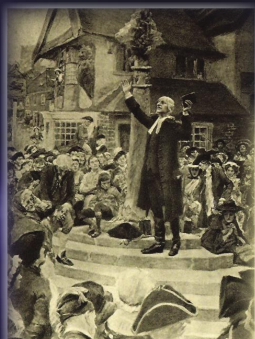

## WHY THE KING JAMES BIBLE?

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### A Continuing Series - CrossVue Study

Modern Bible versions such as the NIV, NASV, NLT and the message are vastly different from the KJB. Please read The KING JAMES BIBLE DECLARATION in this edition for a concise look at this critical issue. In addition, the following 3 points may help summarize why The Declaration is so very important. **The Source**, **The Scholars** and **The Scriptures** outline briefly the contrast between modern Bible versions and the King James Bible. Please read the article "The Word of God" in the Spring 2010 edition of this publication:

- I. **Source...Corrupt Text** (You answer the question. Does The Pure originate in the corrupt? Modern versions of the Bible are from a **corrupt** "critical " **source** previously obscure and discarded)
- II. **Scholars...Corrupt Teachers** (Again you answer. Is this of God? **Corrupt scholars** who believed in evolution, German rationalism, spiritism and other false teachings responsible for the text source of modern Bible versions.)
- III. **Scripture...Corrupt Translations** (**Corrupt scripture** is the result of private interpretation, adding to, taking away from and changing the meaning of vital teaching. Again, did God use obscure, corrupted text, a manmade scientific method directed by men with beliefs contrary to the very Book they claim to be correcting with their "higher criticism".)

*From a corrupt source and corrupt scholars come corrupt scripture. God help us to know the truth. Thy Word is TRUTH. In the garden Satan did not attempt to deny God. Satan did not try to persuade Adam and Eve there was no God. "Yea, hath God said?" This is Satan's attack, the attack on God's Word and God's character. This grotesque, vile, cancerous root of sin extends it tentacles toward the innocent soil of woman's heart. Here is Satan's implantation of corruption – the doubt of God's Word,*



*God's Truth. "Yea, hath God said...?" Thus from the beginning the attack was on God's Word.*

Eve did not abide in God's Word and Satan was able to exclude the abundance of all God had given Adam and Eve. Then Eve carelessly omits God's words that allowed them "every tree of the garden" to "freely eat" (Gen. 3:2). She committed omission and even addition to God's Word in Gen. 3:3 with "neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die." Eve obviously doubts the God-given warning and consequence. Satan in his vileness denies and attacks God's words of Gen 2:17 "thou shalt surely die" with the wicked assertion recorded in Gen. 3:4 "ye shall not surely die." And so it was and is – the taking away and adding to that is clearly warned against in scripture (Rev. 22:18 &19).

Over 3,000 times this HOLY Book records the scriptures divinely inspired origin! Multitudes have possibly read Gen. 1-3 with the intent to read the entire Bible. Certainly the most read verse in the Bible must be Gen. 1:1. And Satan takes the vile spikes of hell and attempts to drive them into the heart of TRUTH. Read Gen. 1:1. Here is the first and foundational utterance recorded for us. Today, as in Gen. 3:1 the Liar attempts to kill the TRUTH. **In the beginning GOD--- In the beginning was THE WORD!** So the attack of Satan starts "in the beginning". "Yea, hath God said...?"

Sadly in churches today, from the pulpits and classroom podiums, come statements like: "this would be better translated" or "the better manuscripts contain or omit thus and so." Certainly the title "Textual Critics" describes well the critics of GOD'S WORD that come with their scholarly exacto knife to cut and paste together some eclectic perversion of a *Bible* that meets the approval of man's will.

Establish, ground, plant your soul, your **ALL** firmly "In the beginning" and you will have no problem believing, living in and standing on the TRUTH.

### **Open The King James Bible to II Peter 1:19-21:**

*We have also a more sure Word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts; knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man; but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.*

Please make a note of the following observations:

1. Our Lord and Saviour warns to “take heed therefore that the light which is in thee be not darkness.” (Luke 11:35) Peter warns with similar words “take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place.” Sadly men are coming with the darkness of criticism to examine God’s Word rather than by faith to have THE LIGHT examine them.
2. Modern Bible versions coming out of Textual Criticism is obviously an eclectic assortment of men’s determinate will to derive “God’s Word” from what they believe to be flawed text. By the way these “textual critics” are using flawed, disgarded, yea corrupted text that the true church rejected. Yes, out of the corrupt comes corrupt.

