PHILOSOPHY AND PURPOSE

BEREAN BIBLE COLLEGE AND THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY is, first of all, a Christian institution, and is therefore a spiritual organization. This Institute was born out of a burden laid by God on the heart of a biblical local church Evangelist, and is a ministry under the auspices of Victory Baptist Temple of Piedmont, MO (an independent, fundamental Baptist church).

BBCTS is an educational institution, established to provide training for full-time Christian ministers, local church laymen, and those who desire to enrich their lives with a more complete, thorough, and practical knowledge of the Word of God.

As a Bible College and Seminary, BBCTS maintains 80% of its courses in Bible or Bible-related subjects, and the other 20% in Practical Ministry courses.

Recognizing the very real need around the world for more Christian ministers and laymen who are dedicated to Christ with a biblical balance of knowledge, wisdom, red-hot fervor, Holy Spirit fullness, and a greater knowledge of the Word of God, BBCTS was born to be a very real factor in meeting this need.

The cornerstone of the BBCTS philosophy, undergirding all curriculum, courses, and activities, is the Lord Jesus Christ. The centerpiece of our convictions is a Person, the Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus said, "I am the way, the TRUTH, and the life...." (John 14:6).

The compass of our course of action and that which gives purpose and direction in the lives of all Christians and Christian institutions is Jesus Christ and His inerrant, infallible Word, for He is "THE WAY." That which erases confusion is a knowledge of Jesus Christ and an understanding of His Word, for He is "THE TRUTH." That which gives eternal value to the Christian's efforts and existence is Jesus Christ, for He is "THE LIFE."

Since the heart of this philosophy of BBCTS is Jesus Christ and His Word, then it follows that the ultimate purpose of this Institute is to train students to seek to do that which will only glory Him. Therefore, it is basic to our institutional existence and purpose that BBCTS offer its students that which will enable them to understand God's plan and purpose for this age and where they best fit into that plan.

IN SUMMARY, the purpose of BBCTS is as follows:

- **1.** To prepare Pastors, Evangelists, Missionaries, and full-time Christian workers with a high standard of biblical studies, fundamental and evangelistic in nature.
 - 2. To effectively train local church lay workers in the different areas of fruitful practical ministries.
- **3.** To teach, promote, and defend that body of biblical truth held by fundamentalists throughout the ages. We believe in the inerrant authority of the Scriptures as set forth in our doctrinal statement of faith.
- **4.** To enrich the lives of serious students of the Word of God by imparting, and providing the tools to gain, a thorough and workable knowledge of the Bible and related ministerial subjects.

The yardstick by which BBCTS will measure everything that is taught and practiced is the Word of God, believing that the KING JAMES BIBLE is the preserved Word of God for the English-speaking people of today. "Consistency, thou art a jewel." As far as is humanly possible, with the help of God, BBCTS shall strive to keep its teaching consistent with the fundamental, literal interpretation of the Word of God.

Because of the distinctively Christian philosophy and purpose of BBCTS, we do not consider ourselves to be in competition with any other school, college, university, institute, or seminary that is training Christian servants. Let it never by said by any of our friends or enemies that we have educated or conferred a diploma or degree on any student who has attended this sacred Institute for any other purpose than that which is herein stated: to serve our Lord Jesus Christ. In conclusion, it is worth noting that every person connected with BBCTS is in agreement with our stated philosophy and purpose.

WHY SHOULD BBCTS BE A CONSIDERATION?

WE ARE <u>FUNDAMENTAL</u>. We hold to the Bible as the inspired and preserved Word of God; the King James Bible being the Word of God for the English speaking people of today. We believe that a literal approach to biblical interpretation is the only sane and correct method of understanding God's message to mankind.

WE ARE <u>EVANGELISTIC</u>. We believe that soul winning is the dearest thing to the heart of God. All teachers are required to be soul winners. All students are expected to be soul winners.

