APM's first overseas missions teaching trip. On May 15, we departed the US for Caracas, Venezuela and a seven week teaching ministry. Due to President Chavez and his communistic tendencies, we could not find reasonable housing and, therefore, had to pay for a motel for the length of our stay. Nevertheless, the Lord's will prevailed and each day was filled with church helps and our primary ministry of teaching English as a second language. The Bible Institute students eagerly learned English so that they may better serve the Lord wherever He calls them, while the local church members enjoyed learning a new language and are looking forward to an opportunity to witness to an English speaking person in their own community. Many from the unsaved community also attended the classes and were introduced to God and His Word and a loving, Bible-preaching local church. At the conclusion of the English session, APM had the opportunity to confront the unsaved students with their need of a Saviour. Because all of the English lessons were taught using Bible stories from Creation to the Resurrection of Jesus, each student had been educated not only in a new language but also in God's plan of salvation. Carlos and Crisbelis accepted Jesus in the closing night of classes. Carlos, realized his need to turn from his sinful life of experimenting in the homosexual lifestyle to the Saviour who would change his life completely. Pray for Carlos as he is discipled in the Lord. Also pray that the Lord will continue to supply the money needed to pay for APM's additional expenses due to the necessity of staying in a motel for 7 weeks.

CrossVue is occupied. What an encouragement it has been to see Lowe's lumber become our Lord's blessings, as the missions training aspect of our ministry grows. As final touches are made, we are anticipating CrossVue's dedication service and first teaching sessions.

Our local church ministry grows. APM continues to help a new local church grow in the Asheville area. One week in July was spent teaching Bible clubs across the city. Praise the Lord for 12 young people being saved during this time. APM will continue this children's outreach on a bi-monthly basis in the fall. The Asheville Headquarters also keeps us "hopping" on a daily basis as we correspond with missionaries, research and write for *The Voice in the Wilderness*, and travel representing the ministry. Also, pray as we explore the opportunity of teaching English classes in Asheville as an evangelism tool for the new church plant.