It has been estimated that a beam of light traveling at 186 thousand miles per second (the speed of light) could travel on and on in the same direction without ever coming to the “edge” of the universe. But GOD’S Light at eternal speed destroys and dispels darkness with the brightness of HIS SON!

“In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.”

The Spirit of God moved. God said “Let there be light”. Yet devils, darkness, deceit and death tries to kill THE LIGHT! But THE LIGHT exposes such.

Amongst all the ideas, religious teachings, myths, and theories about “the beginning” why is it that men are so hostile, demeaning and resistant to the biblical record? Why the abandonment of the Traditional Text and the King James Bible with such an aggressive effort to prove errors in the KJB while critically searching for a better “Bible” amongst corrupted text?

**Thy Word is TRUTH forever settled! Amen. “In the beginning God”- That’s the answer! To accept the Bible record is acknowledgement, accountability, and acceptance (I Tim. 1:15; 4:9) of God’s judgement and justice.** Here it is: Acknowledge (Lord God Almighty) Accountability (to God Almighty) and Acceptance (or rejection, say no to God almighty) Acceptance Of Him- He Is, His Love, Mercy and Grace to have or reject.

1. To acknowledge God the Creator
2. To acknowledge God the Judge
3. To acknowledge God the Sovereign and Saviour

Critics with lives and belief systems opposed to God's revelation try to justify and rational-*lies* their way out of accountability to God. Acknowledgement, accountability, and acceptance of God's Word as revealed would be an indictment of them own selves. Yet, they by their scholarship and science exalt themselves to the place of authority as "higher critics."

The Bible says,... "the Spirit of God moved..." and talk about a shaking. In the Beginning HIS divine wave of energy sweeps over the cosmos with the dynamics of power and order, energizing the creation.

No, not a mystical power or energy, but the person of God Himself – The Spirit of God moved...

Elohim – The Spirit of God moved upon the **form-lessness**, void and darkness with a quickening order to this universe.

Keep in mind the Spirit of God guides us in all TRUTH. Every born again child of God has access to the Holy Spirit's teaching. Nowhere is the higher critics scholarship required.

The moving of His Spirit in our minds and hearts brings illumination, enlightenment, light to the form-lessness of religion, fullness to the void of God-lessness, and SON rise – S O N rise to the darkest night of sin.

The Word “moved” is the divine moving of God’s Spirit upon creation and in II Peter 1:21 the moving of God’s empowerment to Holy men for the inscripturation of “Theos” – the God breathed Holy Word. Again, the beauty, consistency, and continuity from The Book of beginnings to the New Testament record. The Spirit of God moving upon and energized His creation and empowered His prophets to do His will. Over 40 writers during a span of 1,500 plus years in three different languages were moved by the Spirit of God to record a Book like none other in all the world.

The Apostle Paul confronts a heresy in his day that persists to the present in certain aspects. Contrary to biblical doctrine and knowledge Gnosticism laid claim to the superior and secret that was unattainable to the average believer. In Colossians this ugly heresy is answered and exposed for the darkness it was and is today. Chapter one verse 9 declares Paul’s prayer for God’s people to “be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding” and the Apostle clearly identifies the believer’s “inheritance of the saints of light”. 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meaning of "is", and Obama either ignores or perverts the meaning intended by the framers. Too often a close examination of the local church will reveal a very shallow carnal existence. Few daily read and study the Bible feeding on the Bread of Life but would not miss a food and fun event at the church. Bible memory is almost unheard of and even solid Bible teaching is scarce—then what about prayer meeting and soulwinning? Yes, people need to fellowship and have church activities. But what if Bible study, missions activities, soul-winning, a solid music ministry and outreach to the elderly occupied the churches weekly calendar. # When they leave, where do they go?

“From that time many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him. Then said Jesus unto the twelve, will ye also go away? Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? Thou hast the words of eternal life” John 6: 66,67,68.

