
## Judgment of Sheep and Goats

Then the good people will answer, 'When were you hungry and we fed you? When were you thirsty? When were you naked and we gave you clothes? When were you sick? When were you in prison?'




'When you were doing it for my people, you were doing it for me', I will answer.