WE ARE <u>OLD-FASHIONED</u>. We are biblical and fundamental in our doctrines, as well as in our practice, without apology.

WE ARE <u>PRACITCAL</u>. We blend the finest scholarship with the best practical teaching possible. We not only teach what to do, but also HOW to do it. We offer not only a GREATER KNOWLEDGE of the Word of God, but a WORKABLE knowledge of the Word of God. We also offer specialized courses in our Practical Ministries department which include such church ministries as: Children's Ministries, Soul Winning, Church Music, Christian Education, Second Man (Assistant Pastor), Leadership, etc.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

- 1. We believe that the Bible is verbally inspired and that it is the only authority in all matters of faith, doctrine, and practice. We believe that the Bible reveals God, the fall of man, the way of salvation, and God's plan and purpose throughout the ages.
- 2. We believe that there is only one true and living God, existing in three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- 3. We believe in the deity, virgin birth, sinless life, atoning death, and bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ.

- 4. We believe that salvation is "by grace through faith" (Ephesians 2:8, 9), plus nothing and minus nothing. The condition to salvation is repentance and faith.
- 5. We believe that men are justified by faith alone and are accounted righteous before God only through the merit of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ.
- 6. We believe in the personal, visible, premillennial return of Jesus Christ.
- 7. We believe in the everlasting conscious blessedness of the saved, and the everlasting conscious punishment of the lost.
- 8. We believe that the Holy Spirit convicts of sin, converts the repentant sinner, seals God's children, and endues them with soul winning power.
- 9. We believe that it is the solemn duty of every Christian to be a soul winner.
- 10. We believe that the local New Testament Church is God's instrument in the age of Grace to carry out the Great Commission.

POSITIONAL STATEMENT ON THE ENGLISH BIBLE

The Bible is the verbally inspired, infallible, inerrant Word of the living God, and is the final authority in all matters of faith, doctrine, and practice. Not only was it inspired when God gave the original manuscripts; it has been preserved through the Received Text for all people of all subsequent periods of history.

The KING JAMES BIBLE is the Word of God, and is reliable, trustworthy, accurate, inerrant, and proven. We hold that the KING JAMES BIBLE is the Word of God for the English speaking peoples of today. The KING JAMES BIBLE is the only Bible used and upheld in all teaching at HCBITS.

Although we take this position on the KING JAMES BIBLE, we are not Ruckmanites, and we do not fall into the censorious character of many of our brethren who take this same position.

TUITION AND BOOKS

<u>TUITION</u> = \$25 per Semester Credit. Semester Credits are identified for each course in the COURSE LIST in the back of this Catalog. I.E.: (B4)=Bible Department, 4 Credits; (B3)=Bible Department, 3 Credits; (PM2)=Practical Ministry Department, 2 Credits; etc.

2 Credit Courses = \$50 3 Credit Courses = \$75 4 Credit Courses = \$80 (discounted from regular rate)

ALL TUITIONS ARE DUE AND PAYABLE PRIOR TO COURSES BEING MAILED. This greatly eases the burden of payments, late fees, etc., on the part of the student; and it cuts the Institute cost of billing, record-keeping, etc.

BOOKS: All text books are purchased by the student from the source of his/her choice.

****It is recommended that each student purchase their textbooks from their local Bible bookstore, or Christian discount book club. The Institute will gladly refer the student to its source of texts.

****If the student purchases a text book through BBCTS, the cost of mailing must be forwarded to the student. Thus, it is recommended that students acquire all outside textbooks from their local source.

****Some textbooks are produced by BBCTS. In such cases, books will be shipped with courses, and billed to student.

****The cost of textbooks for each course is kept as low as possible. Most textbooks will cost the student approximately \$10 to \$15.

DISCLAIMER: BBCTS does not necessarily agree with everything taught in its recommended textbooks. We search diligently for what we believe to be the best texts available for any given subject. Our position on the KING JAMES BIBLE is clearly set forth in this Catalog. We trust our students to be mature enough to "eat only the chicken, and spit out the bones." We select what we believe are the best available texts for each subject, understanding that some of the textbooks, when it comes to content, do not hold to our position. Please understand! Thank you!!