Did you note the only (6:66) verse in the New Testament? Even today there are 6:66 disciples among us. When they leave, where do they go? This is not 100% nor will a number be affixed, however, many leave good Bible preaching separated churches and in the experience of this preacher, have gone to a liberal, at minimum, churches where the standard is not as high nor the preaching as specific. Where did they go? They went where they could hear, feel, and participate *their way*, not necessarily the Bible Way! Were they 6:66 disciples and not true believers? I don't know. This I do know. They left because they would not tolerate nor change *their way*. Sometimes it may have been dress standards or requirements for church office. Or perhaps it was a desire for more contemporary worship and music. What about the deacon, whose daughter wanted the pastor to perform her remarriage

after sadly, a break-up of the first or even second. Even now there's the Bible version issue. Some want the NIV, NAS while others “prefer” the King James--so off to the church across town or maybe just across the street. Come as you are leave as you were with a *sermonette* for the *christianette* never growing out of the *bassinette*.

Permit me to clarify something. Time may come, due to doctrinal error, sin in the camp or Biblical violation, a believer must pray and seek another church of sound faith and practice. This is not the case considered here. Sadly, too many believers remain in churches that have gone into error.

Here I am referring to a faithful pastor and leadership true to God's Word. Yet some will leave the “Old Paths” removing the Ancient Landmarks and go the way of the world.

When they leave a good church, say over music or standards, it appears to be the tendency to gravitate in a more contemporary or liberal direction. Are we seeing a rise in the John 6:66 generation?

# The King James Bible Declaration

**WHEREAS** 2011 marks the 400<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the 1611 King James Bible,

**AND WHEREAS** the King James Bible is based on the Masoretic Old Testament (compiled from the ancient Old Testament manuscripts, guarded and handed down, by the Masorete Hebrew Scholars) and the Received Text (known as the *Textus Receptus*, Majority text or Byzantine Greek text) preserved by God through Godly men (Ps. 119:89),

**AND WHEREAS** over 47 spiritually qualified scholars academically superior in Biblical languages and related areas in which no group of translators has before or since been endowed by God to undertake this divinely inspired work (II Tim. 2:21),

