
## Parable of the Good Samaritan






One day a lawyer decided to put Jesus to a test. "Teacher what do I have to do to inherit eternal life?"


Jesus answered, "What does the law say to you?"









On and on the beating went, until the man was no longer able to move. The robbers figured he was dead, so they went on their way.




Now it happened that a priest was traveling on that road also, and when he arrived at the place where the half-dead guy was laying, he got as quickly as he could to the other side of the road.








