

Jesus Stills the Storm




One day when crowds of people were around him, Jesus said to his disciples, "Let's go to the other side of the Sea of Galilee."



The disciples took Jesus in a boat and they launched out from the shore.




Jesus was very tired so he went to the back of the boat and laid his head on a pillow. Soon he was fast asleep.




Suddenly a big storm came and the waves were crashing over the boat. The boat was filling with water!




But Jesus was fast asleep on the pillow.
