class, the socialists were having a rock concert across the street in the city square. It was very loud and distracting, but the attendance and the enthusiasm of the students has continued. So, while the dictator's music was blasting and the Catholic church beside us was preparing for evening mass, our students were learning the story of the birth of the Saviour in the Mayor's office! (8/28) Concluded morning ESL classes in Sabana de Parra with a final exam, refreshments, and certificates....We knew something great was about to happen because we could tell that the devil really did not want us to have our ESL classes in San Felipe. Bro. Carlos couldn't find a car to borrow, so we had to slowly drive his car. When we arrived the VBS was over and a group had taken over our classroom at the mayor's office. We ended up setting up in a public school across the street. It was HOT in there and we started over an hour late, but all the students were there and really didn't seem to mind. After teaching the crucifixion/resurrection story and giving our salvation lesson in Spanish to the students, we introduced Pastor Niller as the host pastor for the English classes. He gave a salvation invitation and 17 folks accepted Christ!

Week four (Aug 30)

(8/30) Started the Lord's Day with a children's service at Pastor Niller's new church. Next came the adult service and over 20 of the ESL students came. Steve preached on "The Cross" and 3 more of the student came during the invitation and accepted Christ....

Space does not permit the complete printing of our journal, but please understand that week four continued with the Lord doing amazing things as

we survived two terrific weeks of youth camp in the mountains of Venezuela. We had a great ministry as camp workers and teachers. As asked to, Steve preached on Morality and six teenagers came for salvation while over 30 made specific decisions for Christ. Also, six young people learned to play the handchimes this week. The next week, we both taught on God's standards for music in our lives and enjoyed teaching two groups of young people to play the chimes which were used as special music before the evening service. Our last few days in the country were filled not only with packing and saying tearful goodbyes to newly-made friends, but also teaching a Children's Worker Training session over two nights to an excess of 100 church workers. Truly this was a work of the Lord. Thank you to Pastor Carlos and Pastor Estelvio, their families and the churches who opened their hearts and shared their time with us. To Bro. Garcia, thank you for helping us meet our housing needs. And finally, to The Voice in the Wilderness and its faithful supporters a big THANK YOU for sending us. Praise the Lord!

DEATH BY DENOMINATION

PART II - DEATH BY DENOMINATION

1. "The light which is in thee be not darkness." Can we agree that the Word of God is our sole authority for faith and practice? The Bible is the inspired Word of God, yes? As Christ teaches in Luke 11 verse 33, "No man, when he hath lighted a candle, putteth it in a secret place, neither under a bushel, but on a



candlestick, that they which come in may see the light." We are so blessed to have the light. What a privilege it is to let the truth of God shine forth in our lives unto a dark and dying world. Jesus continued in verse 34, "the light of the body is the eye: therefore when thine eye is single, thy whole body also is full of light; but when thine eye is evil, thy body is full of darkness." Examine yourself to see if thine eye is evil. Jesus makes it clear that if thine eye be evil, thy body is also full of darkness. Then He makes this amazing statement in verse 35, "Take heed therefore that the light which is in thee be not darkness." How can the light in you be darkness? (please read "Is Your Light Darkness? page 10 in this edition)

2. Diagnosis – itching ears. If you can't beat them, why not join them and be politically correct? Some claim they have special enlightenment beyond the scripture and beyond the old fashion Bible preacher. Sadly many pastors have abdicated the call and God-given authority to preach faithfully the whole counsel of God's Word. Indeed some have become hirelings, yes-men, yea, and puppets on a string. From the pew and beyond comes censorship of the pulpit. There will

be no politics in this church.


For me personally, I guess my definition was not up-to-date. Recently I've heard the word politics used several times in relationship to the church and the pulpit. Now Webster's New World Dictionary gives the primary definition of politics as "the science and art of government." In Newsweek magazine, Jon Meacham writes that for many people politics comes down to three things – protect my job, let me keep most of my money, and kill the terrorists. Obviously there is a lot of "me-ology" in Meacham's statement: Me – my job; Me-my money; Me-my safety and security.

Now it appears politics for many church members takes on a similar meaning. No politics means preach just Bible - make me feel good religion, but leave off the personal meddling. Just last week my wife was speaking to a lady about her relationship with the Lord – to make a long story short, she had been hurt at a previous church, in her words, by gossip and politics. If she ever got back in church, it would be on the last pew without getting involved in anything. Amen brother, that's my kind of preaching. Just preach Bible and stay out of politics. It's amazing, with all due respect to the dear brothers and sisters with an aversion toward "pulpit politics", that they exhibit an utter intolerance toward God's man who shines the light on lifestyles contrary to God's Word. Could it be that they want truth that suits them? They claim an intolerant, absolute right to censor the pulpit and no one should attempt to preach anything different. Apparently there is a list of "taboo" topics. Could this possibly be the pre-cursor to the itching ear? Across America today, without doubt, liberal pulpits have not only an

agenda, but also a list of sermons that will not be tolerated. It has been stated in this publication that what is preached not only defines the pulpit ministry, but what is "not" preached as well.