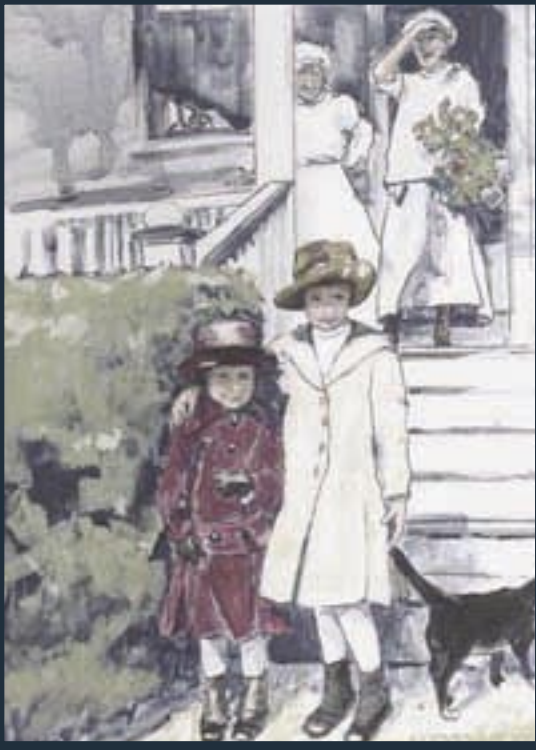

The year 2009 was filled with tremendous blessing for APM as the Lord amazingly worked through little finances to bring forth abundant fruit. As 2010 began, we had great vision of what could be done this year, but, not knowing how the Lord would direct and provide, we continued to plod along each day in His will. By February, we were continuing to fulfill a teaching need at the local Christian school, daily serving in The Voice in the Wilderness office, and we had taken the responsibility of caring for two foster children. Only the Lord knew that in May, a judge would return the children to their drunken and abusive home, while then immediately opening the doors for us to return for a follow-up teaching trip in Venezuela. With watchcare and several faithful supporters, the Lord had prepared finances in advance to be immediately available for an overseas ministry. We began contacting pastors in Venezuela and they eagerly began to prepare teaching and preaching opportunities for us when we arrived. After a late night arrival on the coast and a Saturday morning flight into Barquisemeto, Bro. Carlos picked us up and took us to his church in Yaritagua where, in the midst of rain and a leaky roof, **Steve taught a marriage and family class** to the couples of the church. Praise the Lord, after preaching Sunday school and the morning service, we saw two young people accept Christ. That night, we traveled to San Pablo to preach for **Pastor Josue in the new church plant**. About 40 folks gathered in a store front to hear the gospel and several accepted Christ. What a blessing it was to fellowship with the new believers and share in their excitement about what God is doing in their town. The following afternoon, Rebekah met with the area **Pastor's wives for a time of fellowship and testimony**. Over pizza, each lady shared how the Lord is working in their lives and ministry and also enjoyed picking out new dresses and outfits that APM had the privilege of purchasing. While finding modest dresses, skirts, and shirts in America is becoming a challenge, it is even more difficult in Venezuela. Therefore, some of the ladies simply own one or two "church" outfits, so Rebekah enjoyed shopping and presenting the ladies with new clothes. Tuesday, we began **teaching in the Bible Institute** to approximately 40 students. This was a time of informative and practical lesson on teaching children within the church ministry. We also followed-up on our last trip with further English lessons. On Wednesday, we traveled to San Felipe, a city of over 250,000, where **Pastor Niller** is in the midst of a rapidly growing work with 60 plus regularly attending on Sunday mornings. This mid-week service brought about 40 people with many being unsaved. Seeing the number of unsaved present, Steve quickly changed his sermon topic to salvation and during the invitation, **five**





**more souls were saved.** Thursday morning took us to a **public school** where Pastor Ramos and his assistant Bro. Juan had organized special services for teens and their parents. Steve was to teach on Biblical marriage to the parents, while Bro. Juan taught the young people. Only the Lord knew that a Catholic teacher, not wanting the Baptist to teach in the school, would set-up a last minute festival to distract all the people from attending the church classes. Praise the Lord – the devil was defeated, though, as many **parents** still **attended** and **six accepted Christ** after the lesson. In the teen class, Bro. Juan taught 60 students on “Violence” and Steve followed with a gospel presentation and illustration. In front of their peers, **40 students raised their hand** to receive Christ. We welcomed Friday with joy as we returned to “our home base,” Sabana de Parra, and fellowshiped again with our church family at the **Marvelous Grace Church and Pastor Estelvio**. The Friday evening service began with Bro. Carlos preaching and concluded about 11pm with Steve’s message. What a blessing for The Voice in the Wilderness to have been a part of the 10 plus years of evangelism of this part of Venezuela through the leadership of Pastor Ramos and Pastor Estelvio. As our trip came to a conclusion, we provided music and preaching at **two brand new church plants** that are beginning under a lean-to with new believers being taught by Bro. Juan and under a tree with 30-40 faithful attendees hearing the Word in Las Piedras. Surely it was a quick 10 day trip with ministering in 5 different churches, a public school, and teaching in the Bible Institute. Praise the Lord for the seed planted, water poured, and over 60 professions of faith.

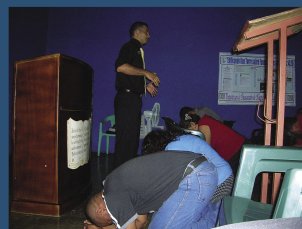

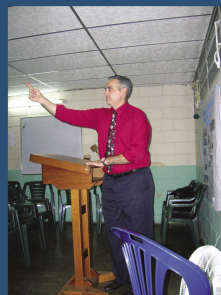

# BECOMING A FRIENDLY CHURCH

A church should be a friendly place if we want visitors to return to the next church service. Friendliness and hospitality must begin with the pastor and his wife. As leaders are developed and staff is hired, each one must learn the importance of reaching out to visitors and new families. A friendly atmosphere will prepare people's hearts to hear the Word of God. A Church planter must develop a friendliness in his church.

There are some specific things every pastor and church member can do to welcome visitors.

