
## 1st Rejection at Nazareth


Jesus came to his hometown of Nazareth. On the Sabbath day Jesus stood up to read and they brought to him the book in the Bible called the book of Isaiah.

Jesus closed the book, gave it back to the synagogue helper and then he sat down. The eyes of everyone in the synagogue were glued on Jesus.