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

FIRST-TIME STUDENTS: Students who have never attended an Institute, College, or Seminary subsequent to High School graduation must use the following checklist for applying to BBCTS:
Complete and submit appropriate APPLICATION FOR ENROLLMENTAttach a recent photograph.
Enclose the appropriate Tuition Fees for course ordered (Make checks payable to "Berean Bible College").
Mail the above to BBCTS (address on front cover).
TRANSFER STUDENTS: If you are transferring from another institution, use the checklist below for enrollment:
Follow all steps under the FIRST-TIME STUDENTS.
If you expect to transfer Credits from another Bible College, Institute, or Seminary, send a copy of all appropriate Transcripts with Enrollment Application.
Upon receipt of the above information, BBCTS will notify you of acceptance.
Only Credits that carry a minimum "C" grade will be considered transferable. It is the policy of BBCTS to accept Credits earned in a Bible Institute, College, or Seminary of like faith in courses where the content parallels similar courses at BBCTS. (For work toward Masters or Doctorate Degrees, BBCTS accepts the Bachelor's Degree from recognized institutions.)

****A MINIMUM OF 33 BIBLE CREDITS MUST BE EARNED AT BBCTS IN ORDER TO EARN ANY DEGREE FROM THIS INSTITUTION, EVEN WHEN TRANSFERRING FROM ANOTHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION.

****<u>SYSTEMATIC THEOLOGY I</u> and <u>SYSTEMATIC THEOLOGY II</u> ARE REQUIRED OF ALL STUDENTS WORKING TOWARD AN ASSOCIATE'S DEGREE OR HIGHER.

ACADEMIC CLASSIFICATIONS

REGULAR STUDENT

A student who has satisfied the entrance requirements and who has been informed of his regular standing by the College office. The regular student may be enrolled either part-time or full-time, and is working for credits, etc.

CONDITIONAL STUDENT

A student who has not completely satisfied the entrance or the continuance requirements and who has been informed of conditional status by the College office. The College office will inform student in writing of the cause for his conditional status (academic or otherwise). Applicants on conditional status may take BBCTS courses, and will be allowed to take up to three (3) courses prior to meeting the conditions for REGULAR STUDENT.

AUDITING STUDENT

A student who may be part-time or full-time, but is NOT WORKING TOWARD CREDITS. For Auditing students the Tuition fees are the same as Regular students. Since Auditing students are not receiving credits, they are not required to take tests, complete assignments, etc., although it is highly recommended that ALL students do so in order to get the maximum benefit from each course. Auditing students do not receive a diploma or certificate.

SPECIAL STUDENT

A High School Senior (expecting to graduate from High School during their first year as a student of BBCTS) who maintains a minimum grade of "C" or higher during his or her Senior year of High School. Minimum "C" grade average must be maintained in High School and BBCTS courses.

Special Student must have written permission from parents/legal guardians in order to take courses from BBCTS.

The purpose of this Special Student status is to assist those who want to 'stack up' credits toward College early, thus getting a jump on their College education.

ACADEMIC PROBATION

Students working for credits will be placed on Academic Probation whenever their grade level falls below a "C" average. New students received on Academic Probation must achieve at lease a "C" average during their studies to have the Academic Probation status lifted.

ALL STUDENTS TRANSFERRING FROM ANOTHER COLLEGE, ETC., ARE AUTOMATICALLY PLACED ON ACADEMIC PROBATION FOR THE FIRST THREE (3) COURSES WITH HCBITS. IF THE STUDENT MAINTAINS A MINIMUM "C" GRADE AVERAGE, HE/SHE IS TAKEN OFF ACADEMIC PROBATION AND PLACED ON REGULAR STUDENT STATUS.