1. The pastor should arrive early and be available to meet new people for Sunday school and for every service.
2. The pastor must train his church members to be friendly. Periodically a small amount of time could be utilized in a Wednesday night or Sunday night service in order to train people on the skill of being friendly. Possible methods of properly greeting visitors could be explained and clarified and practiced.
3. Every deacon, staff member, leader and their wives should be instructed to mill about the auditorium before and after each service.
4. Greeters could be designated and trained. Remember, appointing greeters without proper instruction is doomed to failure. Greeters should be at every possible entrance prior to every service and should be knowledgeable concerning classes, nursery and services.
5. Periodically mention the importance of friendliness during the preaching.
6. Make your facility visitor friendly. Place signs to guide people to Sunday school, the nursery or the auditorium. Keep the buildings clean and in proper repair.
7. Make the services inviting. Make the music uplifting and spiritual. Keep the service moving. People did not come to hear the announcements or endless details about which they have no interest.
8. At the end of each service, the pastor and his wife should



stand at the rear of the auditorium to greet people as they leave.

9. Designate a place for a welcome center where bulletins and church information are available.
10. Train your people to bring visitors to you and introduce them. That way you do not have to struggle trying to locate them after the service.
11. Have members located where people arrive. It may be important to have members in the parking lot or on the street to guide people to the proper places.
12. If the size of your facility warrants it, you should have a map with classroom locations to guide guests to the proper place.
13. Arrive at church early. Though many people are always late, there are some who will arrive early, and someone needs to be ready to meet them when they come.

It all begins with you, the pastor. If it is important to you, then it will become important to others. The pastor's wife also plays a key role in greeting new people and setting the standard for other ladies of the church.

A friendly church provides the opportunity for visitors to return and to become receptive to the Gospel so they can be saved. We have the greatest message in the world! We must let people know the great news that Jesus will save them and change their lives. Being friendly certainly sets the stage for this to be possible.

We must never be guilty of having visitors to our church who are never warmly welcomed to the services. You can have a friendly church if you make it a priority.-- *Jim Townsley, Pastor, Central Baptist Church, Southington, Connecticut*

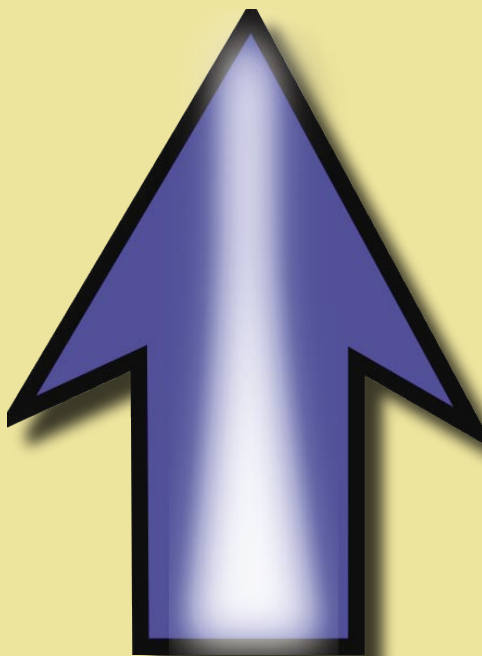
# UP, UP, OR UP?

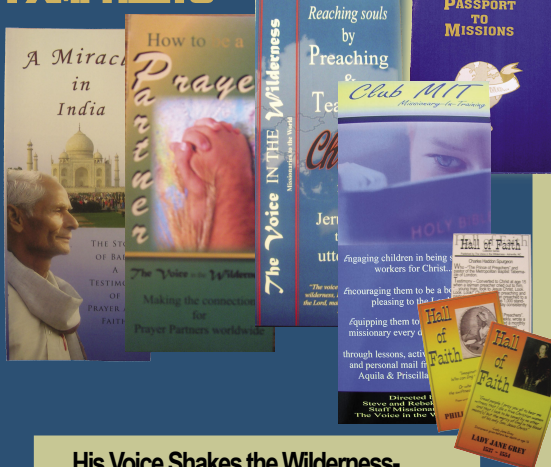

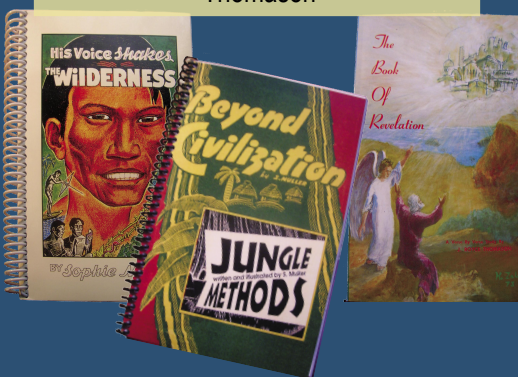
