

Salt is Not Antiseptic; It Is Aseptic!

In Matthew 5:13 Jesus said, “Ye are the salt of the earth.” Salt is not antiseptic but aseptic. It doesn’t cure corruption; at best it only prevents the spread of it.

I’ve talked with preachers involved in movements that tolerated liberals and modernists and had them argue that they were going to change the movement. I remember very well saying to one such preacher, “I hope you can change it, and I hope you’ll prove me wrong; but you must remember that we’re the salt of the earth, and salt doesn’t cure corruption. At best it only prevents the spread of it.”

In Matthew 9:16,17 the Bible says,

“No man putteth a piece of new cloth unto an old garment, for that which is put in to fill it up taketh from the garment, and the rent is made worse.

“Neither do men put new wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish: but they put new wine into new bottles, and both are preserved.”

Once an organization has been infiltrated with liberals who

do not believe the Bible is the Word of God, it is impossible to change it. Harvard, Yale, Oberlin, Vanderbilt University and many other great schools were started by good, Bible-believing, fundamental people; but through the years, liberals infiltrated and took over, and in most cases these schools today have no idea why they were even started.

You can never turn any of them back into spiritual centers, training preachers and Christian workers. We must get the new bottle and a new garment. The old cannot be patched up.
