
Simeon and Anna meet Jesus


Early one morning, the Holy Spirit spoke to an old man named Simeon. "Go to the temple today." God had promised Simeon that before he died he would see the Saviour.








Then an old lady named Anna came to see baby Jesus. She was about 84 years old. Anna had been married only 7 years when her husband died and she never married again.