To bring it down to a personal level, let me ask you this question? If your pastor were deeply moved by the Holy Spirit of God in studying the scriptures concerning a specific topic, would you not expect your pastor to teach on that subject? Eventually over a period of time, months and years, would you not expect your pastor to cover every subject that the Bible deals with? The culture and changing times have no effect on the unchanging Word of God. Just because a society re-defines lies as "a matter of opinion," or "mis-speaking;" fornication as "affairs;" and drunkenness as "chemical dependency" or a "genetic pre-disposition," in no-way relieves the church of its responsibility to call sin, sin. If the preaching is Old Testament and invades lifestyle, the rebuttal is "that's Law and applies to Israel and not to me today." If the preaching is New Testament and ruffles the feathers, then "that's the preacher's opinion, that's politics, and does not belong in the pulpit. Do we have private interpretation here and an intolerant attitude toward the exposure of sin, self, and Satan? The apostle Paul said, "They shall turn away their ears from the truth." Yes, these are perilous times, but from the pulpit to the pew, the call is to stand on the Word of God. "Preach the Word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears...."

3. A watered-down generic. Why would the devil oppose watered-down Bible versions that omit a little here and add a little there? "Yea hath God said?"

Several years ago I was in Mexico and a brother was buying prescription medication right over the counter. I asked him if the drugs in Mexico were safe. At that time he said they probably were. The biggest risk is that the U.S. dosage and strength may be diluted or watered-down in Mexico. There may be fillers and the needed potency has been altered.

Obviously, that can be dangerous and in some cases deadly. If the prescribed strength and dosage is not correctly followed the malady that is being treated may become worse, even fatal. A careful examination of those promoting modern day Bible versions and contemporary church worship styles is very revealing. There are specific liberal trends, buzzwords, and philosophies adopted by those promoting and associated with today's compromise.

It does appear many have "rational – lized" their way beyond the Holy Spirit's conviction against unscriptural philosophies and dogmatisms.

4. The ego, logo, no-go! With denominational leaders making enormous six-figure salaries and millions of dollars gathered annually into the cooperative coffers, is it possible for this rich and fatty diet to not create heart problems? We talk about Rome and its hierarchy. Have you ever dealt with denominational machinery and bureaucracy? Your experiences are probably

different from mine. Regardless, the ego's can be big along with the power, politics and preferred personalities. Logos, labels and loyalties are and of necessity must be large. All wrong or is there right in the co-operative connectional union? Are pastors afraid of being alone by virtue of independence? Do they think

apart from The Denomination there is no job security, health care, investment, or retirement plan? Maybe no one will show up for your funeral? Where will I find a pastorate or where will the church find a pastor apart from the denomination? But pastor, who called you? Who said He would build His Church? Will He ever leave us or forsake us? Can He supply our every need? Where is the pillar and ground of the truth? MUST I GO ON? No---go? It's a no-go because denominationalism is man's opinion not Biblical design. It's a no-go because there is no anchor, no absolutes. Denominations say so but no it's not true. Their standards are ever changing; music changes,

dress changes, associations' change, Bible versions change. Sin that was no longer is and those who were no longer are with a changing redefining relativistic worldview. It's a no-go fraught with prejudicial conjecture. Whatever happened to a little Bible study? What does God say or is that no longer important since the people in the pew have 3 or 4 different versions? But my grandparents belong to this denomination and I will die a member. What a tragic bias. Inconsistencies abound. Please — Biblical evidence is irrefutable. History speaks volumes and the glaring proof of logical fallacies leave no question.

- 5. Mass, prayer and eulogy for the dead. America was reminded again what the Roman Catholic Church and religion is all about. (i.e. Ted Kennedy) The Bible, which Bible, what Bible? This dumbed down age lacks discernment and critical thinking skills. God and the Bible are out and the church is confused as to where the Bible is if we even have the Bible. We've gone from talking in class, chewing gum and running in the halls to drugs, abortion and murder as the discipline problems in government schools. Discipline my foot- it's survival in that jungle. Oh and the children are told they are animals from the jungle so why not act like one. What's that got to do with denominations? Ask them what they believe about Genesis chapters 1-11. Ask them about marriage, divorce, marriage after a divorce or divorces, music, dress standards, alcohol, dancing, worldly entertainment, voting records and why? I am not trying to be contentious but contend for the faith. I have precious family and friends who are members of various denominations across this country. Is this an anti Dale Carnegy Course. Am I trying to lose friends and infuriate people? I do want God's people to think. I want you to open your Bible, KJB, and see what The Lord has to say. Thy Word Is Truth! He is not the author of confusion. Don't be a party to confusion or corruption. Do all to the glory of God.

health, activists stripped away euphemisms and were plain about goals: more funding and more access to abortion. Purnima Mane. deputy executive director of the UN Population Fund, urged activists to "enlarge the pot" of \$11.1 billion given to population-related programs in 2008. The conference promoted "safe abortions" (i.e., legal) but one group passed out stickers telling women how to perform do-it-yourself abortions by lying to pharmacists. Another group distributed pamphlets that said, "I need an abortion" in six different languages, directing women in countries without "Safe abortion" to doctors who can provide them. World

President Obama believes a Palestinian state will defuse most of the Middle East hostility issues. He has expressed support for speedy action since taking office. The fact the Palestinians refuse to recognize Israel as a Jewish state make it impossible for Jews in Israel to recognize a Palestinian state. - 6. How is spiritual growth and discipleship monitored and promoted?
- 7. Are the vision, goals and philosophy of ministry, missions and money clear?
